Race 4 – The explanation from Trainer K Buttimore for the late declaration of rider for MASAROVA was accepted by Stewards. MASAROVA was ridden by A Mudhoo.

Race 4 PLATINUM HOMES (NP) 1200M

PHINSTON (J Parkes) – Trainer Ms L Latta advised Stewards, she was satisfied with the post-race condition of PHINSTON and it is her intention to continue on with its preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **WANGANUI INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN 2200**

BELLA NOCHE (L Douglas) - Slow away. Lay in rounding the final bend. Lay in over the concluding stages.

RAGGY ANN (C O'Beirne) - Began awkwardly and was then shifted sideways when KINGFISHER LAD lay outwards.

KINGFISHER LAD (C Dell) - Lay inwards and away from SECRET ASSASSIN when racing greenly near the winning post on the first occasion. Raced greenly throughout.

SECRET ASSASSIN (A Mudhoo) - Tightened on the point of the home turn when in restricted room between BELLA NOCHE (L Douglas), which shifted inwards, and ESME (L Allpress), which was being angled out. Stewards took into account the inward movement from BELLA NOCHE and the evidence of A Mudhoo when assessing the degree of interference. L Allpress was reminded of her obligation when shifting ground.

HERECOMESTHESUN (R Hannam) - Lost the nearside hind plate during the running.

Race 2 | **TOTAL TRANSPORT MAIDEN 1200**

RAURIMU (D Bradley) - Began awkwardly bumping MANAGERESS.

MANAGERESS (B Grylls) - Bumped start.

DIDDY'S GIFT (C Dell) - Hung throughout, placing the rider at a disadvantage. The stable representative advised DIDDY'S GIFT will undergo a gear change prior to its next start in an effort to improve its racing manners. Stewards advised a warning is placed against the filly.

MADRID (W Pinn) - Over-raced near the 600 metres. Went off stride on the point of the home turn and failed to run on to any extent in the home straight. When questioned regarding the disappointing run, W Pinn advised the filly raced greenly throughout and in his opinion was field-shy amongst other runners when against the rail. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.

Race 3 | **WANGANUI MOTORS 1200**

HOLD THE PRESS (C O'Beirne) - Blundered as the start was effected.

RAFFLE (L Allpress) - Over-raced and had to be steadied near the 900 metres.

MI CAROL (A Mudhoo) - Checked near the 800 metres when KAPINOS (F Lazet) shifted in when not fully clear. MI CAROL then shifted outwards abruptly into the line of MAHOE, which was forced wide on the track.

MAHOE (D Bradley) - Forced wide 800 metres.

F Lazet (KAPINOS) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted KAPINOS to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of MI CAROL, which was checked near the 800 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 8 April until the conclusion of racing on Thursday, 14 April, 4 national riding days.

Race 4	PGG WRIGHTSONS/TOM ANDREWS CONTRACTING 1400
<p>FLEETWOOD BAY (L Allpress) - Late scratching at 1.55pm for failing to load. Connections were advised the gelding must trial prior to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to starting next. Connections advised the gelding was unlikely to be persevered with.</p> <p>WINNIE ROSE (C Grylls) - Slow away.</p> <p>Longburn Lad (R Elliot) - Slow away.</p> <p>CRACKERJACK (C Dell) - Held up briefly early in the home straight. Dictated inwards final stages.</p> <p>RUSTY LANE (S O'Malley) - Dictated inwards final stages.</p> <p>HEMI RIDAPEST (W Pinn) - Over-raced and had to be steadied passing the 1200 metres. Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages dictating CRACKERJACK and RUSTY LANE inwards near the finish. W Pinn was shown footage of his ride and advised he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.</p>	
Race 5	FORESTRY 360 MAIDEN 1400
<p>GIRLBOSS (L Douglas) - Very slow to begin. Connections were advised a warning has been placed on the mare's barrier manners. Connections advised GIRLBOSS was unlikely to be persevered with.</p> <p>THE WITCH (A Mudhoo) - Checked passing the 1100 metres when IMA O'CEIRIN (R Hannam) was dictated outwards into its line by a sharp outward movement from JAMESON (C Dell). When questioned C Dell advised he shifted his mount out abruptly to avoid the heels of HYDRO CHARM (C O'Beirne) when the pace ahead eased. C O'Beirne was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Riding Master and issued with a warning for easing the pace unnecessarily on entering the back straight.</p> <p>SERENGETI (F Lazet) - Over-raced through the middle stages. Hampered near the 200 metres when HYDRO CHARM (C O'Beirne) shifted out into clear running, dictating IMA O'CEIRIN (R Hannam) outwards, forcing SERENGETI across the heels of JAMESON (C Dell). After questioning riders and viewing video footage, C O'Beirne was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.</p> <p>SELLDOM (C Grylls) - Finished last. When questioned rider could offer no excuse.</p> <p>C O'Beirne (HYDRO CHARM) - Issued with a warning for easing the pace unnecessarily on entering the back straight.</p>	
Race 6	WILSON LIVESTOCK/CHRIS GRACE 1400
<p>TOBIAS (L Douglas) - Slow away. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>HORLISTIC (J Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly. Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TOWN BELT (L Allpress) - Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p>CARPE DIEM (A Mudhoo) - Over-reacted when being steadied near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>REGAL REWARD (C Dell) - Steadied near the 800 metres when improving onto the heels of a runner ahead.</p> <p>GOT THE CALL (C O'Beirne) - Held up early in the home straight.</p> <p>SHOWBOURNE (W Pinn) - Shifted out under pressure over the final stages and bumped with SANIBEL</p>	

SANIBEL (R Elliot) - Bumped final stages.

Race 7

STEELFORMERS WANGANUI RACE 2200

JANE O' (J Mudhoo)- Slow away.

POSH POROTENE (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly bumping DARLINGTON COUNTY. Raced wide in the early to middle stages.

DARLINGTON COUNTY (L Allpress) - Bumped start. Held up and unable to improve for some distance rounding the home turn.

WHATSUP (C Dell) - Had to be steadied abruptly for some distance near the 800 metres when on the heels of POSH POROTENE.

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (B Grylls) - Held up passing the 350 metres.

Race 8

WAVERLEY HARVESTING/BIG BLADE MAIDEN 1650

DETONATE (T Allan) - Slow away. Held up early in the home straight.

ONCE BITTEN (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly and then raced ungenerously throughout.

SHOCKPROOF (B Grylls) - Over-raced, having to be steadied passing the 800 metres. Had to be steadied near the 200 metres when RISCHIO rolled out under pressure.

SO UNUSUAL (W Pinn) - Lay in and had to be straightened on several occasions throughout the home straight.
