Race 1 NATIONAL SECURITY MAIDEN 1600

SIR WILLIAM WEKA (A Lawson-Carroll) – Co-trainer M Murdoch advised Stewards SIR WILLIAM WEKA has been retired from racing.

Race 2 AUCKLAND ALARMS 1300

BIG STORY (A Calder) – Trainer C Isdale reported to Stewards BIG STORY pulled up shin sore and has now been sent for a spell.

Race 5 BRYAN JACKSON MEMORIAL 1600

DOUBTFUL SOUND (B Grylls) – Trainer T Pike advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of DOUBTFUL SOUND, however, has now been sent for a spell.

Race 6 AUCKLAND 24 HR GLASS 1600

WAIMOKU FALLS (C Barnes) – Trainer S Marsh advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, however, has now been sent for a spell.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 TW MOORE 3YO (1400 metres)

STARS 'N' CREAM (A Calder) – Raced three wide without cover through the early stages.

LA BELLA BEALS (M McNab) – Got its head up when over-racing through the early stages.

ZIEGFELD (L Innes) – Raced three wide without cover from near the 800 metres.

REKINDLED EXPRESS (J Riddell) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight until passing the 200 metres.

Race 2 SWEENEY TOWNSEND INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN 1215

CIVIL UNREST (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

MISS CAPRICORN (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly making contact with LEAR JET. Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

LEAR JET (C Burdan) – Contacted at the start.

AVONDALAY (L Innes) - Restrained shortly after the start from a wide draw to obtain cover.

GEMMA FLITZ (M Hashizume) – Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

DOVES BAY (A Calder) - Had to be steadied to avoid the heels of HIGH CHOICE near the 850 metres which shifted in and away from LEAR JET which was dictated inwards slightly by HERO WORSHIP. O Bosson and C Burdan were both advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

SIX CHOUXTA (A Goindasamy) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages having to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 800 metres. Held up for a distance passing the 350 metres. Clipped a heel and blundered passing the 200 metres after improving onto the heels of TANZANITE ROSE which shifted out and away slightly from LEAR JET.

Race 3 WAITOMO FUELS MAIDEN 1215

NEVER EASY (A Calder) - Began awkwardly losing some ground.

SMART ROCKS (L Satherley) - Buffeted between runners at the start. Commenced to over-race passing the 900 metres making the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly. Raced greenly when placed in restricted room approaching the 400 metres to the outside of HEZA SHOWMAN which was forced outwards by SEAMSEW which lay out when making the bend. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had raced greenly throughout and proved a difficult ride. Connections were advised a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners.

JUSTLEICA (C Burdan) - Raced keenly in the early stages having to be firmly restrained to avoid the heels of SMART ROCKS near the 1000 metres then continued to race ungenerously for some distance. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 850 metres.

APERITIF (T Mitchell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

BRILLIANT COLOUR (N Parmar) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

READY TO DRINK (O Bosson) - Improved onto heels passing the 700 metres having to be firmly restrained.

SEAMSEW (M McNab) - Lay out passing the 400 metres having to be straightened by its rider and when being corrected, hampered JIMMY KIRK. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight having to be straightened by its rider on several occasions.

JIMMY KIRK (J Riddell) – Hampered passing the 400 metres.

Race 4	CAMPBELL INFRASTRUCTURE 2200
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RISING STORM (A Calder) – Began awkwardly shifting in making firm contact with HAIL DAMAGE.

HAIL DAMAGE (C Burdan) - Heavily contacted at the start losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages. Raced three wide without cover from near the 1200 metres.

MIGHTY CONNOR (N Parmar) - Restrained from its wide barrier at the start.

STOPALLTHECLOCKS (A Goindasmy) - Knuckled at the start.

GINGERBREAD (B Grylls) - Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5	FAULKNER DRAINAGE 1560
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RIP EM UP (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

QUICK PREVIEW (A Calder) – Slow to begin.

ULAANBAATAR (M McNab) – Slow to begin.

OXYGEN (Y Kumagai) – Slow to begin. Improved onto heels passing the 200 metres.

GONE WITH THE WIND (M Hashizume) – Raced wide without cover through the early stages.

CALL ME EVIE (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 6	LASER ELECTRICAL 1400
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LE SABLIER (A Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ON THE ROCKS (M Sanson) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages. When questioned regarding the improved performance co-trainer P Gerard advised that the gelding had benefitted from the 4 kg claim and dropping back in distance.

EL COOLIO (T Thornton) - Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

TANNAHILL (S Spratt) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 650 metres.

OSAKA (L Innes) - Held up rounding the final bend before shifting outwards passing the 300 metres making contact with EL COOLIO which was placed in restricted room.

RED HUSSAR (C Burdan) - Improved onto heels passing the 200 metres having to shift outwards to improve. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding would benefit from a step up in distance.

SHERRIF (A Calder) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding would benefit from a step up in distance.

Race 7 | **RYDGES HOTEL ROTORUA 1215**

LINGJUN HERO (R Elliot) - Made contact with the running rail on the way to the barriers and underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection and was declared fit to start. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Steadied when crowded for room passing the 200 metres between FONTEYN which improved into a marginal run and BELDARRA shifted in slightly. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that being caught wide had been detrimental to its chances.

DAWN PARADE (M McNab) - Restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

NORTH OF HAVANA (C Burdan) - Knuckled leaving the barriers.

DIAMOND PEGASUS (L Satherley) – Raced keenly when leading through the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the impost of 59 kgs today combined with the fact the gelding was now looking for more ground had led to a disappointing performance.

SO SURREAL (T Thornton) - Held up for a distance passing the 350 metres.

A Goindasamy (FONTEYN) - Issued with a warning after improving into a marginal run then shifting outwards crowding LINGJUN HERO near the 200 metres. When assessing the incident Stewards took into account inward movement from BELDARRA.

Race 8 | **LANCE LAWSON 1215**

LA VELOCITA (A Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground. Improved onto heels passing the 300 metres having to be firmly restrained.

SHE'S APPLES (A Goindasamy) – Crowded at the start.

TEREINE (C Burdan) – Blundered leaving the barriers. Held up entering the final straight. Lost the left front plate during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed a small laceration on the left hind leg.

ZOUPERB (J Riddell) – Hampered at the start.

SHOW COURAGE (J Chung) - Shifted out abruptly at the start crowding outside runners. Lay out through the run home.

ALL BUSINESS (A Calder) - Shifted in at the start crowding inside runners. Raced wide without cover throughout.

SPLASH OF RED (A Lawson-Carroll) – Crowded at the start losing ground.

CHANEL (M McNab) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

NOT GUILTY (L Innes) – Crowded at the start losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after receiving interference shortly after the start the filly had settled further back than intended and had failed to respond once placed under pressure in the final straight.

HIGHLIGHTER (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly shifting out crowding outside runners. Raced three wide without cover.

CHAMPAGNE LOLA (L Satherley) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied. Held up for the majority of the final straight.
