RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 MURRAY CONTRACTORS MAIDEN 2100

SECRET ASSASIN (A Mudhoo) - Ran wide on the first bend.

ZACKERY (C Dell) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages when looking to obtain cover, then raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Forced wider 300 metres.

CRY BABY (R Hannam) - Lay in across heels passing the 300 metres. Disappointed, finishing some distance back. R Hannam reported the filly hung rounding the home turn. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

THE BELVOIR (C Grylls) - Held up early in the final straight.

DETONATE (T Allan) - Shifted out to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres, inconveniencing ZACKERY, which was forced wider.

I'M CHUCK (E Nicholas) - Disputed the pace early when taken forward and had little left at the finish. When questioned E Nicholas agreed with Stewards that the more preferred option would have been to take a trail and she had erred in her judgment on this occasion.

HERECOMESTHESUN (L Allpress) - Rider L Allpress reported the gelding would benefit from some easing of the ground.

S O'Malley (ESTABLISHMENT) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip with an action which raised the Rider's arm above shoulder height. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a fine of \$150.

Race 2 ERNIE CHRISTISON CONTRACTING LTD MAIDEN 1200

BARRI HYDE (E Nicholas) - Dislodged rider during the preliminary and galloped a distance before being recaptured, undergoing a veterinary examination and assessed fit to race. E Nicholas was uninjured.

SPARKLING GODDESS (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

LET LOOSE (C Dell) - Restrained from a wide barrier. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

PHINSTON (J Riddell) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.

MOLL OF PENTIRE (L Sutherland) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Hampered 500 metres when forced wider.

KAREHANA BAY (F Lazet) - Made brief contact with the rail approaching the 800 metres, becoming unbalanced, then hung outwards passing the 600 metres, becoming awkwardly placed near heels, proving a difficult ride.

RAURIMU (D Bradley) - Hampered 500 metres when forced wider. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages to the inside of LET LOOSE, which shifted in under pressure.

FREE THYME (A Mudhoo) - Shifted out to avoid the heels of KAREHANA BAY which was racing erratically passing the 500 metres crowding MOLL OF PENTIRE and RAURIMU.

BE FLEXI (J Parkes) - Became awkwardly placed near the 150 metres when improving onto the heels of RAURIMU.

Race 3 PAUL DIAMOND MEMORIAL 1200

Trainer P Lock (FLAT TRACK BULLY) - Issued with a warning after presenting FLAT TRACK BULLY without notified (visor blinkers).

FLAT TRACK BULLY (M Hashizume) - Crowded soon after leaving the barriers.

FREE BEE (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

SUNLIT LANE (L Allpress) - When questioned into the improved performance of the winner SUNLIT LANE, Trainer S Brown advised the home track advantage and the addition of a shadow roll were the main factors in its improved performance, which he added was not unexpected.

Race 4 PROPERTY BROKERS PAHIATUA/WOODVILLE 1200

GEE STRING (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly. Got its head up when being steadied near the 800 metres.

VATICAN NEWS (S O'Malley) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages, then made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. S O'Malley reported the gelding is better suited to more rain-affected footing.

Race 5 THE PRESIDENT'S MILE MAIDEN 1600

WAGON WHEEL (S O'Malley) - Began awkwardly losing ground, then becoming tailed off in the early stages.

SHOCKPROOF (L Sutherland) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

KAMAAL (D Turner) - Raced greenly throughout.

JAMESON (C Dell) - Held up passing the 400 metres

LONGBURN LAD (C Grylls) - Finished well back. C Grylls had no excuse.

Race 6 SUPER LIQUOR WOODVILLE 1600

GREYSTONE (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly.

SHOWBOURNE (J Parkes) - Raced wide without cover.

RED 'N' SURF (L Sutherland) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

MADURO (T Taiaroa) - Ran wide rounding the final bend.

RED JAKKAL (L Douglas) - Held up passing the 350 metres.

Race 7 WOODVILLE-PAHIATUA CUP 1600

FLYING SURF (F Lazet) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MISS SHER NAN (L Douglas) – Steadied from a wide barrier.

ROCKTILYOUDROP (E Nicholas) - Raced keenly approaching the 1200 metres then shifting outwards to avoid heels, forcing SANIBEL and RUBY ROCKS wide on the track. Raced wide without cover.

SANIBEL (L Allpress) - Forced wide 1200 metres. Dictated wider 300 metres.

RUBY ROCKS (J Parkes) - Forced wide 1200 metres.

THE FEARLESS ONE (C Grylls) - Held up for a distance making the final bend and early in the final straight.

DAWN JESSIE (M Hashizume) - Lay inwards onto the heels of SWISH AZ, which lay outwards passing the 300 metres. When being corrected by its rider DAWN JESSIE shifted outwards briefly hampering MAHOE and SANIBEL, which were dictated wider.

MAHOE (D Bradley) - Dictated wider 300 metres.

Race 8 DANNEVEGAS MAIDEN 1400

THE JUNGLE KING (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

SERENGETI (F Lazet) - Hampered leaving the barriers. Raced keenly in the early stages. Held up for a distance from near the 600 metres behind the tiring MARTINA MARIEA.

TAKE ON (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

CRACKERJACK (C Dell) - Crowded 1300 metres.

GOING STEADY (M Hudson) - Crowded 1300 metres. Raced in restricted room passing the 900 metres.

JUST BEN (M Hashizume) - Shifted in crowding CRACKERJACK and GOING STEADY near the 1300 metres before being corrected by its riders. M Hashizume was advised to exercise care.

MANAGERESS (L Allpress) - When questioned rider could offer no excuse for the performance other than it may benefit from more rain-affected going.
