RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 1550

SET IN STONE (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly.

KING MANDALO (A Goindasamy) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from the outside barrier.

OUR WONDERLAND (B Rogerson) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

FIVE SCHILLINGS (K Asano) - Got its head up when being steadied to avoid the heels of UP 'N' GONE which shifted inwards when not fully clear near the 1100 metres. C Grylls was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

CAPISTRANO ROCS (L Satherley) - Held up from the 600 metres and did not obtain clear running until near the 200 metres.

DEVOTED (O Bosson) – When questioned regarding the performance rider O Bosson could offer no explanation.

Race 2

CAMBRIDGE VOLUNTEER FIRE BRIGADE MAIDEN 1300

GOLDBURG (E Nicholas) - Slow away. Raced wide without cover throughout and ran very wide rounding the final bend after initially being taken out by THE CHROME NUN. Rider E Nicholas was shown video footage of her ride in the presence of the Riding Mentor.

SUPER WRAITH (A Goindasamy) – Jumped away awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance rider A Goindasamy advised that his mount was unsuited to the fast early tempo.

GAME PATROL (J Riddell) - Hampered shortly after leaving the barriers when STAR TRAIL shifted outwards after being contacted by THE CHROME NUN.

RISING RISK (V Colgan) – Over-raced in the early stages.

INDULGE ME (K Hercock) - Had to be steadied near the 1000 metres, losing ground, with rider K Hercock advising that the gelding had raced ungenerously when racing in tight quarters.

THE CHROME NUN (S Spratt) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

FAYE'S WARRIOR (T Newman) – Held up rounding the final bend.

CONTENTIOUS (D Prastiyou) - Finished last. When questioned regarding the performance rider D Prastiyou could offer no explanation. Trainer J McIlroy advised Stewards that upon return to her stable the mare was showing signs of being jarred up.

Race 3

GROUP ONE TURF BAR 1300

EL COOLIO (D Danis) - Slow to begin before being further hampered by EASY PEASY which shifted inwards leaving the barriers. Raced ungenerously through the middle stages.

VIRGINIA REEL (K Hercock) - Slow away.

IRISH ODDS (A Goindasamy) - Slow away.

DEAR OH DEAR (J Riddell) - Jumped away awkwardly.

KELLY KEEPER (C Lindsay) – Held up rounding the final bend.

LADY KOVAL (E Nicholas) - Over-raced through the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance of the unplaced favourite rider E Nicholas reported that the mare had over-raced which proved detrimental to its chances. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

OPAEA JOE (J Kamaruddin) – Raced three wide without cover.

Race 4 | **AP GOLLAN PROPERTY VALUERS 1550**

DUNEAGLE (O Bosson) - Slow away. Hung outwards rounding the final bend and continued to do so throughout the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance of the unplaced favourite, rider O Bosson reported that the gelding had hung throughout which proved detrimental to its chances.

TARWYN (K Hercock) - Slow away.

SUPERETTE (C Barnes) – Over-raced for a distance passing the 1300 metres.

LASER’S FURY (C Grylls) – Held up rounding the final bend.

MONZA (E Leighton) - Rider dropped her right rein just prior to the finish line.

Race 5 | **RICHARD BRIGHT MEMORIAL CUP 1550**

SUPREME KHAN (O Bosson) – Jumped away awkwardly. Steadied off heels near the 1000 metres when runners either side had shifted ground when not fully clear. Both D Danis & L Satherley were advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. When questioned regarding the performance rider O Bosson advised that the gelding had got further back than intended and had been unable to recover.

HEART OF GOLD (L Satherley) - Slow away. Shifted outwards passing the 1000 metres when not fully clear of SUPREME KHAN placing that runner in restricted room having to be steadied off heels.

THE MIGHTY SPAR (J Kamaruddin) – Slow away. Had to be steadied away from heels near the 1000 metres when the pace eased. Placed in restricted room inside the final 50 metres.

DAZZLING MISS (K Hannan) - Raced wide without cover. Lay in passing the 50 metres placing THE MIGHTY SPAR in restricted room.

NO ROCK NO POP (A Mudhoo) – Raced very wide throughout.

TIVAAN WARRIOR (S Spratt) - Over-raced through the early stages when racing outside the leader. When questioned regarding the performance rider S Spratt reported that the mare would be better suited back in distance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a superficial wound on left hind heel.

ALPHA CHARLIE (E Nicholas) – Commenced to over-race near the 1200 metres having to be firmly restrained for a distance when awkwardly placed near the heels of TIVAAN WARRIOR.

LILY D’OR (D Danis) - Shifted inwards passing the 1000 metres when not fully clear of SUPREME KHAN and simultaneously HEART OF GOLD shifted ground outwards which placed SUPREME KHAN in restricted room.

RED VIENNA (K Asano) – Over-raced through the middle stages.

SAGUNTO (E Leighton) – Raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres.

Race 6 | **REMEMBERING CFO DON GERRAND QSM MAIDEN 970**

SWISSABEEL (C Lindsay) - Jumped away awkwardly getting its head up. Trainer A Smith advised that the mare would likely be retired.

FEEL THE THUNDER (E Nicholas) - Jumped away awkwardly. Raced very wide rounding the bend.

ONE POWER (M Sanson) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

AOIDE (K Hannan) - Lay out rounding the final bend and in the straight.

GIRLS LIGHT UP (K Asano) - Rider dropped his whip near the 300 metres.

BOSS BABY (S Spratt) - Finished last. When questioned regarding the performance rider S Spratt reported the mare was unsuited to the synthetic track.

R Beemud (KIVA HAN) - Issued with a warning after he weighed in 0.4 kgs under the weight at which he weighed out at which was within the 0.5 kg tolerance allowed under Rule 648(3).

Race 7

WAIPA EARTHWORKS MAIDEN 2000

MISTER PUCCI (D Danis) - Slow away.

JACK HAMMER (J Riddell) - Slow away. When questioned regarding the performance of the unplaced favourite rider J Riddell reported that the gelding had travelled well but when placed under pressure had failed to respond. Co-Trainer C Murray was spoken to and advised that the gelding had some history of wind issues which will be followed up with the stable.

THEGEEWAGON (J Kamaruddin) - Jumped away awkwardly.

BROTHER MAX (T Mitchell) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

MYTURN (C Barnes) - Raced ungenerously when being steadied off the heels of PINION near the 1800 metres.

BAYLANDER (C Grylls) – Raced wide in the early stages.
