<p>HIBERNIA SEA (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>POSTER BOY (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>MR RAINBOW (V Colgan) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>DRUM MAJOR (B Rogerson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LOFTYS GIFT (E Nicholas) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 550 metres then held up for a distance.</p> <p>IPSO FACTO (S Weatherley) – Performed below market expectation. When questioned, the rider advised that in his opinion the mare would appreciate being ridden colder and back in distance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>SWISH AZ (L Satherley) - Gave ground rounding the final bend and was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that she felt there was something amiss with the mare. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>A Goindasamy (POSTER BOY) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount six times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$500.</p>	
Race 2	CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL MAIDEN 1550
<p>GOODO JO (L Satherley) - Reared as the start was effected losing ground (3L). Contacted passing the 550 metres.</p> <p>DENZEL (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly near the 1300 metres and went off stride for a short distance. Lay out making contact with GOODO JO when shifting ground passing the 550 metres.</p> <p>VADIABEEL (C Lindsay) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover.</p> <p>KING MANDALO (M Cameron) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>SEARCHLIGHT (K Asano) - Performed below market expectation. When questioned, the rider could offer no explanation.</p> <p>ROLAND GARROS (J Riddell) - Weakened rounding the final bend and was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>M Dee (CALVARIA) - Issued with a warning after he struck his mount six times prior to the 100 metre mark with Stewards taking into account his clear recent Australian record with regard to any breach of the whip rule.</p>	
Race 3	MAJESTIC HORSE FLOATS 1300
<p>KOOL CHOUXZ (J Goodwin) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after, losing ground. Raced wide without cover through the middle stages.</p> <p>EL COOLIO (T Thornton) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>CATHAY EMPRESS (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.</p>	

TIVAAN WARRIOR (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MASTER PARK (J Riddell) - Crowded and checked near the 1100 metres.

RED INFERNO (V Colgan) - Crowded and checked near the 1100 metres.

DOUBLE TAKE (E Nicholas) - Shied away from the running rail passing the 850 metres. Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

DIAMOND PEGASUS (Y Kumagai) – Lost the hind plate during the running.

FISCAL FUN (C Barnes) - Performed below market expectation. When questioned, the rider advised that the filly did not appreciate being taken on in the lead which had been detrimental to its chances. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

Y Kumagai (DIAMOND PEGASUS) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed DIAMOND PEGASUS to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear crowding MASTER PARK onto RED INFERNO which was checked near the 1100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended Y Kumagai's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 16 July up to and including racing on Wednesday 27 July, 5 national riding days.

Race 4 | **MIKE ALTON MOBILE ENGINEERING MAIDEN 1300**

ELUSIVE NATION (T Harris) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

SUPER WRAITH (A Goindasamy) - Improved onto heels passing the 1000 metres having to be firmly restrained.

HEZA SHOWMAN (C Barnes) – When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had held its breath.

C Jones (FAST FLYIN BILLIE) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip on his mount FAST FLYIN BILLIE when the horse was out of contention with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$400.

Race 5 | **NEW ZEALAND HORSE AMBULANCE TRUST MAIDEN 1300**

MOONLIGHT SHADOW (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin.

TINY (D Danis) - Slow to begin.

MIDNIGHT (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SWEET TALKING (R Elliot) – Steadied to avoid the heels of MISS BEE which shifted in when not fully clear passing the 1000 metres. B Rogerson was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

TRAMONTO (M McNab) - Raced keenly in the middle stages.

MISS BEE (B Rogerson) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay in under pressure near the 100 metres crowding SOUTH PEARL.

SOUTH PEARL (T Mitchell) – Crowded near the 100 metres.

Race 6 | **BROOKS RACING MAIDEN 3YO 1300**

B Harvey (LASER'S FURY) - Issued with a warning after presenting LASER'S FURY without the notified pre-race ear covers.

HARMONIA (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after beginning awkwardly the filly had got back further than intended and was unable to recover.

MISTER PUCCI (T Harris) - Slow to begin.

HALOUMI (E Nicholas) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

SAVAGE LOVE (J Kamaruddin) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.

C Jones (IMPREVU) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount IMPREVU to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of ARJAY'S FLIGHT which was hampered and forced wider inside the 100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended C Jones' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 16 July up to and including racing on Friday 29 July, 7 national riding days.

Following the running of the race connections of the 3rd placed horse ARJAY'S FLIGHT lodged a protest alleging interference in the final straight by the 2nd placed horse IMPREVU. After viewing the video footage and considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee upheld the protest with amended placings being 1st RED VIENNA, 2nd ARJAY'S FLIGHT, 3rd IMPREVU, 4th SAVAGE LOVE.

Race 7 | **KINGSCLERE STABLES 970**

ADDICTED TO YOU (B Rogerson) – Over-raced in the early stages.

BERBIZIER (S Spratt) – Raced wide in the early stages.

IS THAT SO (T Harris) - Raced keenly passing the 750 metres when being restrained to take a trail.

DANELION (C Barnes) – Over-raced when racing outside the leader through the middle stages.

DOVES BAY (D Danis) – Made the bend awkwardly when racing wide near the 600 metres.

Race 8 | **JATIN (JT) BHAI @INSURANCEBASE MAIDEN 970**

D Walker & A Tata (GIVERNY) - Issued with a warning after presenting GIVERNY without the notified blinkers.

ICE COLD GOLD (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages.

RIDGEVIEW MANDY (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

AOIDE (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up for clear running rounding the final bend.

ESPRESSO (S Weatherley) – Raced wide throughout. Rider S Weatherley reported that the gelding lay in during the running and he was unable to ride it out in the home straight.

Race 9 | **MR G PROPERTY MAINTENANCE MAIDEN 2000**

POGGIO (T Newman) - Slow to begin then shifted outwards abruptly shortly after, losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the connections advised that the mare resented the kickback and in addition the blinkers had filled with clods. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

VIPER (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the improved performance the rider advised that the mare was suited to the strong tempo.

BROTHER MAX (E Nicholas) – Raced wide without cover from near the 800 metres.

CASPER (K Asano) - Rider dropped his rein for a short distance passing the 400 metres.

BOURBON CURE (C Barnes) - Performed below market expectation. When questioned, the rider advised that in her opinion the gelding failed to back up from its recent race on 6 July. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

L Satherley (VIPER) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount VIPER six times prior to the 100 metre mark with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$250.
