GENERAL

Race times from Race 3 onwards were amended due to the delay at the Riverton Racing Club.

Trainer F Pratt (MAGIC INCANTO) was questioned by the RIB Stewards regarding his reasoning when entering MAGIC INCANTO in both the POWER TURF SPRINT (1200m) and the POWER FARMING HAWKE'S BAY CUP (2200m). Mr Pratt advised the mare's owners had instructed him to prepare MAGIC INCANTO for the 2200m distance race which he was in the process of doing. However after missing some work due to a minor setback he formed the opinion the mare would be better suited to start in the 1200m race. The explanation from Mr Pratt was noted.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN 1600

ZEDTAC (A Mudhoo) - Crowded shortly after the start, losing ground.

MAKBEEL (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after, losing ground.

MAENAD (M Cameron) - Crowded shortly after the start.

ENCHANTED ELLE (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly for a distance passing the 1300 metres.

WONDERSTRUCK (W Pinn) - When questioned regarding performance, rider advised the filly had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Race 2 | **VILLA MARIA 2YO 1300**

DUNCAN CREEK (L Allpress) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination being declared a late scratching at 1.00pm on veterinary advice. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to DUNCAN CREEK racing next.

UNSCRIPTED (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

SHANLORD (M Cameron) - Lay out rounding the bend and into the final straight.

Race 3 | **THANK YOU NZ COMMUNITY TRUST 3YO MAIDEN 1400**

IFFIDAPUNT (S McKay) - Began awkwardly, losing ground.

OHIWA SUNSET (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly.

SLEEPY JEAN (B Grylls) - Steadied passing the 1100 metres.

VIVA LE VADA (J Parkes) - Steadied near 800metres after being placed in restricted room inside ST LAWRENCE (E Nicholas), which shifted in. E Nicholas was advised to exercise care. Raced greenly when in restricted room approaching the 400 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding raced greenly throughout and had been reluctant to improve when placed under pressure.

HEMI RIDAPEST (W Pinn) - Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight, inconveniencing CHARLIE CHUCKLE.

CHARLIE CHUCKLE (M Cameron) - Inconvenienced final straight.

ST LAWRENCE (E Nicholas) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 4 | **BX FOODS 1400**

WINNIE ROSE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin (5L). Connections were advised a warning has been placed on the mare's barrier manners.

ESTEFANIA (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TINA AGAIN (T Newman) - Shifted in making contact with the running rail for some distance entering the home straight.

TRULY (D Bradley) - Tightened near the finish.

Race 5 | **VINTECH PACIFIC POVERTY BAY CUP 2500**

KHAFEEF (T Taiaroa) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

THE SEAGULL (D Bradley) - Shifted in passing the 300 metres making contact with ALL IN BLACKBERRY.

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (M Hudson) - Contacted and unbalanced passing the 300 metres.

LILLY LAGUNA (J Kamaruddin) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that in his opinion the mare was feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer J Bary confirmed LILLY LAGUNA would now be sent for a spell. A subsequent veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

T Taiaroa (KHAFEEF) - Issued with a warning after she struck her mount 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark with Stewards taking into account her clear recent record with regard to any breach of a whip rule.

Race 6 | **POWER TURF SPRING 1200**

BURGUNDY ROSE (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

SUMMER MONSOON (J Parkes) - Slow to begin.

NO TIME TO JAZZ (F Lazet) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CAN I GET AN AMEN (L Allpress) - Momentarily held up passing the 100 metres having to switch ground outwards to improve.

SCOTCH (M Cameron) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

SUMMER MONSOON (J Parkes) - Rider reported the mare was displaying an irregular breathing pattern on pulling up.

MAGIC INCANTO (M Hudson) - Finished some distance last. M Hudson was of the opinion the mare was feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer F Pratt advised consideration would be given to spelling MAGIC INCANTO.

Race 7 | **POWER FARMING HAWKE'S BAY CUP 2200**

MOTIVATION (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after. Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

LANGKAWI (S McKay) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

SWORDS DRAWN (J Kamaruddin) Held up rounding the final bend.

AQUAOIR (M Cameron) - Held up until passing the 250 metres.

HUNTA PENCE (J Parkes) - Steadied on the point of the home turn when LANGKAWI (S McKay) was angled outwards. S McKay was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground. J Parkes reported that HUNTA PENCE was left flat-footed when the pace quickened and felt that the top weight told over the final stages.

THE MAYOR (J Riddell) - Pulled up prior to entering the home straight and not persevered with after J Riddell considered there was something amiss with the gelding. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections confirmed THE MAYOR would be retired.

W Pinn (RANGITATA) - Spoken to by Stewards regarding his whip use during the loading process.

Race 8 | **HAWKE'S BAY HUNT SATURDAY 2 JULY 1400**

NOD OF THE HEAD (J Riddell) - Crowded shortly after the start having to steady.

CHIKIRA LASS (A Mudhoo) - Improved on to heels passing the 350 metres, having to be steadied. Held up early in the home straight when on the heels of REGAL REWARD.

REGAL REWARD (M Hudson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

MUSIGNY LASS (E Nicholas) - Disappointed, finishing well back. Connections advised the filly is more suited to more rain-affected going. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.
