GENERAL

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 ASCOT SPORTS BAR HANDICAP 2200

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (S Khetoo) - Blundered on jumping losing ground. Reported by its rider to be flat throughout and had proved to be disappointing.

SITARIST (T Jonker) - Slow to begin.

PETE THE DRIVER (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

VEE TWELVE (T Comignaghi) - Raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres when OLAF (C Campbell) lay in under pressure. C Campbell was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

C Campbell (OLAF) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount OLAF eight times prior to the 100 metres mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of Mr Campbell's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on 9 April 2022 until the conclusion of racing on 20 April 2022, 6 national riding days.

Race 2 | **ASHFORD MOTOR LODGE MAIDEN 2200**

THE TUI TOILER (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly contacting IDEAL WARRIOR. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Hung outwards badly rounding the bend near the 1200 metres with the gelding locking on one rein and being retired from the race as a result. Connections were advised THE TUI TOILER was stood down to trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards on one occasion prior to resuming.

IDEAL WARRIOR (Y Atchamah) - Contacted on jumping and was then buffeted losing ground.

LEAVE IT TO ME (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Contacted near the 1200 metres.

VILLANELLE (R Mudhoo) - Raced four-wide into the first bend then three-wide without cover until the 1300 metres. Shifted out abruptly to avoid heels near the 1000 metres when over-racing, contacting RENAULT. When asked to comment on the performance the rider reported the mare had to work too hard in the early stages and was under pressure turning for home.

WUDDZZ (S Muniandy) - Shifted out abruptly when over racing passing the 1200 metres contacting LEAVE IT TO ME.

MI JADORE (K Williams) - Tailed the field through the early to middle stages despite the efforts of its rider who reported the mare had been under pressure throughout and had failed to respond to her urgings. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed MI JADORE to be showing signs of a skin rash. Trainer E Winsloe advised it was his intention to now send the mare for a spell.

RENAULT (C Johnson) - Contacted near the 1000 metres.

CASTLE ON THE HILL (T Comignaghi) - When asked to comment on the performance of the favourite the rider advised the mare had raced greenly in its first start in the South Island and had been slightly disappointing.

C Carmine (ROYAL KHAN) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which C Carmine used his whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had contravened the rules.

Trainer **S Blair-Edie** (THE TUI TOILER) - Issued with a warning when presenting this gelding without the notified blinkers.

Race 3 | **NORTHERN SPORTS BAR & TAB HANDICAP 2200**

HOLY LOCH (Y Atchamah) - Began awkwardly briefly unbalancing its rider.

HEIDI HI (K Williams) - Shifted in at the start contacting PINHEAD.

PINHEAD (G Jogoo) - Contacted at the start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

VAGUE (T Comignaghi) - Held up approaching the 400 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until near the 100 metres.

JACK BE QUICK (T Jonker) - When asked to comment on the apparent disappointing performance the rider was of the opinion that the impost of 61 kgs had been detrimental to the chances of the gelding today.

Trainer **P Harris** (OCEANS AWAY) - Admitted a charge that he presented this gelding with side winkers that were not notified and was fined \$50 by the Adjudicative Committee under the Minor Infringement Schedule.

Race 4 | **ILT CENTREPOINT & SOUTHCITY LIQUORLAND MAIDEN 1400**

BOB MARLIE (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

WING IT (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

ELIZABETH DARCI (S Toolooa) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover. Underwent a post-race Veterinary examination which revealed the filly to have a suspected fracture to the right hind leg. Consequently, the Horse Ambulance was immediately deployed to transport the filly to a nearby Veterinary clinic for further assessment.

PURE VINTAGE (K Selvan) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Blundered passing the 1200 metres.

TIGER FIRE (T Comignaghi) - Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Hampered near the 250 metres.

CHISSIE (C Carmine) - Lay outwards on the final bend shifting up the track crowding ABRUZZI which in turn contacted the hind quarters of NAVAHO JO. Also hampered in this incident were PAR TEE and TIGER FIRE. The rider reported the mare had hung throughout. Connections were advised CHISSIE was on a racing manners warning.

ABRUZZI (J Lowry) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout. Crowded and buffeted passing the 250 metres having to be restrained and losing momentum.

NAVAHO JO (D Montes de Oca) - Contacted and turned inwards passing the 250 metres.

