RACE COMMENTS				
Race 1	COLLINGWOOD CIVIL "TRIAL OFFER" MAIDEN 2100			
ESCALADE (O Dalton) – Taken back to gain cover from its wide draw.				
JAN'S GIANT (S MacNab) – Raced fiercely in the early stages.				
NIGHTFALL (L KENNEDY) – Had to be steadied when going into the back straight when on the heels of NO TEARS.				

SOUTHERN BABE (C Sharp) – The saddle shifted forward early in the home straight on the first round placing the rider at a disadvantage. SOUTHERN BABE was not persevered with and was retired from the race.

Olivia Dalton (ESCALADE) – Spoken to advisedly by the RIB after weighing in slightly under her weigh out weight.

M Hill (BEERSHEBA) – Spoken to with regard to his whip action in the home straight.

Race 2 EGMONT CUP OCT 8TH "DOUBLE YOU EM" MAIDEN 1600

GET UP JONEZEE (C Dell) – Got back at the start.

KIWI TO THE BONE (M Singh) – Had to be steadied in the back straight when over racing near the 1200 metres.

FLOWER OF WANAKA (L Allpress) – In restricted room on the home turn prior to be angled inwards to improve.

SUN ONE (S O'Malley) – Tailed off and was uncompetitive, must trial.

ALL IN ALL (B Grylls) – Raced greenly in the home straight.

INDIAN BLIZZARD (J Parkes) – Held up early in the home straight but failed to run on to any extent when clear. J Parkes was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited to the heavy conditions under foot. A subsequent veterinary examination was clear.

RACE 3 EGMONT JUMPS RACEDAY JULY 20TH "KIA MAIA" MAIDEN 1600

The start of race 3 was delayed three minutes due to a miscommunication.

ARBRE ROUGE (L Sutherland) – Over raced in the early part resulting in the saddle slipping forward near the 600 metres. L Sutherland lost the use of her outside iron so elected to take her foot out of the inside iron and finish the race off without the use of both irons.

DANZ I AM (D Bradley) – Uncompetitive finishing some distance last, must trial.

EDDIE'S DREAM (R Hannam) – Raced greenly turning out of the back straight and shied passing the 800 metres, unbalancing R Hannam prior to making firm contact with VALHALLA RISING. Also affected was JAMESON which had to be eased.

JAMESON (J Riddell) – Had to be eased passing the 800 metres.

Race 4 WYNDSPELL@GRANGEWILLIAM "SIMON DE MONTFORT" 1600

SUPER SPIRIT – Was late scratched immediately prior to the start by the Veterinary Surgeon after kicking out at the barrier sustaining abrasions and lameness to the near hind leg. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against SUPER SPIRIT with regard to its barrier manners.

CANDY CROSS (T Taiaroa) – Raced wide throughout.

Race 5 PIONEER SEEDS "TEE PEE GOLD" 1100

SOOWIN (J Riddell) – When asked for comment on the performance of the favoured runner, rider was of the opinion racing handy to the rail and the step up in today's class had been detrimental to the gelding's performance.

ROCKET SCIENCE (R Hannam) – Slow to begin (4 lengths). Dictated outwards near 400 metres bumping COOGA MOON.

LIFFEY (S O'Malley) – Slow to begin.

HALF OF NOTHING (B Rogerson) – Angled her mount outwards near the 400 metres when not clear, dictating ROCKET SCIENCE (R Hannam) outwards bumping COOGA MOON who in turn shifted out and made contact with LUXURIANT which was unbalanced.

COOGA MOON (F Lazet) – Bumped near the 600 metres contacting LUXURIANT.

LUXURIANT (J Kamaruddin) – Briefly unbalanced near the 600 metres.

LOVE STORM (M Hudson) – Blundered passing the 600 metres becoming momentarily unbalanced.

B Rogerson (HALF OF NOTHING) – Was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Riding Master and issued with a warning after angling her mount outwards near the 400 metres dictating ROCKET SCIENCE (R Hannam) outwards bumping COOGA MOON WHO IN TURN SHIFTED out and made contact with LUXURIANT which was briefly unbalanced.

Race 6 ELTHAM VET SERVICES "WHITI TE RA" MAIDEN 1200

BELLUCCI (C Dell) and MYSALLY (D Turner) came together and bumped at the start.

SUNTRIBUTE (L Douglas) – Got back from its wide draw.

LEON ROUGE (S O'Malley) – Finished some distance last. S O'Malley advised that although the gelding raced wide throughout and was reasonably comfortable in the going, he had no excuse. A subsequent Veterinary examination was clear.

BELLUCCI (C Dell) – Rider reported the mare, which was having her first start, was unsuited to the heavy track.

BANANARAHMA (L Allpress) – Disappointed. Rider reported BANANARAHMA was unsuited to the heavy track.

Race 7 NORWOOD HAWERA "BRIDIE" 1200

CASAQUINMAN (A Bohoron) – Taken back from its wide draw.

PULL NO PUNCHES (M Hudson) – Steadied for some distance when travelling keenly near the 800 metres.

Race 8 BHL FEEDS "COPPER WEAVE" MAIDEN 1400

CANBITEABIT (F Lazet) – Slow away.

THE WITCH (A Mudhoo) – Raced keenly in the back straight and had to be steadied for some distance.

WATTABREEZE (L Allpress) – Angled wide rounding the home turn and wider in the home straight. L Allpress reported the mare had not been travelling well in the more cut up going rounding the home turn so elected to improve wider on the track in search of better footing.

LOOX LIKE A PRO (C Dell) – Travelled well throughout but when placed under pressure failed to respond. C Dell considered there may be something amiss. A subsequent veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.

Race 9 HOLDEM CONTRACTING "TIMANDRA STEED" 1400

RIP US OFF (L Allpress) – Began awkwardly and was slow away. L Allpress reported that RIP US OFF hung throughout.

SPLODGE (C Dell) – Shifted out in the early stages hampering FATTORE OTTO then commenced to over race and became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1200 metres.

FATTORE OTTO (M Singh) – Hampered early stages.

SON OF THUNDER (S O'Malley) – Lay inwards across the heels of HOLYELL passing the 150 metres having to be steadied. When asked to comment on the performance, rider advised the gelding had not handled today's heavy track conditions.
