PACHECO (R Elliot) – Began Awkwardly.

ATA RANGI (D Danis) – Began awkwardly crowding ORLA. Briefly held up passing the 600 metres.

ORLA (R Hannam) – Crowded at the start losing ground. Commenced to hang inwards in the home straight and had to be continuously straightened, with the rider changing his whip hand in order to keep ORLA straight. R Hannam was questioned by Stewards after appearing to briefly relax his ride near the 100 metres when in fourth position and his explanation that he was unable to ride the mare out fully to the finish, due to its hanging tendency was accepted.

GOLDEN EAGLE (T Taiaroa) – Commenced to give ground rounding the home turn and was tightened when ATA RANGI (D Danis) was angled outwards in search of a run. Also hampered was PACHECO which became unbalanced.

RODOLFO (F Lazet) – Made the final bend awkwardly.

D Danis (ATA RANGI) – Was issued with a warning for shifting ground when insufficiently clear near the 500 metres tightening GOLDEN EAGLE.

Race 5 POWERWORX OPUNAKE CUP (1400m)

TIMES TICKING was late scratched on veterinary advice due to being lame in its left fore leg. A veterinary clearance will be required prior to resuming.

OSELETA (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly bumping MONT VENTOUX. Finished last, a post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality. Rider advised the mare was not happy in the heavy track but was nevertheless disappointing.

MONT VENTOUX (N Parmar) – Bumped with OSELETA.

DARCI LA BELLA (L Allpress) – Over raced through the early and middle stages and blundered when being steadied shortly after the start.

CORK (T Taiaroa) – Lay outwards near the winning post bumping DEERFIELD.

DEERFIELD (C Dell) – Bumped near the winning post.

D Danis (HELENA BABY) – Was issued with a warning with regards to his celebratory gesture prior to the finish.

Race 6 REVITAL FERTILISERS 1400

MISS DIXIE (L Allpress) – A late scratching at the barriers at 3.25pm on veterinary advice due to being lame in its right fore leg.

HIGH FREQUENCY (T Taiaroa) – Slow away then commenced to over race shortly after the start.

CHAJABA (H Schofer) – Over raced passing the 1000 metres.

Race 7 SINCLAIR ELECTRICAL & REFRIGERATION SC MAIDEN (1400m)

LOOX LIKE A PRO (C Dell) – Restrained to the rear shortly after the start.

MOMOSA (J Parkes) – Over raced through the early to middle stages when wide, commenced to give ground from the 500 metres finishing in last position. When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding had raced greenly and did not handle the heavy track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

CEE ARE EL (R Hannam) – The inside side winker became displaced entering the home straight.

CHERRY ROSE (A Bohorun) – Lay in briefly near the 300 metres having to be straightened.

Race 8 SEATON PARK 1600

ARICINA (A Bohorun) – Was restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

LUCKY PARK (K Hercock) – Improved on to the heels of the tiring SUBTLE POINT near the 600 metres.

DIOGENES (C Grylls) – Hampered and dictated wider by RUN LIKE BOO (J Mudhoo) on the track near the 150 metres. **SUBTLE POINT** (J Parkes) – Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider advised the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

BUNKERS (L Allpress) – Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider advised the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

J Mudhoo (RUN LIKE BOO) – Was shown footage of his ride after allowing his mount to shift outwards in the home straight hampering DIOGENES which was forced wider on the track. J Mudhoo was issued with a warning and advised he must straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.
