RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 METROCLAD MAIDEN 2200

HOSEL ROCKET (F Lazet) - Restrained to the rear. Steadied passing the 700 metres when improving up onto the heels of I'M CHUCK. Held up early in the home straight. The off-side front bandage broke near the 400 metres with the bandage eventually coming adrift near the 100 metres. The bandage, which was brand new, was inspected by Stewards and found to be in a previously good condition.

THE RATTLIN' BOG (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide for the majority.

FERN FLATS (S Macnab) - Began awkwardly.

Race 2 | **CARTERS 2200**

BOLD BETTE (R Hannam) - Restrained to the rear.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (A Mudhoo) - Over-raced through the middle stages.

DALMATIA (L Allpress) - Lay in under pressure near the 100 metres.

BOBBY DEE (J Parkes) - Finished last. When questioned J Parkes reported the gelding failed to see out the distance after racing keenly for the majority. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 3 | **HARRISONS CARPETS 3YO 1200**

SHOW US MORE (K Asano) - Shifted outwards at the start hampering **GUCCI BELT** and **COTE DE BEAUNE**.

GUCCI BELT (L Allpress) - Hampered start. Held up early in the home straight having to be angled outwards across heels to improve passing the 250 metres.

COTE DE BEAUNE (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered start.

GAME NIGHT (W Pinn) - Held up behind **SHOW US MORE** and raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Race 4 | **M G TILING 1000**

LINCOLN'S KRUZ (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly. Contacted shortly after the start.

OKAY PAL (W Pinn) - Shifted outwards at the start, hampering **MAISON ROXANNE** which in turn contacted **LINCOLN'S KRUZ**.

MAISON ROXANNE (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered at the start.

VISHAKHA (A Mudhoo) - Held up early in the straight.

Race 5 | **MANA PLUMBING LTD**

SIDE BY SIDE (J Parkes) - Late scratching at the barrier on veterinary advice after knuckling when parading to the start. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to **SIDE BY SIDE** racing next.

SO SURREAL (S Macnab) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced and hung through the middle stages. Finished towards the rear. When questioned rider advised the mare had changed stride on several occasions and proved difficult to ride out over the concluding stages.

Race 6 | **HARDY TRADE SUPPLY 1400**

HUNTER PENCE (H Schofer) - Began awkwardly, settling at the rear.

JEWEL OF PATCH (F Lazet) - Slow away.

SWISSWATCH (R Hannam) - Raced wide throughout. Finished a distant last. Rider reported the gelding was making abnormal respiratory noises. A post-race veterinary examination confirmed **SWISSWATCH** to have bled.

SWISSWATCH shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

Race 7 | **HUMPHRIES CONSTRUCTION 1400**

MONZA (J Parkes) - Began awkwardly. Finished well back. A post-race veterinary examination revealed MONZA to be suffering from mild colic, which was treated.

SHARPIE (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly.

CARLINGFORD BAY (C O'Beirne) - Restrained to the rear.

REGAL REWARD (A Mudhoo) - Placed in restricted room shortly after the start when KING FAROUK shifted in when not clear. After questioning riders F Lazet was issued with a warning. Lost the near front plate during the running.

WICKET MAIDEN (L Allpress) - Wide throughout. Finished last. When questioned rider was of the opinion there may be something amiss with the mare and was not persevered with in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a delayed recovery.

F Lazet (KING FAROUK) - Issued with a warning after permitting KING FAROUK to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of REGAL REWARD, which was placed in restricted room near the 1200 metres.

Race 8 | **BARBER COMMERCIAL 1600**

LOCHWINNOCH - Trainer K Myers sought and was granted permission to scratch LOCHWINNOCH at 12.55pm.

SHEZABELTER (J Parkes) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious prior to being loaded and was cleared to start.

HONG KONG (C Dell) - Restrained to the rear from a wide draw.

GIACOMO (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages, having to be steadied. Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

PRINCESS ANI (S Macnab) - Placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres when HONG KONG (C Dell) shifted in when not clear. After questioning riders C Dell was issued with a warning.

BOLD IRIS (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide throughout. Finished towards the rear. When questioned rider advised the mare raced wide throughout and had little left at the finish.

C Dell (HONG KONG) - Issued with a warning after permitting HONG KONG to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of PRINCESS ANI, which was placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres.
