

SUPPLEMENTARY

Canterbury Jockey Club @ Riccarton Park - Thursday, 25 August 2022 Race 5 - CHRISTCHURCH CASINO SI RACING AWARDS 1200m

MEGALOMANIAC (L Allpress) – Trainer Mr A Carston advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, however it has now been sent for a spell.

FIRST ROCK (S Toolooa) – Trainer R Didham reported to Stewards that FIRST ROCK underwent a veterinary examination on Friday 26 August which included x-rays, with results showing slight swelling to the near front fetlock. R Didham further advised that the mare has been rested this week, however will look to return FIRST ROCK to track work once the swelling subsides.

Race 6 - FEATURE RACES NOMINATIONS CLOSE 30 AUGUST 1200m

CAUSE CELEBRE (B May) – Trainer Mr P Harris advised Stewards that he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, and it is his intention to continue on with CAUSE CELEBRE'S current preparation where he will be nominated for the Canterbury Jockey Club meeting on Saturday 3 September.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 CLEAN UP CANTERBURY 2000m

SULU SEA (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (S Toolooa) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover from a wide draw.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (A Balloo) - Over raced in the early stages.

ENOUGH SAID (M McNab) - Lay out under pressure near the 250 metres having to be corrected. When questioned regarding performance, rider was of the opinion the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer M Cunneen confirmed that ENOUGH SAID had come to the end of its preparation and would be spelled.

Race 2 PRYDES EASIFEED 1200m

CASAQUINMAN (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

SACRED GIANT (M McNab) - Began awkwardly.

BENAUD (D Montes de Oca) - Shifted inwards at the start crowding REDFORD and then restrained from a wide draw to obtain cover. Angled wider on the track passing the 400 metres to find clear racing room.

REDFORD (J Laking) - Crowded at the start.

FOUR QUEENS (T Moseley) - Held up early in the run home and when shifting ground near the 375 metres contacted IFFRAAJABLE which in turn made contact with the hindquarters of IRISH RED which was unbalanced. T Moseley was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

IFFRAAJABLE (M Taylor) - Contacted near the 375 metres and in turn made contact with IRISH RED.

IRISH RED (J Kamaruddin) - Hindquarters contacted becoming unbalanced passing the 375 metres.

AVAQUINELLA (K Chowdhoory) - Held up for a short distance approaching the 200 metres.

The track was upgraded to Soft 6 following this race.

Race 3 MURRAY GILLANDERS MEMORIAL 3YO 1000m

TURF WAR (T Moseley) - The start was delayed when TURF WAR refused to load being declared a late scratching at 1.55pm. Connections were advised that TURF WAR must barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing again.

MADAME GISELLE (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near the heels of SHAZZA coming off the junction and re-joining the course proper running rail approaching the 600 metres. Held up early in the run home then being disappointed for a run to the inside of SHAZZA near the 250 metres, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 150 metres.

PEACEMAKER (C Barnes) - Shifted outwards at the start making firm contact with FOREVER BABE. Clipped a heel and blundered losing ground shortly after the start.

FOREVER BABE (L Callaway) - Contacted at the start then lay inwards, with the trailing PEACEMAKER clipping heels and blundering. Raced greenly throughout.

THATS CHARMING (K Williams) - Began awkwardly making contact with GRACE 'N' GREY. Was inclined to get its head up when being restrained in the early stages.

REDMOND (Y Atchamah) - Over raced in the early to middle stages.

SHAZZA (M Taylor) - Inclined to lay outwards throughout.

DAYZEE DIOR (C Campbell) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the straight.

 Race 4
 ELLIE STOKES TRUST CHARITY DINNER 22 SEPTEMBER 1000m

 SUNLIT LANE (C Barnes) - Slow away.

O'JUDE (S Toolooa) - Steadied to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier.

J Kamaruddin (DANCARINA) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when under pressure over the concluding stages when not fully clear of RHONDA WOOD.

Race 5 PAULINE JEFFS HANDICAP 1000m

LOVE SQUIRRELS (M Taylor) - Very fractious in the barriers and jumped away awkwardly.

SUMMER MONSOON (M McNab) - Began awkwardly. Lost the left front plate during the running. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the straight.

RAPOSA RAPIDA (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

KHIMAR WAR (J Laking) - When questioned regarding performance, rider advised that resuming from a spell today the gelding had been trapped wide and would benefit from the run.

