**ALL ASHORE (C Campbell)** – Co-trainer Mr. S Anderton advised Stewards, ALL ASHORE, has been retired from racing.

## RACE COMMENTS

**Race 1** | **ALLEVIATE ADMINISTRATION MAIDEN 2200m**

**BAILADOR** (R Mudhoo) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from a wide draw. Rider advised in his opinion the gelding had not backed up from its previous run last Saturday.

**NELLIE GREY** (G Jogoo) - Lost the near hind racing plate passing the 700 metres.

**KNOWICAN** (C Campbell) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

**VITAL PERFECTION** (D Montes de Oca) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which D Montes de Oca used his whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had contravened the rules.

**RAARDY RAAR** (J Laking) - When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance trainer M Price advised Stewards the gelding had been looking for more ground and was aided by a positive front running ride today.

**Race 2** | **ONE SMART COFFEE / HIREWORX OAMARU 1400m**

**OUR CLARRY** (R Beeharry) - Began awkwardly.

**SPINDLESHANKS** (R Mudhoo) - Bumped shortly after the start becoming briefly unbalanced.

**SPLENDIOR** (C Campbell) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

**THE GROWLER** (T Moseley) - Held up rounding the final bend and had to be restrained off heels passing the 300 metres when badly held up by a tiring runner.

**KING COUGAR** (M Taylor) - When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner the rider could offer no tangible excuse.

**Race 3** | **NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY / DELECTABLES BAKERY OAMARU 1200m**

**REENVEST** (M Taylor) - Slow to begin.

**CHEYENNE DREAMS** (S Muniandy) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Lay inwards early in the run home. Lost the off-hind racing plate during the running.

**A BOX OF TRICKS** (K Williams) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 250 metres.

**MIDNIGHT JANE** (T Moseley) - Crowded passing the 250 metres when CHEYENNE DREAMS lay inwards at this point. S Muniandy was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion. When asked to comment on the performance rider could offer no tangible excuses with the mare only battling over the concluding stages.

**Race 4** | **HONEYWILL CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1600m**

**CARDINAL** (D Montes de Oca) - Late scratching at 2.29pm when refusing to load. Connections were advised the gelding must barrier trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to racing next.

**TAURIMA** (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly. Gave ground from the 700 metres when under pressure.

**CEEDOUBLEJAY** (J Laking) - Crowded shortly after the start. Rider reported the gelding had made abnormal breathing noises during the running. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had a high heart rate and slow recovery. Stewards will follow up with connections in the coming days.

**AMATERASU** (K Williams) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

**Race 5** | **CONGRATULATIONS WESTCOAST AND WILLIAMSONS WINNING THE GRAND NATIONAL STEEPLECHASE 1600m**

**VALYRIAN** (D Montes de Oca) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after presenting with blood present in its mouth and was cleared to start.

**A LITTLE VAGUE** (K Mudhoo) - Began very awkwardly losing considerable ground.

**BELLA DORA** (M Taylor) - Slow to begin and tailed the field for the majority of the race despite the efforts of its rider. Rider advised the mare had not responded to her riding in the early and middle stages and been under pressure throughout, however in her opinion had then finished the race off fairly, making some ground in the run home after getting well back off the leaders.

**OUR TEDDY BOY** (S Toolooa) - Over-raced in the early stages.

**RITA HAYWORTH** (S Wynne) - Lay out in the run home. Stewards inquired into the manner in which S Wynne used her whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that she had contravened the rules.

**JESSIE'S ROCK** (C Barnes) - Rider advised that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's testing track conditions however would take natural benefit from the first up run following a brief spell.

**DIOR ROSETTA** (M Taylor) - Blundered leaving the barriers.

**LEA** (C Campbell) - Slow to begin.

**HALLOWING COMMANDS** (S Wynne) - Slow to begin. Lay in throughout the run home.

**JAMIESON'S TIPPLE** (B Murray) - Over-raced in the early stages.

**DONNA RICA** (S Muniandy) - Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.

**MR MISTER** (C Johnson) - Not persevered with in the run home after being well beaten. Rider reported that the gelding had hung throughout and not handled today's testing track conditions.

**SLINKY LINKY** (S Toolooa) - Rider reported that the mare had not been comfortable in today's testing track conditions.
