#### **RACE COMMENTS**

### Race 1 WWW.WARRIORS.KIWI 1200

SIX CHOUXTA (M Kareem) - Slow to begin.

**EAGLE TARZAN** (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly. Placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres and again just prior to the winning post.

**KHUFU** (V Colgan) - Raced wide in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Connections advised that the gelding would not be persevered with as a racing proposition from his stable.

**FASHION SHOOT** (O Bosson) – Over-raced in the early stages.

**VISTOWN** (A Lawson-Carroll) – Over-raced in the early stages. Improved onto heels approaching the 450 metres having to be steadied.

SHE'S APPLES (W Pinn) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

**GWEN STEPHANI** (K Hannan) - Placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres and again just prior to the winning post.

**O Bosson** (FASHION SHOOT) – Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of ANGE DE REVE which was forced inwards placing GWEN STEPHANI and EAGLE TARZAN passing the 100 metres.

**E Nicholas** (ANGE DE REVE) - Issued with a warning after allowing her mount to shift inwards placing GWEN STEPHANI and EAGLE TARZAN in restricted room over the concluding stages.

Following the running of this race connections of the 4<sup>th</sup> placed horse GWEN STEPHANI viewed Stewards footage before electing not to proceed with a protest.

#### Race 2 BIDDING ENDS MONDAY ON GAVELHOUSE.COM 1200

MR UNIVERSE (S Spratt) - Slow to begin.

**OSELETA** (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly.

**PAISLEY PARK** (M Kareem) – Raced wide in the early to middle stages.

#### Race 3 FAIRVIEW MOTORS MAIDEN HURDLE (2800 metres)

**OBRIGADO** (D Parker) - Slow to begin. Misjudged the third to last fence.

**GINGEE** (T Moki) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**TAUMALOLO** (H McNeill) - Hampered passing the 2400 metres when placed in restricted room to the inside of GINGEE which was over-racing. Hampered as a result was the trailing MAJOR TOM. Hit the fence near the 900 metres and blundered on landing.

**MAJOR TOM** (M Cropp) – Improved onto heels passing the 1650 metres having to be firmly restrained. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

**CRIMEA** (S Karnicnik) – Raced wide throughout. Retired from the race prior to jumping the last three fences.

**DEVOTED** (E Farr) – Misjudged the third to last fence.

**ZABDI** (K Joyce) - Retired from the race prior to jumping the last three fences.

### Race 4 PETER KELLY – BAYLEYS GREAT NORTHERN HURDLE (4200 metres)

INTERLLECTUS (S Fannin) - Jumped indifferently throughout.

**KAJINO** (S Phelan) – Misjudged the 7<sup>th</sup> fence. Contacted just prior to jumping the 3<sup>rd</sup> to last fence.

BANKS ROAD (E Farr) - Was inclined to run its fences down throughout.

**PHELAN FOXY** (G Walsh) – Jumped indifferently throughout. Pulled up prior to jumping the final three fences. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**NEDWIN** (A Kuru) - Hit the fence near the 900 metres losing ground. Shifted outwards just prior to jumping the 3<sup>rd</sup> to last fence making contact with KAJINO. Then misjudged that fence landing awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the gelding would have benefitted from more rain affected footing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**IZYMYDAAD** (M Roustoby) – Retired from the race prior to jumping the last three fences.

**JAKAMA KRYSTAL** (M Cropp) - Hit the last fence and fell dislodging its rider and in doing so inconvenienced ELUSIVE ACE. M Cropp was uninjured. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to have blood present in both nostrils consistent with head trauma. Connections were advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

**ELUSIVE ACE** (S Karnicnik) – Hampered by the riderless horse after jumping the last fence unbalancing the rider.

**ABU DHABI** (H McNeill) – Lay out when placed under pressure passing the 150 metres finishing wide on the track.

### Race 5 BGP BATTLERS CUP (2400 metres)

ATA RANGI (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.

**LATE TO THE PARTY** (C Grylls) – Raced three wide throughout.

**S Phelan** (ENCHANTED ELLE) - Presented the mare to race with the incorrect saddle cloth with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$50.