Race 6 CHRISTCHURCH CASINO SI RACING AWARDS 1800m

A LITTLE VAGUE (G Jogoo) - Bounded at the start losing ground.

BELLA DORA (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

KENKI (B May) - Slow to begin.

CAGE PHYTA (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover through the early stages.

YEAH RIGHT (T Moseley) - Over raced in the early stages and had to be heavily restrained away from heels near the 1300 metres, shifting outwards hampering HEY MICKEY. Continued to race keenly in the run down the back straight placing the rider in difficulty for some distance then crowded near the 1100 metres when DAY LIGHT, which was also over racing, shifted outwards to avoid the heels of FAH LUN simultaneously as HEY MICKEY was improving tight to the outside of YEAH RIGHT.

HEY MICKEY (M Taylor) - Hampered 1300 metres. Raced wide without cover from the 1100 metres.

BOB MARLIE (K Mudhoo) - Held up early in the straight.

M Taylor (HEY MICKEY) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount HEY MICKEY seven times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$500.

A Balloo (EULOGY SHOW) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount EULOGY SHOW twelve times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of A Balloo's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Friday 9 September until the conclusion of racing on Friday 23 September, 10 national riding days.

Due to the nature of today's breach and A Balloo's record of whip breaches, he was directed by the Stewards to meet with an NZTR appointed rider skills review panel under the provisions of Rule 343.

Race 7 CUP WEEK TICKETS ON SALE NOW HANDICAP 1600m

The start of the race was delayed when two horses were loaded into incorrect barriers which was rectified prior to the start.

WILLIAM WALLACE (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

DRAGON STORM (K Mudhoo) - Shifted outwards abruptly at the start contacting FIRODEN which then made contact with the hindquarters of VERMONT with both these runners becoming briefly unbalanced.

FIRODEN (C Campbell) - Bumped at the start and unbalanced.

VERMONT (S Wynne) - Bumped at the start and unbalanced.

WANNABE 'N' PARIS (D Montes de Oca) - Contacted leaving the barriers then shifting outwards making firm contact with DRAGON STORM. Raced in restricted room for a distance near the 1000 metres. Crowded between ASATHOUGHT and VERMONT near the 600 metres when weakening. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination after dropping out to finish a distant last which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

FRANKIE THE FOX (R Mudhoo) - Raced in restricted room for a distance going into the bend passing the 1100 metres to the inside of WANNABE 'N' PARIS which initially shifted away from WHALE SONG. FRANKIE THE FOX and WANNABE 'N' PARIS then continued to race in restricted room for a distance to the inside of WHALE SONG passing the 1000 metres.

HUNTER VILLAIN (K Williams) - Steadied when improving onto the heels of SOUTHERN OCEAN passing the 1000 metres.

ASATHOUGHT (J Laking) - Had to shift ground passing the 125 metres to find clear racing room.

C Campbell (FIRODEN) - Reprimanded for the manner in which he used his whip during the loading process.

K Chowdhoory (WHALE SONG) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount WHALE SONG to shift inwards near the 1000 metres placing WANNABE 'N' PARIS and FRANKIE THE FOX in restricted room for a distance.

Race 8 RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1400m

T Rae (ASTRAKHAN) - Fined \$50 under the Minor Infringement Schedule after presenting ASTRAKHAN without the notified blinkers.

FINAL SAVINGS (M Taylor) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

INVINCIBEEL (J Kamaruddin) - Jumped away awkwardly and shifted inwards making contact with STAN WITH ME losing ground. Steadied when becoming awkwardly placed near heels approaching the 1000 metres. Held up early in the straight.

VICTOR ROUGE (T Moseley) - Lay out away from inside runners leaving the barriers contacting STAN WITH ME. Got its head up and made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly.

STAN WITH ME (L Callaway) - Hampered when contacted leaving the barriers due to movement from runners to either side.

ROBBIE BURNS (K Chowdhoory) - Hampered shortly after the start. Rider could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance of this favoured runner.

JUSTFIXIT WULDYA (D Montes de Oca) - Over raced passing the 1000 metres having to be steadied and shift outwards to avoid the heels of EL TIRADOR.

ASTRAKHAN (M McNab) - When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that the mare had travelled well but when placed under pressure had failed to respond.

GLOBAL BEAUTY (C Barnes) - Rider advised she had been disappointed with the effort of the mare today, adding that her mount may not have handled the holding track conditions.
