**RACE COMMENTS** 

### Race 1 RUAKAKA – NZ'S BEST BET IN WINTER 2100

ALOFT (A Calder) - Began awkwardly.

E Green (PATSYS LASS) - Reprimanded after PATSYS LASS was late to be presented in the birdcage.

### NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1300

**VADAMOS QUEEN** (C Barnes) - Slow to begin. Forced wider near the 450 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Barnes advised that after beginning poorly the filly raced greenly and failed to recover. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

**ANNIE JAMES** (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly then steadied. Commenced to over-race when awkwardly placed near the 1000 metres making contact with the running rail. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight. Improved onto heels approaching the 200 metres having to be steadied.

**LEICA MODEL** (L Innes) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier. Contacted becoming briefly unbalanced near the 400 metres when FINANCIER shifted out to obtain clear running. Shifted in and away from SHARP 'N' SMART and was then further crowded when that runner shifted in under pressure near the 200 metres.

**SHARP 'N' SMART** (L Satherley) - Restrained at the start from its wide barrier then becoming tailed off. Forced wider near the 450 metres when LEICA MODEL shifted out to obtain clear running. L Innes was advised to exercise care in a similar circumstance. Ducked out abruptly when being ridden forward with the whip near the 100 metres and again near the 50 metres.

HARDCORE HENRY (M Cameron) - Raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.

**DIAGON ALLEY** (C Grylls) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

**BOSS MAN** (S Spratt) - Became awkwardly placed when over-racing approaching the 900 metres. Failed to obtain clear running throughout the home straight.

**FINANCIER** (M McNab) - Shifted out to obtain clear running near the 400 metres making contact with LEICA MODEL with FINANCIER then racing in restricted room for a distance.

**L Satherley** (SHARP 'N' SMART) - Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of LEICA MODEL near the 200 metres.

Race 3 11 JUNE SUPPORT BREAM BAY BUSINESS DAY MAIDEN 1200

**STUNGUN** (C Grylls) - Declared a late scratching at 1.40 pm on veterinary advice at the barrier. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

**WITHEEZE** (N Parmar) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance rider N Parmar could offer no tangible explanation.

CAKEBYTHEOCEAN (L Satherley) – Restrained at the start from a wide barrier.

MATAI BAY (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly.

**SHIRAZELLE** (J Kamaruddin) - Commenced to race ungenerously soon after leaving the barrier for a distance.

**SAND CRAB** (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Briefly contacted 350 metres becoming unbalanced.

FELICITY THEN (M Hashizume) - Raced ungenerously in the middle stages when hanging out.

LA RAPIDE (C Burdan) – Lay in under pressure in the final straight.

#### Race 4 NORTHLAND BUSINESS SYSTEMS MAIDEN 1200

PRIZE PRINCE (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

**NARINCE** (L Satherley) – Raced in restricted room soon after the start and was steadied to obtain cover. Held up for clear running until passing the 250 metres.

**OUR TRISTABELLE** (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly. Forced wide 600 metres.

**LONG GAME** (J Fawcett) - Commenced to race keenly approaching the 800 metres becoming awkwardly placed on heels for a distance shifting out to avoid heels passing the 600 metres forcing OUR TRISTABELLE wider on the track then continued to race keenly for a distance. Briefly steadied when awkwardly placed near the heels of GAME DUKE which shifted out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

**NEIGH KID** (N Parmar) - Commenced to hang out when making the bend near the 800 metres becoming awkwardly placed then shifting out to avoid heels hampering GOD OF EROS and NARINCE.

**GAME DUKE** (M Cameron) - Shifted out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

#### Race 5 4 MAY LION RED PUBS N CLUBS CHALLENGE 1200

**HORACE** (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly then crowded and hampered, losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Grylls advised that after being crowded at the start the gelding settled further back than intended and could not recover under the impost of 60 kgs.

**QUALITY PREVAILS** (L Satherley) – Crowded and hampered soon after leaving the barriers.

**RAPID RECALL** (A Lawson-Carroll) – Shifted in abruptly soon after leaving the barriers despite the efforts of its rider crowding QUALITY PREVAILS onto HORACE which were both hampered. Raced wide throughout. Rider dropped his whip before regaining it passing the 250 metres.

**ZOULANDER** (A Goindasamy) - Hampered soon after leaving the barriers. Improved onto heels near the 200 metres, then held up until near the 100 metres.

MISTRESS MINX (M McNab) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

JOEY'S GIFT (S Spratt) - Raced keenly when being steadied in the early to middle stages

**IGOTTADOITMYWAY** (A Calder) – Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Lost the near front plate during the running.

**FINN MCCOOL** (C Barnes) – Raced four wide without cover. Rider C Barnes advised that the gelding had over-raced throughout.

OUR WONDERLAND (B Rogerson) - Shifted out to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.

**REGAL DUCHESS** (M Hashizume) - Held up for clear running until passing the 250 metres.

Race 6 MOUNTFIELD QUARRY MAIDEN 1600

**TRUE NORTH** (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly then crowded, losing ground.

**SPICEY LAD** (J Kamaruddin) - Raced ungenerously when being restrained in the early stages.

GO BRO (N Parmar) - Awkwardly placed near heels for a distance passing the 1000 metres.

**MYLA** (A Lawson-Carroll) - Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly.

**FLOSSYROSYCANDY** (S Spratt) - Crowded and checked approaching the 600 metres when awkwardly placed between POSTER BOY which appeared to be dictated out slightly by SWEY MY WAY and IFFIN DOUBT DANCE which was improving to that runner's outside. Footage of this incident proved inconclusive with riders L Innes and S Spratt being advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

GO BRO (N Parmar) – Hampered and forced wider 600 metres.

MYLA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Hampered and forced wider 600 metres.

JACK HAMMER (M Cameron) – Awkwardly placed near heels passing the 200 metres.

**M McNab** (RADUCANU) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift out when insufficiently clear of GO BRO and MYLA which were hampered and forced wider near the 600 metres.

Race 7 ITM/GIB NORTHERN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIPS 1600

**PEERLESS WARRIOR** (T Newman) – Began awkwardly and crowded, losing ground.

**TOPKAPI** (M Cameron) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the middle stages.

HIBERNIA SEA (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.
