Stewards granted permission on Tuesday 28 June for J Riddell to be released from his engagement on ROLAND GARROS (Race 5). J Riddell was replaced by A Goindasamy.

**Race 7 - TEAM WEALLEANS TAURANGA CLASSIC 1400 (Listed Race)**

**ONEROA** (M Cameron) – Trainer Mr. A Forsman advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however, in his opinion ONEROA failed to handle the Heavy 10 track conditions. A Forsman further advised it is his intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>WAIPA EARTHWORKS 1550</b>
<p><b>HEART OF GOLD</b> (L Satherley) - Slow to begin. Inconvenienced over the concluding stages.</p> <p><b>ELUSIVE EMPIRE</b> (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>CHAMPAGNE PRINCESS</b> (S Weatherley) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from an outside barrier. Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages inconveniencing HEART OF GOLD. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next. Trainer D Weatherley advised Stewards that it is his intention that the mare will be retired.</p> <p><b>FELIX FAURE</b> (J Chung) - Raced keenly in the early stages when leading. Rider dropped his whip near the 500 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 1550</b>
<p><b>PONTARDAWE</b> (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>HIGH CHOICE</b> (M McNab) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from an outside barrier.</p> <p><b>BOLEH</b> (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>JIMMY DEAN</b> (J Riddell) - Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>MAKISBAK</b> (K Hercock) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>ELUSIVE CAPITAL</b> (K Asano) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>MERSEY BEAT</b> (Y Kumagai) - Held up for clear running until near the 150 metres.</p> <p><b>LA PALMA</b> (T Thornton) - Lay out under pressure near the 150 metres inconveniencing OHIWA SUNSET.</p> <p><b>OHIWA SUNSET</b> (S Weatherley) - Inconvenienced near the 150 metres.</p> <p><b>FREEWHEELIN</b> (J Kamaruddin) – Lost the near front plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>PIKE RACING MAIDEN 1300</b>
<p><b>HEZA SHOWMAN</b> (T Harris) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>KING MANDALO</b> (T Newman) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after. Raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p><b>PAPENHUYZEN</b> (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly contacting BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE. Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance K Hannan advised that the gelding had proved a difficult ride when caught wide without cover which was detrimental to its chances.</p> <p><b>BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE</b> (M McNab) - Contacted at the start by PAPENHUYZEN which began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>TIPPER</b> (M Sanson) - Raced keenly in the early stages when racing outside the leader.</p> <p><b>COPPER COIN</b> (D Danis) – Raced keenly in the early stages.</p>	

**IPSO FACTO** (C Grylls) – Held up for clear running rounding the final bend before obtaining a run near the 200 metres.

**Race 4** | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1300**

**KELLY KEEPER** (C Lindsay) - Slow to begin. Stewards questioned apprentice rider C Lindsay regarding her riding tactics and in particular why she became detached from the body of the field through the early and middle stages of the race. Stewards were concerned with C Lindsay's perceived lack of vigour to maintain contact with the body of the field and observed it was only when entering the final straight that she urged her mount forward. Apprentice rider C Lindsay explained in the presence of her employer S Marsh her instructions were to ride the mare cold and allow the horse to get into a rhythm in the early stages. These instructions were confirmed by Trainer C Cameron. When considering this matter Stewards had regard for the fact that C Lindsay is a 4 kg claiming apprentice, however she was advised that she must display greater judgement in future. Apprentice rider C Lindsay was severely reprimanded and is to be referred to the Rider Skills Review Panel.

**TEREINE** (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly and crowded shortly after. Raced wide without cover throughout.

**WHITE LIGHTNING** (S Spratt) - Contacted at the start by TEREINE which began awkwardly.

**ROC CHA** (R Beemud) - Began awkwardly making contact with TEREINE.

**MACUSHLA** (T Newman) – Over-raced in the middle stages. Held up for clear running until passing the 150 metres.

**Race 5** | **HAPPY RETIREMENT BIG MIKE MAIDEN 1300**

**LUDISIA** (D Danis) - Slow to begin. Lay out and raced ungenerously passing the 1000 metres.

**EXPRESSWAY** (L Satherley) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

**HARMONIA** (M McNab) - Steadied approaching the 900 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of CALVARIA.

**ANNIE** (T Thornton) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

**B Foote** (HARMONIA) – Issued with a \$50 minor infringement notice after seeking permission for the filly to race without the notified ear covers.

**Race 6** | **ITM/GIB 2YO WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES QUALIFYING RACE 1300**

**ORSOME DUDE** (R Beemud) - Slow to begin.

**SUPER WARRIOR** (D Danis) - Began awkwardly making contact with THEE AULD MINX. Shifted inwards near the 1100 metres dictating THEE AULD MINX in onto CALEDONIE who's rider was forced to take a hold and lost its rightful running line. D Danis was advised he must exercise greater care when shifting ground in future.

**THEE AULD MINX** (C Barnes) - Contacted by SUPER WARRIOR then crowded shortly after the start. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1100 metres.

**TOP TORRENT** (A Goindasamy) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from an outside barrier.

**CALEDONIE** (T Newman) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of THEE AULD MINX approaching the 1100 metres.

**LYCOMEDES** (V Colgan) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

**READY TO REIGN** (B Rogerson) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**ALFRISTON** (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Lay out rounding the final bend briefly making contact with ABANDON.

**ABANDON** (M McNab) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Briefly contacted final bend.

**JUSTICE** (T Thornton) - Over-raced through the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance T Thornton could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which found the gelding to have inhaled a clod.

**Race 7**

**MERV RITCHIE MEMORIAL 970**

**AOIDE** (J Fawcett) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination due to the filly arriving late on course after the connections encountered transport difficulties. Lay out rounding the final bend. Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

**ROCKBANK** (T Thornton) - Slow to begin.

**EXPRESSO** (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly. Held up for clear running rounding the final bend and early in the final straight.

**IMPREVU** (T Mitchell) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Contacted over the concluding stages.

**SWEET TALKING** (R Elliot) - Shifted out and away from AOIDE over the concluding stages making contact with IMPREVU.

**EXPRESS DESIRE** (T Newman) - When questioned regarding the performance T Newman could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities. Trainer C Cole subsequently advised Stewards that the mare had bled. EXPRESS DESIRE shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1,000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.
