RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 1550**

ROC DANCER (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly.

MS ROSE (L Satherley) - Slow to begin.

HOW MUCH FOR CASH (K Hannan) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

HIGH CHOICE (C Grylls) - Commenced to race ungenerously for a distance when being restrained passing the 1100 metres.

TIGHTEN ME UP (E Nicholas) - Steadied near the 150 metres after improving onto the heels of STAND ALONE which was forced inwards by ROC DANCER which shifted inwards. S Weatherley was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

Race 2

FENWICK FAMILY 1550

LA VELOCITA (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer D Weatherley was advised that LA VELOCITA will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a veterinary certificate declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres.

MR BIGGLESWORTH (V Colgan) - Slow to begin. Lay in under pressure in the straight.

DIAMOND DELIGHT (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

FAR AND AWAY (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Improved onto heels near the 500 metres having to be steadied.

LA BELLARINA (J Kamaruddin) - Steadied passing the 1300 metres to obtain cover. Lay out rounding the final bend.

WINDERMERE (T Mitchell) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

ALPHA CHARLIE (E Nicholas) - Improved onto heels passing the 970 metres having to be steadied.

FELIX FAURE (Y Kumagai) - Rider dropped his whip near the 150 metres.

Race 3

HAPPY RETIREMENT CHAMPAGNE PRINCESS 1300

ELUSIVE EMPIRE (T Mitchell) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DESTINYS GIRL (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

CAPISTRANO ROCS (S Weatherley) – Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

RUSAVY (M Hashizume) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

OUR WONDERLAND (B Rogerson) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained. Improved onto heels approaching the 600 metres having to be steadied.

Race 4

WAIPA EARTHWORKS MAIDEN 1300

ELUSIVE FIGHTER (T Harris) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier.

BRILLIANT COLOUR (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly. Steadied passing the 1200 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of COPPER COIN which shifted in and away from RED VIENNA. Held up rounding the final bend until passing the 200 metres.

COPPER COIN (K Hannan) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

PRINCEOFCAMBRIDGE (V Colgan) - Commenced to race ungenerously for a distance passing the 1200 metres when being restrained.

CONGO (S McKay) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

LUCKS IN (M Hashizume) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied approaching the 600 metres.

T Harris (ELUSIVE FIGHTER) – Issued with a warning after weighing in 0.5 kgs heavier than the weight at which he weighed out.

Race 5 | **NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1300**

SOUTH PEARL (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

KICHEKO SANA (Y Kumagai) - Slow to begin.

DIAMOND ALLEY (T Newman) - Restrained at the start from a wide barrier.

MISS BEE (B Rogerson) - Improved onto heels having to be steadied near the 700 metres.

TRAMONTO (M McNab) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of THE CHROME NUN which lay in near the 500 metres.

THE CHROME NUN (V Colgan) - Placed in restricted room having to be steadied near the 250 metres.

Race 6 | **NEMS MEDICAL MAIDEN 970**

NUHAKA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

TWOMINUTESINHEAVEN (C Grylls) - Slow to begin. Steadied approaching the 800 metres when placed in restricted room. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight.

LIKE A RIVER (M Sanson) - Crowded shortly after the start. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Lay out rounding the bend. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the filly's racing manners.

TIPPER (T Mitchell) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 7 | **MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS MAIDEN 2000**

UPCLOSENOUGH (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BURCHA (R Beemud) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

BOURBON CURE (T Newman) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

JACK HAMMER (S Weatherley) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

ASTRADEEL (M McNab) - Steadied over the concluding stages when improving onto heels.
