RACE COMMENTS	
Race 1	SPEEDY SIGNS MAIDEN 2100
GRAND PROSPECT (A Mudhoo) - Over-raced and had to be steadied near the 1600 metres. Raced wide for the majority of the event. Lay in and had to be straightened on several occasions throughout the home straight.	

FABULOUS NANCY (L Douglas) - Over-raced and had to be steadied passing the winning post on the first occasion.

LA'JACINDA (M Singh) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages before weakening and finished some distance last. Connections advised Stewards that the mare's future was in jumping, nevertheless a warning has been placed on LA'JACINDA'S competitiveness.

C Dell (KENTUCKY BOY) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount KENTUCKY BOY 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 24 September until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday, 28 September, 2 national riding days, and in addition imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 2 | **THE TELE OTAKI 3YO MAIDEN 1200**

Co-Trainer J Benner was issued with a warning for presenting O'RIORDAN without the required pre-race ear covers.
O'RIORDAN (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly, bumping BOASTING.

BOASTING (T Taiaroa) - Bumped at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout.

COLORADO SILVER (M McNab) - Slow away. Held up rounding the final bend.

SCELTA DI ELENA (A Mudhoo) - Raced greenly near the 350 metres placing MR TWINKLETOES in restricted room

MR TWINKLETOES (F Lazet) - Improved into a marginal gap near the 350 metres, then placed in restricted room, having to be steadied and angled outwards across heels to gain clear racing room passing the 150 metres.

MISS BONNY ROSE (T Allan) - Lay out near the 350 metres.

Race 3 | **EL CHEAPO CARS HANDICAP 1200**

EAGLE COUNTY (T Taiaroa) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after an incident in the stabling area, and was cleared to start. Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

PULL NO PUNCHES (F Lazet) - Hampered at the start when runners either side shifted ground, settling at the rear. Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider advised that after getting back at the start, the gelding was unable to improve under the top weight.

ICONIC LASS (A Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly, hampering PULL NO PUNCHES. Rider dropped his whip near the 300 metres.

WINSTON (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly, hampering PULL NO PUNCHES.

MOCHATINI (M McNab) - Over-raced when being restrained near the 1000 metres.

Race 4 | **AQUASHIELD ROOFING MAIDEN 1600**

OPAL SPIRIT (M Hudson) - Commenced to buck for a short distance briefly after the start. Connections were advised a warning has been placed on the gelding's racing manners. Lost the near front plate during the running.

MADAM RAZIA (L Douglas) - Slow away.

WENEDASHOCK (K Hercock) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

EDDIE'S DREAM (M Singh) - Raced greenly in the home straight.

<p>WINNIE ROSE (L Allpress) - Slow away. Steadied off heels near the 800 metres. Lay in having to be straightened near the 300 metres.</p> <p>MANOLO (T Taiaroa) - Slow away. Steadied off heels near the 700 metres. Held up rounding the final bend, gaining clear racing room passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>BATTLE SECRET (M Hudson) - Slow away. Lay out near the 450 metres.</p> <p>QUEEN OF SPADES (M McNab) - Made the final bend awkwardly. Lay out over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 6	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE 1600
<p>MIZZENA (F Lazet) - Slow away.</p> <p>IRISH ODDS (J Mudhoo) - Slow away. Raced wide through the early and middle stages. Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider advised the mare was not suited to today's track conditions.</p> <p>REGAL ROCK (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LINCOLN LOVER (M McNab) - Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider advised the mare had pulled up in a normal post-race condition and could offer no excuses.</p>	
Race 7	HARCOURTS OTAKI HANDICAP 1600
<p>TOBKAY (A Mudhoo) - Over-raced when wide throughout. When questioned rider advised the gelding had little left at the finish and in his opinion would prefer looser footing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Connections advised they would monitor TOBKAY over coming days and report any anomaly to Stewards.</p> <p>RISING RANSOM (L Sutherland) - Held up rounding the final bend, having to angle inwards near the 250 metres to gain clear racing room.</p> <p>BERRY THE CASH (C Dell) - Lay out over the concluding stages.</p> <p>V Jalalkuncha (MONKEY TOWN) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount MONKEY TOWN 7 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today, 15 September, up to and including racing on Friday, 23 September, 6 national riding days.</p>	
Race 8	VETS ON RIVERBANK HANDICAP 1400
<p>ROSCHANA (K Hannan) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Dictated wider passing the 150 metres when PINKERTON (C Dell) shifted wider on the track than intended. C Dell was advised that he is expected to straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.</p> <p>IF YOU DANCE (T Taiaroa) - Performed below market expectations. Rider advised that after the gelding had been taken wide on the turn, had failed to run on to any extent.</p>
