Race 1 LANDMARK HOMES PREMIER 1600

BARNEY RUBBLE (C Grylls) – Trainer Mr. R Patterson advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, and it is his intention it continue on with BARNEY RUBBLE'S current preparation.

Race 2 THE OAKS STUD PREMIER 1200

CHIKIRA LASS (S Weatherley) – Trainer Ms. L Latta advised Stewards she was satisfied with the post-race condition of CHIKIRA LASS, and it is her intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.

Race 6 COURTESY FORD MANAWATU SIRES PRODUCE STAKES 1400 (G1)

DYNASTIC (O Bosson) – Trainer Mr. M Walker reported to Stewards, he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the colt, however, has now been sent for a spell.

Race 7 CITY OF PALMERSTON NORTH AWAPUNI GOLD CUP 2000 (G2)

HYPNOS (W Pinn) – Co-trainer Mr. R Wellwood advised Stewards, HYPNOS, may not have handled backing up from his run in the Japan Trophy, however, R Wellwood further advised the gelding will undergo a veterinary examination in the coming days, which will include x-rays. Stewards will do a further follow up with the stable next week.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 KEVIN MYERS STABLES JUMPERS HIGHWEIGHT 2060

TELL ME MORE (L Douglas) - Slow away.

TITTLETATTLE (S Karnicnik) - Slow away.

LOCHWINNOCH (K Macnab) - Had to be steadied passing the 1100 metres when awkwardly placed on heels.

HE'S RIC (D Parker) - Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

S Karnicnik (TITTLETATTLE) - Shown footage of his ride and issued with a warning with regard to his use of the whip.

Race 2 CHASE A FOX RACING SYNDICATE MAIDEN HIGHWEIGHT 1600

ESTABLISHMENT (S O'Malley) - Slow away. Raced three wide without cover until passing the 1000 metres.

TAKE ON (D Parker) - Slow away. Raced three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

DETONATE (E Farr) - Steadied when improving on to heels near the 1000 metres.

NIGHTFALL (K Macnab) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1000 metres.

CRY BABY (S Fanin) - Held up behind the weakening KING'S EMPIRE for a distance passing the 600 metres.

S O'Malley (ESTABLISHMENT) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount ESTABLISHMENT to shift inwards passing the 1000 metres when not fully clear, crowding NIGHTFALL.

Race 3 LISA LATTA RACING STABLES MAIDEN 1200

SHEZ MALEFICENT – (A Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly, losing ground, settling well back.

MY ZOI (L Allpress) - Slow away then further hampered. Raced three wide without cover.

GREEK HEROINE (D Turner) - Jumped away awkwardly hampering MCCRAW, PODIUM and MY ZOI.

PODIUM (J Parkes) - Hampered leaving the barriers.

MCCRAW (L Douglas) - Hampered leaving the barriers. Over-raced, having to be steadied near the 1000 metres.

TENNESSEE ROSE (J Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly.

Race 4 FRASER AURET RACING 1200

MIRACULOUS (B Rogerson) - Finished last. When questioned rider advised the gelding was making irregular respiratory noises and would recommend adding a tongue tie to the gear prior to its next start. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

MISS SWEET PEE (M Singh) - Lay out rounding the turn, then lay in under pressure in the home straight, placing CLICKETY CLICK in restricted room.

CLICKETY CLICK (L Allpress) - Briefly steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of MISS SWEET PEE (M Singh) passing the 200 metres. M Singh was reminded of his obligation to keep his mount straight.

FIVE FORTUNE (F Lazet) - Shied and dislodged F Lazet when pulling up. F Lazet was uninjured.

Race 5 RATHBONE RACING STABLES MAIDEN 3YO 1360

TOUCH O'PARADISE (M Hudson) - Delay to start after TOUCH O'PARADISE escaped riderless from behind the barriers. After being recaptured, underwent a veterinary inspection being cleared to start. Bumped with ASAHI over the concluding stages.

MY TARNZ GIRL (D Turner - Jumped away awkwardly hampering MISS SAILOR and LADY LOLA.

MISS SAILOR – (R Elliot) - Hampered leaving the barriers. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the home straight.

LADY LOLA (R Hannam) - Hampered leaving the barriers. Finished towards the rear. When questioned R Hannam was of the opinion the filly was not comfortable in today's track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

COM SI COM SA (F Lazet) - Jumped awkwardly hampering CADA CAMINO and ASAHI shortly after the start. Steadied near the 700 metres when awkwardly placed near heels.

CADA CAMINO (B Rogerson) - Hampered shortly after the start. Raced wide without cover. Inclined the race greenly throughout.

ASAHI (L Allpress) - Hampered shortly after the start, losing ground and settling at the rear. Bumped with TOUCH O'PARADISE over the concluding stages.

MARTINA DIVA (T Taiaroa) - Over-raced when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

SUBTLE TEASE (M Singh) - Lay outwards rounding the final turn.

Race 6 TINA EGAN RACING 1360

VATICAN NEWS (J Riddell) - Hung outwards throughout.

KICK ON (R Elliot) - Lay in passing the 200 metres.

KAPINOS (F Lazet) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that she had anticipated leading in the race and that after being challenged for the lead by VATICAN NEWS her mount had tended to over-race and its chances had been affected by having to dispute the pace when in hindsight it may have been advantageous to make more of an effort to take a sit in the trail. Trainer R Bergerson advised he is now likely to freshen the gelding.

Race 7 COMMDIVES NZ OPERATING 30+ YEARS 1360

KEEN TO RUN (L Douglas) - Came together with TUDOR QUEEN leaving the barriers. Had to be steadied to avoid the heels TUDOR QUEEN (M Singh) which shifted inwards when being crossed by SWISH AZ (D Turner) which was not fully clear passing the 1200 metres. Both D Turner and M Singh were advised to exercise greater care.

LORNA DOON (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover. Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight.

SWISH AZ (D Turner) - Lay out under pressure in the straight.

Race 8 WANGANUI FUNCTION CENTRE 1600

WAY ABOVE (T Taiaroa) - Slow away.

SWING LOW (M Hudson) - Jumped away awkwardly.

PRINCE OF DOON (M Singh) - Restrained shortly after the start then over-raced in the early stages. When questioned regarding his riding tactics, M Singh advised that his riding instructions had been to ride the gelding more quietly today after a disappointing effort at its previous start when ridden outside the leader. M Singh further stated that he had been instructed that after drawing barrier 1, he was to attempt to take up a position wider on the track for perceived better footing, he also stated that the gelding had failed to finish the race off and had been disappointing.

FRANKENSTEIN (R Hannam) - Over-raced when leading for the majority.

NEVERSTOPLAUGHING (A Mudhoo) - Hung outwards on the final bend.

PUTORINO (L Allpress) Lay in early in the home straight, inconveniencing PHELAN FOXY.

PHELAN FOXY (L Douglas) - Inconvenienced early in the home straight.

AMATHUSIA (R Elliot) - Lay out over the concluding stages.

S O'Malley (BRUNO MAGILE) - Spoken to advisedly regarding his whip use in the home straight.
