GENERAL

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 THE OAKS STUD 3YO 1600

SAINT BATHANS (J Riddell) - Jumped away awkwardly. Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

RIP WHEELER (L Allpress) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Contacted near the 350 metres when **BARZETTI** was attempting to obtain clear running. Hung inwards badly in the final straight and was unable to be ridden out as a result. Rider L Allpress advised that the gelding had travelled well and she had been confident of its chances but once placed under pressure **RIP WHEELER** commenced to hang inwards badly. Trainer S Wilson advised that he would now be sending **RIP WHEELER** for a spell but would also be having the gelding fully examined prior to doing so and report any findings to the Stewards.

BARZETTI (R Elliot) - Held up early in the final straight. Bumped near the 200 metres when **RIP WHEELER** lay in.

Track downgraded to Soft 7 retrospective to Race 1.

Race 2 | **MANAWATU ITM MAIDEN 1400**

ORIGIN (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse, advising that the gelding had felt disinterested.

KAMAAL (D Turner) - Jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.

SHAKEOUT (M McNab) - Jumped away awkwardly, hampering HACKSAW RIDGE. Commenced to over-race shortly after the start having to shift inwards to avoid the heels of MASTER CHATTER BOX, hampering LADY TELENA near the 1200 metres. Contacted near the 250 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had travelled well in the running but had failed to respond once placed under pressure and had been disappointing. Trainer S Marsh indicated that the gelding would now be retired from racing.

LADY TELENA (D Bradley) - Hampered 1200 metres.

HACKSAW RIDGE (L Allpress) - Hampered leaving the barriers. Checked near the 1100 metres when becoming badly unbalanced after receiving solid contact from SUBTLE POINT.

SUBTLE POINT (M Singh) - Checked when crowded near the 1100 metres, making solid contact with HACKSAW RIDGE, losing ground.

CRACKERJACK (C Dell) - Ducked inwards making contact with SHAKEOUT near the 250 metres.

L Douglas (DREAM MACHINE) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted DREAM MACHINE to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of SUBTLE POINT and HACKSAW RIDGE which were checked near the 1100 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Monday, 18 April until the conclusion of racing on Thursday, 28 April, 6 national riding days.

Race 3 | **COURTESY FORD 2200**

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (M Hudson) - Jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.

BOLD BETTE (R Hannam) - Hampered leaving the barriers when SCUTAR jumped inwards. Raced wide in search of better footing. When questioned regarding performance R Hannam was unable to offer any excuse but was of the opinion the mare may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

SCUTAR (L Allpress) - Jumped away awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages.

Race 4 | **HIGGINS CONCRETE 1200**

HIGHBORN (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered when contacted leaving the barriers.

GUCCI BELT (L Allpress) - Crowded leaving the barriers when PACKING NOBLESSE jumped outwards.

SCOTCH (J Parkes) - Jumped away awkwardly.

PACKING NOBLESSE (W Pinn) - Commenced to over-race when being restrained shortly after the start, getting its head up for a distance.

MEHRTENS (A Mudhoo) - Held up early in the straight.

SEAAPRINCE (R Elliot) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had made the final bend a little awkwardly and had then come to the end of its run near the 200 metres.

LINCOLN FALLS (J Riddell) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding, which was having its first race for 15 months, had travelled well enough during the running but was unable to finish the race off in today's track conditions, adding that it should derive natural improvement from the race.

Race 5 | **RICH HILL STUD AUTUMN SPRINT SERIES QUALIFIER 1100**

AFTER PARTY (W Pinn) - Late scratching at 2.43pm on veterinary advice after escaping from its rider during the preliminary.

KELLYS INSPIRATION (R Hannam) - Slow away.

BRADMAN (J Kamaruddin) - Steadied to obtain cover near the 800 metres.

THATZ DAISY (A Mudhoo) - Hung outwards rounding the final turn.

IFFSHECAN (R Elliot) - Held up early in the straight.

POWER 'N' GLORY (C Dell) - Lay inwards when struck with the whip, making contact with RAINBOW DUNEE near the 250 metres, continuing to lay inwards for the remainder of the race. Rider C Dell advised that he had recommended to connections the application of blinkers.

RAINBOW DUNDEE (D Turner) - Contacted 250 metres.

Race 6 | **LAWNMASTER HANDICAP 1600**

HE'S A DOOZY – Late scratching at 1.40pm due to the downgrade in track conditions.

CHASE (D Turner) - Slow away.

PEP TORQUE (F Lazet) - Lay in under pressure in the straight.

QUIZ KID (K Hannan) - Lay outwards under pressure over the final 200 metres.

OUR HAIL MARY (M Hashizume) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no tangible excuse, advising the mare had been disappointing with Trainer A Sharrock advising he was also disappointed with the run.

Race 7 | **JAPAC HOMES MANAWATU BREEDERS STAKES (G3) 2000**

SAMIAM SEUSSIE (M McNab) - Lay inwards early in the straight. Inconvenienced near the 200 metres when CHARMS STAR shifted outwards under pressure.

CHARMS STAR (W Pinn) - Lay out under pressure in the straight.

HOUSE OF CARTIER (J Parkes) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had felt a little indifferent in its action and it was his understanding that HOUSE OF CARTIER would not be spelled, which was confirmed by a stable representative. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 8 | **BRAMCO GRANITE AND MARBLE 1400**

REIGN IT IN (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin losing several lengths.

EL VENCEDOR (M McNab) - Jumped in the air at the start.

NOTABADPHELAN (J Parkes) - Hampered leaving the barriers. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding is better suited to more rain-affected footing.

NEWSTALK (D Turner) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had felt flat today with connections advising they would have blood tests taken on return to its stable.

M McNab (EL VENCEDOR) - Spoken to regarding his whip use on a horse clearly winning.
