RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 TARANAKI STEELFORMERS MAIDEN 2100 METRES

BECQUEREL (M Singh) – Tightened at the start.

SPANISH HARLEM (M Hudson) – Slow away.

ESTABLISHMENT (S Macnab) – Raced three wide into the first bend prior to gaining cover on entering the back straight.

UMUTAHI LAD (D Turner) - When questioned into the disappointing run the rider advised the gelding may be better suited to a more rain affected track.

D Montes de Oca (REDGUM) – Spoken to with regards to his whip use in the home straight.

Race 2 SANDFORDS RURAL CARRIERS MAIDEN 3YO 1200 METRES

KIANA BELLE (D Hirini) – Slow away.

HOODLUM (L Allpress) – Lay inwards on entering the home straight.

Race 3 ECOLAB MAIDEN 1200 METRES

KINGFISHER LAD (S Macnab) – Slow into stride. Got back in the early and middle stages and finished the race off well in the home straight. When questioned S Macnab advised despite her urgings the gelding was unable to muster any early speed in the firmer going.

KHUFU (M McNab) – Stood flat footed at the start and was slow away. Was held up for a short distance prior to entering the home straight.

RUE CLER (L Allpress) – Over-raced in the back straight and had to be eased outwards near the 800 metres to avoid heels.

HIGH FREQUENCY (H Schofer) – Held up for some distance prior to entering the home straight gaining clear running near the 300 metres.

D Montes de Oca (SWEET KARMA) – Was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after angling his mount inwards after the start when not fully clear of HIGH FREQUENCY.

Race 4 GARDEN EDGE MAIDEN 1400 METRES

HOLYELL (M Hudson) – Raced fiercely in the early stages and had to be steadied for some distance.

LORD ESPERANZA (E Nicholas) – Was steadied when in restricted room passing the 600 metres and in doing so went back on to HERMES which had to check off that runner's heels.

HERMES (M Singh) – Checked off heels near 600 metres. Held up in the early part of the home straight.

BUSYBEINGFABULOUS (L Allpress) – Raced wide in the back straight

KIWI TO THE BONE (S Macnab) – Held up entering the final straight before shifting out.

ASTRADEEL (M McNab) – Had to be angled very wide in the home straight to improve.

Race 5 NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY 1600 METRES

HARDTIMES (M Hudson) – Over raced in the early stages.

PRINCESS JENNI (L Kauri) – Wide throughout.

REGAL SHOCK (D Hirini) – Held up and unable to improve for some distance in the home straight.

BERRY THE CASH (C Dell) – C Dell reported the gelding was now better suited to a longer distance.

Race 6 HEATHER D YAXLEY MARTINEZ 1600 METRES

JUGADOR (D Hirini) – Stood flat footed in its gate and got well back out of its ground and took no effective part. Connections were advised the gelding must trial to the Stewards satisfaction prior to its next start.

BIG BEN (C O'Beirne) – Lay in rounding the home turn hampering MI GRACIE near the straight entrance.

MI GRACIE (E Nicholas) – Hampered near the straight entrance.

E Nicholas (MI GRACIE) – Admitted a breach of Rule 638(3)(g)(i) in that she used her whip excessively prior to 100 metres. E Nicholas had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 8 September up to and including racing on Thursday 16 September, 5 national riding days and fined the sum of \$100.

Race 7 ZED@GRANGEWILLIAM STUD 1600 METRES

HEY HEY HEY (B Rogerson) – Hung throughout placing the rider at a disadvantage. Hung outwards rounding the turn dictating SYBARITE over extra ground. Connections were advised the gelding would have a warning placed against its racing manners.

SYBARITE (M Singh) – Dictated wide rounding the turn.

KHAFEEF (T Taiaroa) – Hung out under pressure in the home straight.

J Mudhoo (BAE CORP) - Reported the mare which disappointed was better suited to more rain effected footing.

Race 8 DERRYN@GRANGEWILLIAM STUD 1200 METRES

CHEEKY AZZ (M Hudson) – Over raced and hung throughout. Connections were advised that a warning is placed against the gelding regarding racing manners.

GAMEOUT (A Mudhoo) – Was held up and unable to improve in the home straight until near the 100 metres.

FIDDYAFORTNIGHT (L Hemi) – Was held up rounding the turn and the early part of the home straight.

ICONIC LASS (H Schofer) – When questioned into the run of ICONIC LASS which disappointed, H Schofer said the mare is better suited to more rain affected footing.

Race 9 HEATHER D YAXLEY MARTINEZ 1200 METRES

TAMAHINE (T Taiaroa) – Slow away.

SWISS KITTY (J Kamaruddin) – Near the 700 metres shifted in and bumped with RINGTHEBELLEDARCI becoming momentarily unbalanced.

HOLD THE PRESS (L Allpress) – Lead throughout but was not persevered with from near the 200 metres. When questioned L Allpress advised the mare was displaying a breathing irregularity, so was not persevered with. A subsequent veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections were advised to monitor HOLD THE PRESS over the coming days and to report any anomaly to the Stewards.

RINGTHEBELLEDARCI (A Mudhoo) – Bumped near the 700 metres. Was held up in the early part of the home straight and was inclined to shift out under pressure behind the heels of LADY KARTEL near the finish.

Race 10 WYNDSPELLE@GRANGEWILLIAM RACEDAY OCT 9TH 2100 METRES

VIKTOR VEGAS (J Kamaruddin) – Awkwardly placed on heels for a distance approaching the final straight and then shifted out.

OBRIGADO (H Schofer) – Hampered in the home straight.

AIGNE (C O'Beirne) – Shifted out near the 800 metres and dictated CHIEF SEQUOYAH over extra ground. A short distance further AIGNE had to be steadied when CHIEF SEQUOYAH lay inwards. C O'Beirne was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Riding Master.

ZAC BROWN (B Rogerson) – Over raced in the back straight and then had to be continuously steadied near the 1000 metres and went back on to VICTOR VEGAS which also had to steady. Made the home turn awkwardly and then shifted outwards dictating CHIEF SEQUOYAH outwards into the line of VIKTOR VEGAS which was improving to that runner's outside. VIKTOR VEGAS then overreacted and shifted out abruptly hampering MONDORANI and OBRIGADO. B Rogerson was shown footage of her ride and reminded of her obligations when shifting ground and advised that she is expected to straighten her mount sooner than she did on this occasion. Stewards took into account the tendency of VICTOR VEGAS which was racing greenly when assessing interference.

DR HANK (E Nicholas) – Near the 1600 metres had to be steadied off the heels of OBRIGADO entering the back straight and went back on to CHIEF SEQUOYAH.

MONDORANI (T Taiaroa) – Hampered in the home straight.

CHIEF SEQUOYAH (D Montes de Oca) – Dictated outwards home straight.

BEAUDACEA (C Jones) – Shifted in passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

RAZORS EDGE (J Mudhoo) – Became awkwardly placed on heels near the 30 metres.
