R7 - HIGHLY RECOMMENDED AT BERKLEY STUD MAIDEN 1200m

B Murray (RAARDY RAAR) – Admitted a charge in that he weighed in 0.6 kg in excess of his weigh out weight, with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$200.

B Murray (RAARDY RAAR) – Admitted a charge in that he failed to gain permission before leaving the jockeys' area, with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$100.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1** | **AVON CITY FORD SYDENHAM HURDLES 3100m**

MIZZENA (C Case) - Slow to begin.

HE'S RIC (H McNeill) - Jumped indifferently in the early stages. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

CANDY CROSS (G Walsh) - Retired from the race after jumping the fence near the 1500 metres with rider G Walsh feeling that there was something amiss with the mare. CANDY CROSS was immediately attended to by the on-course Veterinarian, with the equine ambulance being deployed and CANDY CROSS being transported to the nearby morning tie-up area for further evaluation. CANDY CROSS was found to have suffered a significant tendon injury to the left hind leg and was subsequently humanely euthanised.

DAL KILCHOAN (P Matthews) - Put in a poor jump at the final fence.

Race 2 | **GAVELHOUSE.COM - 61 LOTS CLOSE 8 AUGUST 1200m**

DELPHILLIUS (L Callaway) - Raced keenly in the early stages getting its head up but was a beaten runner passing the 400 metres being eased down in the straight finishing a distant last. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse, advising that the filly had travelled well enough but had failed to respond when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

A Mudhoo (CARIGNAN) - Issued with a warning after he struck his mount CARIGNAN six times prior to the 100 metre mark, with Stewards taking into account his clear recent record with regard to any breach of a whip rule.

Race 3 | **RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE KORAL 4250m**

ALBARON (D Parker) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

MANDALAY (H McNeill) - Retired from the race after jumping the fence near the 2800 metres and was immediately attended to by the on-course Veterinarian, with the equine ambulance being deployed. MANDALAY was found to be severely lame in the left hind leg and subsequently collapsed and died showing signs of a haemorrhage.

CARNABY (C Case) - Landed awkwardly after jumping the 2nd last fence.

Race 4 | **STALLION TENDER OPEN HANDICAP 1200m**

RADIANT ROSIE (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly.

BENAUD (K Williams) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance, rider was unable to offer any excuse.

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (M Taylor) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

MAKABAR (D Montes de Oca) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the straight.

Race 5 | **WINTER FASHIONS HERE 13 AUGUST 1200m**

GALLERY GIRL (C Barnes) - Blundered then further hampered at the start losing ground. Raced ungenerously getting its head up in the early stages.

IRON MIKE (T Moseley) - Slow to begin then further hampered when crowded losing ground.

A BOX OF TRICKS (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly.

FAME SHINES (F Lazet) - Slow to begin. Commenced to over race in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions.

TAKE A RISK (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

GEMSTONE JEWELS (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

CAUSE CELEBRE (T Taiaroa) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

PROSERVE (D Montes de Oca) - Held up rounding the final turn and in the straight until near the 200 metres.

HE'S THE MAN (C Carmine) - Lost both front plates during the running.

S Toolooa (WHERE'S WALLY) - Issued with a warning after he used his whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height.

C Carmine (HE'S THE MAN) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount HE'S THE MAN six times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of C Carmine's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 10 August until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 24 August, 6 national riding days.

Race 6 | **GOLD CLUB 1800m**

SIR BEETS (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding had been disappointing and was unable to offer any excuse other than possibly not seeing out the 1800 metres in today's heavy track conditions.

RED RUFUS (K Williams) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse.

OCEANS AWAY (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly then further hampered when crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Raced wide without cover.

KIDDO (F Lazet) - Hampered shortly after the start then becoming awkwardly placed on heels having to be steadied.

BURNVUE (L Callaway) - Over raced in the middle stages.

DES DE JEU (A Mudhoo) - Commenced to over race passing the 1200 metres having to be heavily restrained when improving onto heels.

ANJAMEME (L Allpress) – Rider reported that the mare had hung outwards throughout the race.

<p>BELARDO BOY (J Riddell) - Slow away. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been disappointing, but in his opinion should derive improvement from today's race.</p> <p>ROCK ISLANE LINE (L Sutherland) - Slow away.</p> <p>MATSCOT (T Moseley) - Restrained in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier. Hung outwards rounding the bend.</p> <p>WHISKEY IN THE JAR (K Kwo) - Over raced when being restrained near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>SEA SHEPHERD (C Campbell) - Lay inwards under pressure over the final 200 metres.</p>	
Race 8	WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS 125TH WINTER CUP 1600m
<p>FIRODEN (C Campbell) – Slow to begin.</p> <p>WILLIAM WALLACE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>BLUEY'S CHANCE (T Jonker) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.</p> <p>LORD DARCI (T Moseley) - Over raced through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>VERRY FLASH (F Lazet) - Over raced in the early and middle stages and had to be further restrained passing the 1400 metres when crowded to the inside of TAMAHINE which was taken in by GREEN LUCK.</p> <p>TAMAHINE (T Taiaroa) - Over raced in the middle stages having to be further restrained passing the 1400 metres when crowded to the inside of GREEN LUCK.</p> <p>NOMEN LUDI (K Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover.</p> <p>KICK ON (K Asano) - Lay in under pressure in the straight. When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that the gelding had travelled well but had only battled when placed under pressure and may not have been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions.</p> <p>ORIGINAL GANGSTER (K Williams) - When questioned regarding performance, rider was unable to offer any excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>T Moseley (LORD DARCI) and T Jonker (BLUEY'S CHANCE) were both spoken to regarding the height of their arms relating to the use of the whip over the concluding stages.</p> <p>J Laking (GREEN LUCK) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount GREEN LUCK to shift inwards crowding TAMAHINE and VERRY FLASH passing the 1400 metres.</p>	
Race 9	SPEIGHT'S 1600m
<p>KENKI (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final turn until passing the 400 metres.</p> <p>TARAMEA LAD (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.</p>	

MR GHIBSON (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Held up behind the weakening **EASY ON THE EYE** which was giving ground quickly rounding the final turn then struck a heel of that runner and blundered near the 450 metres. Continued to have some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres.

IFITHAPPENSAGAIN (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

PAZE THE POWER (K Kwo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ROCKTILYODROP (A Mudhoo) - Crowded between runners shortly after the start. Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had got further back than intended and he had been unable to go forward and lead to its normal racing pattern and where **ROCKTILYODROP** races best, then also being caught wide throughout.

EASY ON THE EYE (K Asano) - When questioned regarding performance rider was unable to offer any excuse. Trainer A Carston indicated that the mare is now likely to be retired.