### Race 6 TE AROHA JOCKEY CLUB STALLION SERVICE SCHEME STEEPLECHASE (3900 metres)

TELL ME MORE (D Parker) - Slow to begin.

LEICA WARRIOR (R Leech) - Began awkwardly. Misjudged the fence near the 1000 metres unbalancing its rider.

ITISWHATITIS (S Karnicnik) – Began awkwardly. Jumped indifferently throughout. Fell after jumping the fence near the 1000 metres, dislodging its rider. S Karnicnik was attended to by the oncourse Doctor and cleared to fulfil his remaining ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be lame in the left foreleg along with having bled from both nostrils. ITISWHATITIS shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a veterinarian.

LOCALLY SAUCED (G Walsh) - Dipped on landing after jumping the first fence, unbalancing its rider.

**SUFFICE TO SAY** (A Kuru) – Misjudged the fence near the 800 metres.

# Race 7 BEN FOOTE RACING GREAT NORTHERN STEEPLECHASE (6500 metres)

**NO TIP** (S Phelan) - Slow to begin. Hampered after jumping the fence leaving the straight on the 2<sup>nd</sup> occasion. Pulled up quickly after crossing the line and was immediately dismounted being led off the track. Was immediately attended to by the oncourse veterinarian and was found to be suffering from dehydration and exhaustion, receiving the appropriate veterinary treatment.

DONARDO (H McNeill) - Began awkwardly. Misjudged the fence near the 1400 metres on the last occasion.

MAGIC CANNON (E Farr) - Hung out in the early stages. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**MAGIC WONDER** (A Kuru) - Misjudged the fence near the 1000 metres on the first occasion. Badly misjudged the first fence in the centre on the final occasion, unbalancing its rider who lost the right iron for a short distance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found a minor laceration to the sternum.

**COCONUT** (S Karnicnik) - Jumped indifferently throughout. Put in a poor jump at the fence leaving the straight on the  $2^{nd}$  occasion hampering NO TIP. Pulled up prior to jumping the final fence.

THE ANARCHIST (D Parker) - Rider dropped his whip passing the 150 metres.

#### Race 8 VODAFONE WARRIORS 1400

**INDEEM** (E Nicholas) - Slow to begin. Improved forward wide without cover from near the 800 metres.

MONZA (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide throughout.

**SUPERETTE** (M Hashizume) - Over-raced in the early stages.

**SUPREME KHAN** (O Bosson) – Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

**OUTFIT** (McNab) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse.

## Race 9 WAIKATO STUD WINNERS CIRCLE MILE (1600 metres)

HINEPARA (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

**OCEAN BILLY** (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly.

**PRISE DE FER** (T Mitchell) - Raced wide in the early stages. Hindquarters contacted passing the 400 metres becoming unbalanced.

**CRYSTALLIZE** (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced wide in the early stages. Raced in restricted room passing the 400 metres contacting the hindquarters of PRISE DE FER which then lay in.

BULLYBROOK (E Bragg) - Hampered passing the 1150 metres.

EVEN CHANCE (S Spratt) - Made contact with the running rail passing the 700 metres.

TRUE ENOUGH (J Riddell) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running entering the final straight.

**FIELD OF GOLD** (M McNab) - Rider reported that when placed under pressure the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

**AMARELINHA** (O Bosson) - Rider reported that the mare had made abnormal breathing noises during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the mare to be lame in the left hind leg. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing next.

**M Kareem** (TIPTRONIC) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of BULLYBROOK which was hampered near the 1150 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of M Kareem's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 21 September up to and including racing on Sunday 25 September, 4 national riding days.

# Race 10 DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS MILE (1600 metres)

PLUSHENKO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

**GLORIFIED** (V Colgan) – Slow to begin.

**STELLA ECLIPSE** (S Weatherley) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

**ELECTRIC TIME** (S Spratt) – Raced keenly for a distance passing the 900 metres.

TICKLE ME ALMO (C Barnes) – Raced wide without cover from near the 800 metres.
