RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **ALLEVIATE ADMINISTRATION (2200m)**

JIMINY CRICKET (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

HARLEEN QUINZEL (G Jogoo) - Got its head up when being steadied shortly after the start.

HILLERSDEN (L Allpress) - Got its head up when being restrained to avoid the heels of **YOU NEVER KNOW** (S Toolooa) which had improved forward to lead passing the 1700 metres. S Toolooa was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.

YOU NEVER KNOW (S Toolooa) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

STAR VISTA (K Williams) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had been quickly beaten when placed under pressure early in the run home and had been disappointing.

Race 2 | **DAVE HEFFERNAN PGG WRIGHTSON (1400m)**

ANJAMEME (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

ITS SO EASY (C Johnson) - Out-paced through the middle stages despite the efforts of its rider.

BEAU STITCH (M McNab) - Raced three-wide without cover.

BLUE EYED SUSIE (T Moseley) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly had travelled well until placed under pressure however had failed to respond to his riding and was disappointing.

Race 3 | **HIREWORX OAMARU MAIDEN 1400**

VALYRIAN (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

WILKINSON (B Murray) - Raced wide without cover and was inclined to hang outwards, running off rounding the final bend and not being persevered with by its rider. Connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial prior to racing next. Trainer D Crozier advised the Stewards he would be reassessing the racing future of **WILKINSON**.

DICELAND (R Mudhoo) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home and was then held up only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres, then hung outwards over the concluding stages.

A Frye (**DICELAND**) - Admitted a charge of neglect in saddling in that she omitted the lead bag when saddling **DICELAND**. After considering penalty submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$300.

Race 4 | **DELECTABLES BAKERY OAMARU MAIDEN 1200**

MOVIE STAR (L Allpress) - Jumped away awkwardly.

MORRIE (S Toolooa) - Became tailed off in the early stages and was out-paced throughout not being persevered with in the final straight and finishing a distant last. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Connections were advised the gelding was on a racing manners warning and must be more competitive in its races. Trainer P Collins advised he would be sending **MORRIE** for a spell.

RAGHALLAIGH (Y Atchamah) - Hung out rounding the final bend.

SPORT MODE (C Johnson) - Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages and near the 75 metres had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of **SILVER CANNON**.

JAMIESON'S TIPPLE (G Jogoo) - When questioned the rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance of the gelding.

Race 5 | **WHITESTONE LIVESTOCK (1200m)**

The explanation given by trainer **S Woodsford** for the late declaration of rider for **HELLO MARY LOU** was accepted on this occasion.

SENTIENT (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin.

SWEET MOLLY MALONE (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

SURCHARGE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout and hung outwards, running off rounding the final bend and not being persevered with by its rider, finishing a distant last. When questioned the rider advised the gelding had hung throughout and had been awkward in its action rounding the final bend. Connections were advised that the gelding is now required to trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

JACK ATTACK (C Campbell) - Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

CAUSE CELEBRE (M McNab) - Raced three-wide without cover.

HELLO MARY LOU (C Johnson) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

Race 6 | **SOUTHERN DEMOLITION & SALVAGE LTD MAIDEN 1600**

GURU LEIGH (C Campbell) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

TREKOLURE (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.

THE BOLD LIONESS (K Chowdhoo) - Made the junction near the 1400 metres awkwardly and shifted up the track abruptly before being corrected by its rider. Lay out rounding the final bend.

TIRATORE (C Johnson) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages and then over-raced improving quickly on to heels near the 1500 metres, clipping a heel and blundering. When asked to comment on the performance the rider advised that the mare had raced keenly in the early and middle stages and greenly throughout.

DUSHKU (L Allpress) - Lay out rounding the final bend, shifting wider on the track having to be continually corrected by its rider. Connections were advised the mare was on a racing manners warning.

K Chowdhoo (THE BOLD LIONESS) - Reminded of his obligations to ride his mounts out fully to the finish after narrowly holding 2nd placing.

Race 7 | **AGRICOM PASTURES FOR PROFIT (1600m)**

OUR TEDDY BOY (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin.

MIRADELLO (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.

EAVESDROP (L Callaway) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover in the early stages.

TENNESSEE ROCK (L Allpress) - Over-raced in the early to middle stages.

LAST BID (C Campbell) - Disappointed for a run passing the 200 metres having to be steadied and shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running. When asked to comment on the performance the rider was of the opinion that although he had some difficulty obtaining clear running the mare had only battled in the run home.

CHEYENNE DREAMS (C Johnson) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had worked too hard to get to the lead in the early stages and when placed under pressure in the final straight had failed to respond to his urgings and was disappointing.
