RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 STALLION TENDER OPEN NOW 1600m

ARE YOU CEREAL (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing some ground.

ROAD TO REIGN (T Jonker) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover.

EULOGY SHOW (G Jogoo) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages.

JIN LU (T Moseley) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary inspection JIN LU was confirmed to have bled. JIN LU shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race or Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian. Trainer L Didham advised Stewards it is now his intention to retire the gelding from racing.

Race 2 ROAD TO JERICHO QUALIFIER 22 OCTOBER MAIDEN 1400m

R Didham (VICKEZZROSE) - Issued with a warning after presenting VICKEZZROSE without notified gear (tongue tie).

DICELAND (B Murray) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection at the barriers and was cleared to race after being kicked at the start area. Not persevered with over the concluding stages when well beaten, with rider B Murray advising the mare had not travelled well throughout the running and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

KIZ (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly shifting out contacting HIGHLAND FLING. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Rider reported the mare had made abnormal breathing sounds during the running. A post-race veterinary inspection did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer M McCann advised Stewards it is his intention to apply a tongue tie prior to the mare's next raceday start.

HIGHLAND FLING (J Laking) - Contacted at the start.

COVARCHI (L Allpress) - Slow into stride. Held up rounding the final turn and had trouble obtaining clear running early in the run home. Inclined to race greenly throughout the final straight.

TAIL LIGHTS (K Chowdhoory) - Got its head up when being restrained to obtain cover in the early stages. Lay in through the run home.

VICKEZZROSE (T Moseley) - Held up entering the final bend having to shift outwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

Race 3 ELLIE STOKES TRUST CHARITY DINNER 22/09 MAIDEN 1200m

CHEX MY NONO (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

STOLEN DECREE (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly making contact with PEN TO PAPER losing ground as a result.

PEN TO PAPER (C Barnes) - Contacted at the start then got its head up when racing keenly into the bend near the 1000 metres.

Race 4 NZ INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1200m

QUIXOTIC (G Jogoo) - Began awkwardly and raced greenly throughout. Made the bend awkwardly near the 800 metres, with the rider reporting the mare had hung outwards throughout the running.

SATELLITE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

LIGHTNING RIDGE (B May) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

PEACE LOVER (K Williams) - Over raced in the early and middle stages. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the run home.

LUCYBELLE (W Papier) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

Race 5 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO SI RACING AWARDS 1200m

CAMPIONESSA (C Barnes) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with ZOULUMINOUS losing ground as a result.

MEGALOMANIAC (L Allpress) - Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which revealed the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance is now required prior to MEGALOMANIAC trialling or racing next.

FIRST ROCK (S Toolooa) - Lost the near front plate during the running. When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider could offer no tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed the mare to be getting down on both hind bumpers.

Race 6 FEATURE RACES NOMINATIONS CLOSE 30 AUGUST 1200m

OUR ROSETTE (D Montes de Oca) - Slow to begin.

VINO BELLA (C Barnes) - Slow to begin and further hampered losing ground when LORNA DOON shifted in shortly after the start. Held up early in the run home only gaining clear racing room inside the final 250 metres.

OUR CLARRY (Y Atchamah) - Crowded shortly after the start having to shift ground inwards and when doing so made contact with the rail.

INVINCIBEEL (T Moseley) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

CAUSE CELEBRE (B May) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the gelding had hung throughout. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a slow recovery rate.

MAKE BELIEVE (L Allpress) - Raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres when IRISH RED shifted in under pressure. J Laking was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 7 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 2200m

J Laking (RED SUNDAY) - Issued with a fine of \$200 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after failing to make the contracted weight for RED SUNDAY and was replaced by B Murray.

DIAMOND RIVIERE (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

ARABIA (S Wynne) - Jumped outwards at the start crowding its outside runner.

STAR VISTA (L Allpress) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

RED SUNDAY (B Murray) - Raced three wide in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no tangible excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary inspection which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

JILDI JILDI (A Balloo) - Lay out under pressure with the rider reporting the mare had hung throughout.

B Murray (RED SUNDAY) - Reminded of his obligations regarding his whip use behind the barriers.
