Rider T Harris advised Stewards at 8 am that he was unwell and would not be attending today's meeting. T Harris was advised that a medical clearance is required prior to riding next.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 iLINE ADMINISTRATION MAIDEN 1400

ZADANE (V Colgan) – Jumped outwards at the start making contact with GREY WOLF. Over-raced racing into the first bend having to be steadied off heels. Became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 600 metres having to be steadied.

GREY WOLF (S Spratt) – Contacted leaving the barriers losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance

rider S Spratt could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

HIWA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Was tightened shortly after the start when SINGLE MALT shifted in simultaneously as there was outward movement from runners to the inside of HIWA.

SINGLE MALT (C Lindsay) - Began awkwardly then shifted in. Shifted inwards near the end of the back straight when insufficiently clear of THE JUNGLE KING which was crowded and steadied. Raced in restricted room approaching the 100 metres. C Lindsay was shown video footage in the presence of the riding mentor and advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

RIDGEVIEW MANDY (J Fawcett) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

JUNEBERRY (K Hercock) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

OCEAN CRUIZER (K Hannan) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

THE JUNGLE KING (M Hudson) – Restrained near the end of the back straight when SINGLE MALT shifted in.

PUDDIN 'N PIE (J Kamaruddin) – Lay out under pressure in the final straight.

SHENJENGAR (A Goindasamy) – When questioned regarding the performance rider A Goindasamy reported that the mare failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

Race 2 iLINE QUANTITY SURVEYORS MAIDEN 1400

ABOVE SUSPICION (D Danis) – Began awkwardly unbalancing its rider.

FLIGHT PLAN (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly.

STANIMA MAN (E Bragg) – Crowded leaving the barriers. Over-raced in the early stages having to be restrained off heels passing the 1000 metres.

JACK IN THE BOX (C Lindsay) – Slow to begin.

WILLIAM (V Colgan) – Over-raced passing the 1000 metres having to be steadied off heels. When questioned regarding the performance rider V Colgan advised that the gelding had been disappointing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

MADIRAN (S Spratt) – Over-raced passing the 1000 metres having to be restrained when awkwardly placed on heels.

ON THE PROWL (E Nicholas) – Lost the near front plate during the running.

KINGS LADY (C Grylls) – Raced wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance rider C Grylls could offer no explanation.

Race 3 iLINE PROJECT MANAGERS 1200

LORD VALENTINE (D Danis) - Began awkwardly.

NEW YORK JAZZ (A Lawson-Carroll) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from an outside barrier.

MANRICO (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

SHOSHONE (K Hannan) - When questioned regarding the performance rider K Hannan advised that the mare was making a noise consistent with having got its tongue over the bit. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination including an endoscopic examination which did not reveal any abnormality. Trainer K Kelso undertook to monitor the mares progress over the coming days and report any finding to Stewards.

Race 4 ILINE SITE MANAGERS 1200

FLAT TRACK BULLY (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced in restricted room and was held up and unable to improve for some distance passing the 200 metres.

LOCK UP (L Satherley) - Began awkwardly.

MIGHTY CASTLE (V Colgan) - Made contact with LOCK UP leaving the barriers. Raced wide without cover throughout.

APERITIF (T Mitchell) – Skied its head when over-racing passing the 1000 metres.

TINY TERROR (K Hannan) - Lay in near the 150 metres having to be corrected by its rider.

GNASHER (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded having to be steadied passing the 150 metres. When questioned regarding the performance rider A Lawson-Carroll advised that the gelding would appreciate looser track conditions.

LADY DE WINTER (E Bragg) - Finished well back. When questioned regarding the performance rider E Bragg could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 iLINE CARPENTERS MAIDEN 2100

IRISH MOONSHINE (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ACAPULCO (E Nicholas) – Reared at the start losing ground. Improved wide from the 1200 metres.

MIDNIGHT (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly shifting outwards leaving the barriers.

BEAU ARCHERS ROSE (L Douglas) - Over-raced in the early stages.

REASONTORETIRE (K Hercock) – Lay out passing the 600 metres and continued to lay out in the final straight.

A Lawson-Carroll (THE BAMBINO) - Issued with a warning after he directed his mount outwards when insufficiently clear of ACAPULCO passing the 800 metres.

Race 6 ILINE PRECONSTRUCTION AND DESIGN 2100

TAHUROA HEIGHT (A Lawson-Carroll) – Began awkwardly.

CHARRED (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly.

RODOLFO (K Hercock) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

ZA'FARAN (V Colgan) - Raced keenly passing the 1700 metres having to be restrained.

FORTUNE WINGS (T Mitchell) – Commenced to give ground passing the 700 metres and was not persevered with. When questioned regarding the performance rider T Mitchell advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's holding track conditions.

ATA RANGI (D Danis) - When questioned regarding the performance rider D Danis advised that the gelding was unsuited to the track conditions which he described as very holding.

DAWN JESSIE (E Leighton) – Briefly held up entering the home straight.

Race 7 ILINE WAIKATO 1600

MILLENNIUM DAWN (L Satherley) - Slow to begin.

NASHA RIVA (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly.

MUSIGNY LASS (A Lawson-Carroll) - Over-raced when leading in the early stages. Became unbalanced passing the 600 metres.

SO GORGEOUS (C Grylls) - Over-raced in the early stages.

BULLYBROOK (E Bragg) - Over-raced passing the 800 metres having to be restrained when awkwardly placed on heels.

Race 8 ILINE CLIENTS 1600

CHASE 'N' GOLD (D Prastiyou) - Stood in the barriers as the start was affected losing ground (3L).

HIT THE SWITCH (E Nicholas) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide without cover before being allowed to stride forward to lead near the 900 metres.

LEGIT (A Goindasamy) – Jumped inwards leaving the barriers making contact with BUGATTI. Finished well back. When questioned regarding the performance rider A Goindasamy advised that the gelding had hung throughout when unsuited to the holding track conditions. A Goindasamy was shown video footage and spoken to advisedly for using his whip on a runner that is out of contention.

BUGATTI (C Grylls) - Contacted leaving the barriers.

RENEGADE FIGHTER (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

GO YOU GOOD THING (J Fawcett) - Over-raced in the early stages.

SEEUINABIT (S Spratt) - Over-raced in the early stages. Shifted out when being steadied hampering THE FIRST LINK which was improving to its outside near the 1300 metres. THE FIRST LINK continued to over-race for some distance.

CHARLOTTE AMALIE (L Satherley) – Lay out and away from HIT THE SWITCH when both runners shifted ground under pressure in the final straight.

Race 9 ILINE CONSULTANTS AND PROFESSIONALS 1400

MISTER ROQUETTE (D Danis) - Late scratched at 2.00 pm due to transport difficulties.

MRS BIG (E Bragg) - Stood in the barriers as the start was affected losing ground (6L).

MAGDALA (M Kareem) - Began awkwardly losing ground,

INDEEM (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room passing the 50 metres.

DAWN PARADE (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly. Lay in over the concluding stages. Rider O Bosson was reminded of his obligations to straighten his mount at the earliest opportunity in future.

BUNKERS (A Lawson-Carroll) – Over raced in the early stages.

DEEBEE ZAPOWER (V Colgan) - Lay out under pressure in the final straight. Rider V Colgan was reminded of his obligations in that he must straighten his mount at the earliest opportunity in future.

Following the race, C Ormsby trainer of the 2nd placed horse INDEEM viewed Stewards footage of the final straight before electing not to proceed with a protest.