PAR TEE (C Campbell) - Hampered near the 250 metres.

NO BOUQUET (R Mudhoo) - When asked to comment on the apparent disappointing performance of the filly the rider could offer no tangible excuses.

Race 5 | **WAXY'S IRISH PUB HANDICAP 1200**

RADIANT ROSIE (D Montes de Oca) - Began awkwardly contacting MIDNIGHT RUNNER.

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (T Comignaghi) - Contacted at the start. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

MINT JULEP (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

FINBARR (K Kwo) - Restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

JOHNNY JONES (T Jonker) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

EARL OF ORKNEY (K Williams) - Held up over the concluding stages.

Race 6

THE AVE SPORTS BAR MAIDEN 1200

RYLEE MAY (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly contacting GINTYS GIRL.

GIVEALITTLE (T Comignaghi) - Began awkwardly contacting MISS BOLD AS. Raced wide without cover throughout.

WILLNOTQUIT (C Carmine) - Contacted and hampered at the start.

MISS BOLD AS (K Selvan) - Contacted at the start losing ground.

GINTYS GIRL (L Callaway) - Contacted at the start. Held up rounding the final bend. Reported to have raced greenly throughout.

GALILEO EXPRESS (G Jogoo) - Raced ungenerously getting its head up on several occasions through the early stages.

PURE ZAMBEZI (K Williams) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

RU BRADAR (C Campbell) - Held up rounding the final bend and when looking for clear racing room near the 225 metres lay outwards and contacted THE DUDE which was shifted wider on the track. C Campbell was advised to exercise greater care.

THE DUDE (J Lowry) - Contacted near the 225 metres and shifted wider on the track.

DOUBLE PROSPERITY (D Bothamley) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

RAGHALLAIGH (Y Atchamah) - Held up in the run home and was then buffeted and briefly unbalanced passing the 100 metres when taking a run between DOUBLE PROSPERITY which lay outwards and IRON MIKE which shifted inwards under pressure.

IRON MIKE (C Johnson) - Lay inwards under pressure passing the 100 metres.

Race 7

EDITOR'S CUT SPORTS BAR HANDICAP 1600

HENLEY (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

FULL TO THE BRIM (S Toolooa) - Slow to begin.

PONIARD (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover from the 800 metres.

GERRY JOYCE (C Johnson) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

SYMPATHIQUE (T Comignaghi) - Lay inwards on the bend near the 1200 metres making contact with the running rail.

Race 8

WAIKIWI TAVERN & THE FOUNDRY RESTAURANT HANDICAP 1400

CARLOS (S Khetoo) - Slow to begin.

DARCEE QUE (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

WILLPOWER (K Williams) - Slow to begin. Raced three-wide throughout. When asked to comment on the performance the rider advised that the gelding had travelled well through the early stages however when placed under pressure over the concluding stages had failed to respond and was disappointing.

JIMMY FIVE (D Bothamley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When asked to comment on the performance of the favourite the rider advised that after getting back when awkward away the gelding was forced to chase on a good tempo throughout and had finished the race off fairly.

LOUIE LINCOLN (C Johnson) - Hampered shortly after the start. Commenced to over-race for a distance passing the 1200 metres. Briefly placed in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 350 metres.

Trainer **S McKay** (LA OPCION) - Issued with a warning when presenting this mare without the notified side winkers.

Race 9

THE LANGLANDS HOTEL OPENING SOON HANDICAP 1400

ROSEY POSEY (G Jogoo) - Late scratching at 5.19pm after initially being loaded into the barriers and became very fractious and was removed and declared a scratching. Connections were advised the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next.

DECEPTIO VISUS (J Lowry) - Began awkwardly.

STOP YELLING (R Mudhoo) - Shifted outwards at the start contacting FAME SHINES.

FAME SHINES (D Montes De Oca) – Contacted at the start losing ground then further restrained to obtain cover shortly after the start. Briefly lost contact with the body of the field through the early stages.

HE'S MI BROTHER (D Bothamley) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground when runners to its inside shifted outwards. Lost contact with the body of the field in the early stages despite the efforts of its rider.

POWER OF THE KITTY (L Callaway) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages and made the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly.

GLOBAL STAR (T Comignaghi) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

GLAMOUR (C Johnson) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HENRY HUBBER (K Williams) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend.
