RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 BAYLEYS WHAKATANE 3YO (1400 metres)

OHIWA SUNSET (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

SAINT BATHANS (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up for clear running early in the final straight.

NOVASHOW (M McNab) - Steadied passing the 1000 metres to obtain cover and then raced ungenerously for a distance. Not persevered with by its rider and was eased down in the final straight. When questioned regarding performance rider M McNab could offer no tangible excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

S Weatherley (SAINT BATHANS) - Issued with a warning for using his whip with his arm above shoulder height on one occasion near the 150 metres.

Race 2 GARTSHORE CONSTRUCTION MAIDEN (1400 metres)

ENCHANTED ELLE (K Hannan) - Slow to begin. Lay in near the 450 metres making contact with CAMACHO which became briefly unbalanced.

CASINO PRINCESS (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly then crowded, losing ground.

NO AGENDA NIGEL (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

CAMACHO (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Briefly unbalanced 450 metres.

ANNEXCEPTION (S Weatherley) - Crowded and hampered losing ground passing the 1300 metres. Received veterinary treatment following the race after returning to the enclosure with blood present due a small laceration to the left fore coronet.

BLOOD DIAMOND (A Goindasamy) – Crowded becoming unbalanced near the 1300 metres.

BEAU ARCHERS ROSE (C Burdan) – Restrained passing the 1200 metres to avoid the heels of CADA CAMINO.

L Satherley (CADA CAMINO) – Issued with a warning after permitting CADA CAMINO to shift in near the 1200 metres crowding BEAU ARCHERS ROSE which was steadied.

L Satherley (CADA CAMINO) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount CADA CAMINO to shift in near the 1300 metres when insufficiently clear of ANNEXCEPTION and BLOOD DIAMOND which were both crowded and hampered losing ground. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee suspended L Satherley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 30 March up to and including racing on Thursday 7 April, 5 national riding days.

Race 3 OWENS IFS HANDICAP (1600 metres)

HAPPY REMARK (N Parmar) – Restrained from a wide barrier.

GINGERBREAD (S Weatherley) – Made the final bend awkwardly.

QUICK PREVIEW (A Calder) – Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider A Calder advised that the gelding may prefer firmer footing.

GAGLIARDI (L Satherley) – Raced keenly when leading.

EL BANDOLERO (M Hashizume) - Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 4 BAYLEYS TAURANGA HANDICAP (1600 metres)

BLUE MOON (S Weatherley) - Restrained at the start.

FUNTONIC (N Parmar) - Restrained leaving the barrier. Improved wider on the track passing the 400 metres and continued to shift outwards in the final straight finishing very wide on the track. When questioned regarding the riding tactics in particular from near the 500 metres where he had asked FUNTONIC to improve wide on the track, apprentice rider N Parmar explained that his riding instructions had been to come wide on the track. Trainer C Wood confirmed to Stewards that the instructions were to get to the outside half of the track in the home straight as he believed it would provide better footing. N Parmar further explained that when he had asked FUNTONIC to improve wider on the track the gelding had failed to respond in the conditions and then elected to go wider in an endeavour to find better footing. N Parmar's explanation was noted by Stewards. N Parmar was reminded of his obligation in that he must ride his mounts out to the end of the race when circumstances permit him to do so.

CLEVER RUDS (L Satherley) – Raced keenly in the early stages when leading.

Race 5 J SWAP CONTRACTORS HANDICAP (1200 metres)

APPELLANT (S Weatherley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously in the early to middle stages.

STAR TREASURE (M Hashizume) - Made brief contact with DIAMOND PEGASUS over the concluding stages.

DIAMOND PEGASUS (L Satherley) - Made brief contact over the concluding stages.

L Satherley (DIAMOND PEGASUS) - Issued with a warning for using her whip with her arm above shoulder height on one occasion near the 250 metres.

Race 6 TRITON PACIFIC OWENS PLATE (1400 metres)

NAVAL FLEET (M Hashizume) - Restrained from its wide barrier. When questioned regarding the performance apprentice rider M Hashizume advised the mare had not been comfortable in the existing track conditions in a fresh state.

MONT VENTOUX (N Parmar) - Slow to begin.

SUMMER PASSAGE (S Weatherley) - Raced wide in the early stages.

TWO ILLICIT (M McNab) - Rider M McNab advised that the mare had found the existing track conditions testing under the impost of 62 kgs.

MANRICO (T Newman) - When questioned regarding the improved performance Trainer S Ralph advised that the gelding had capitalised on a more favourable draw when being able to lead.

Race 7 ULTIMATE MAZDA JAPAN TROPHY (G2) (1600 metres)

GINO SEVERINI (A Calder) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers becoming briefly unbalanced. Raced wide without cover throughout.

HYPNOS (S McKay) - Knuckled when leaving the barrier and quickly recovered.

CHEVAL PROMETTEUR (S Spratt) - Lay in leaving the barriers crowding MASETTO onto GINO SEVERINI who made contact with the hindquarters of TRUE ENOUGH which became briefly unbalanced. Became briefly unbalanced near the 50 metres when making contact.

MASETTO (M McNab) - Crowded leaving the barrier losing ground. Crowded near the 50 metres between TRUE ENOUGH which shifted out slightly, and CHEVAL PROMETTEUR which shifted in slightly, with CHEVAL PROMETTEUR and MASETTO becoming briefly unbalanced.

TRUE ENOUGH (A Goindasamy) - Was seen to by the veterinarian following the race after losing the near hind plate.

Following the race, rider M McNab was shown footage where **MASETTO** had been crowded near the 50 metres with M McNab advising the interference had not affected his finishing position in the race.

Race 8 BAYLEYS MOUNT MAUNGANUI HANDICAP (1200 metres)

SAVONOSKI (M McNab) – The rider was re-weighed after it was brought to Stewards attention there may have been an error during the weigh out process.

NOTABADPHELAN (A Calder) – Restrained from its wide barrier at the start.

HIGHLIGHTER (S Weatherley) - Restrained from its wide barrier at the start.

LOCK UP (T Thornton) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

BULLNOSE (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly.

SEAFOAM (J Fawcett) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CALL ME EVIE (C Burdan) - Raced ungenerously when making the bend near the 900 metres.
