Cambridge Jockey Club – Wednesday, 3 August 2022

Race 9 – Martin Collins New Zealand 2000

(Heard at Te Rapa Racecourse Tuesday 27 September 2022)

S Weatherley – Defended a charge he did ride recklessly passing the 250-metre mark, in that he directed his mount 'JACK HAMMER' outwards making heavy contact with the hindquarters of 'GOODO JO' which was forced into the line of 'TE ATATU PASH', causing that runner to fall and dislodge the rider. After viewing all available film footage and hearing submissions the Adjudicative Committee found the charge to be proven imposing a suspension of S Weatherley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 1 October 2022 until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 3 December 2022, a period of nine weeks.

S Weatherley is also to be directed to meet with an NZTR Rider Skills Review Panel under the provisions of Rule 343.

Matamata Racing Club – Wednesday, 21 September 2022

Race 8 – GCM Feeds 1600

C Barnes (VADARA) - Admitted a charge in that she permitted her mount to shift outwards passing the 600 metres when insufficiently clear of DEEBEE BELFER (T Mitchell) which clipped a heel and fell dislodging its rider, as a result LOOSE MONEY (D Prastiyou) was brought down, dislodging its rider. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of C Barnes' licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 1 October up to and including racing on Saturday 29 October, 4 weeks.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | WAIPA EARTHWORKS MAIDEN 1550

OUR BO JAKK (T Thornton) – Slow to begin.

MASTER ORGETA (K Asano) – Slow to begin.

ROC DANCER (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced when wide in the early stages.

THE UPRISING (W Pinn) – Raced wide through the middle stages.

BRONTES GOLD (S Spratt) - Raced wide in the early stages before improving to race outside the leader passing the 1300 metres.

DELECTABLE (K Hannan) - Had to be steadied off the heels of SMOOTH PASS after improving into a position where there was insufficient room to do so passing the 1000 metres.

K Hannan (DELECTABLE) - Issued with a warning for allowing her mount to improve into a position to the inside of SMOOTH PASS when there was insufficient room to do so passing the 1000 metres.

Race 2 | CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL 1550

MIGHTY CONNOR (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

OXYGEN (L Satherley) – Raced wide in the early stages before improving to race outside the leader near the 1200 metres.

PAHI LASS (D Danis) - Raced wide in the early stages.

RUSAVY (A Lawson-Carroll) – Over-raced in the early stages.

KING FAROUK (S Spratt) – Over-raced near the 1000 metres being taken wider on the track to avoid the heels of ROCKET LAD. Lay in when placed under pressure near the 100 metres.

PENNY JANE (T Mitchell) - Had to be restrained off heels near the 100 metres when runners either side shifted ground.

WOLFGANG (S McKay) – Lay out when placed under pressure near the 100 metres.

Race 3 | EMBELLISH GR1 WINNER BY SAVABEEL MAIDEN 1300

CORBATIN (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Over-raced through the middle stages.

GOOD TIME GARRY (O Bosson) – Over-raced when being steadied in the early stages. Ducked in when being ridden forward with the whip near the 100 metres inconveniencing WAIHI WARRIOR, DELOREAN and MISTER ZIPPY.

MISTER ZIPPY (L Satherley) – Over-raced through the middle stages and had to be steadied off heels near the 1000 metres. Inconvenienced near the 100 metres.

DELOREAN (S Spratt) – Raced keenly through the middle stages before improving three wide near the 600 metres. Inconvenienced near the 100 metres.

WAIHI WARRIOR (T Newman) - Raced wide without cover from near the 1000 metres. Inconvenienced near the 100 metres.

Race 4 | **GROUP 1 TURF BAR MAIDEN 1300**

PRIDE OF PROISIR (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide in the early stages before improving to the lead approaching the 900 metres.

BAZOOKA (J Riddell) - Crowded at the start. Held up rounding the final bend.

ZIRCON (S Spratt) – Jumped outwards at the start. Over-raced in the early stages having to be restrained.

STRANGE LOVE (W Pinn) – Jumped outwards at the start hampering PROPOSAL. Over-raced through the middle stages having to be firmly restrained off heels. Held up rounding the final bend and early stages of the final straight.

PROPOSAL (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered at the start losing ground. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the early stages of the final straight.

SMUG (T Thornton) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from an outside barrier.

HASSTOBE PERFECT (V Colgan) – Began awkwardly then restrained to obtain cover in the early stages.

AYREON (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover from near the 1000 metres.

GOOD SOUL (L Satherley) – Over-raced through the middle stages.

Race 5 | **ALFRISTON 1300**

NO AGENDA NIGEL (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

MINI MYSTIC (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

FELIX FAURE (E Bragg) - Raced wide in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier before improving to the lead approaching the 1000 metres.

MR RAINBOW (T Mitchell) – Raced three wide without cover from the 800 metres.

DIVINE DUDE (B Rogerson) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

Race 6 | **THE RODMOR NO.2 CHARITABLE TRUST MAIDEN 970**

ALL A DREAM (L Satherley) - Late scratched at the barrier after refusing to load. Connections were advised that the mare would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

OH HERMANI (D Danis) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious in its barrier stall and was cleared fit to start. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

LET LOOSE (B Rogerson) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

THE HOUND (T Mitchell) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

FIZZY MOON (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced passing the 800 metres having to be steadied off heels.

SUPER WARRIOR (J Fawcett) - Shifted inwards leaving the barriers crowding inside runner. Raced wide in the early stages. Inconvenienced near the 150 metres by OH HERMANI which was laying out.

NANA'S WISH (A Goindasamy) – Raced wide throughout. Made the final bend awkwardly laying out having to be corrected by its rider and continued to lay out in the final straight.

Race 7 | **FORSMAN RACING MAIDEN 970**

RUBY SEEKER (L Satherley) - Slow to begin. Lay out rounding the final bend.

GET LIT (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly. Had to be restrained in the early stages. Over-raced through the early and middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly would benefit from the experience of having its first race day start and further added that it was difficult to make up ground given the fast last 600 metres.

COVERMEINSUNSHINE (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the early stages.

JUSTICE (T Thornton) - Held up for clear running rounding the final bend and early in the final straight before obtaining clear running near the 100 metres.

Race 8 | **CHAMPION 2YO SWORD OF STATE 2000**

GOODO JO (D Danis) - Began awkwardly hampering OFFENDED. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the gelding was feeling the effects of recent racing.

OFFENDED (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly hampered by GOODO JO. Over-raced through the middle stages. Crowded and hampered when runners on either side shifted ground near the 250 metres.

GOLDEN EAGLE (L Satherley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

EVE'S SONG (T Mitchell) - Shifted out near the 250 metres when not fully clear of OFFENDED placing that runner in restricted room. T Mitchell in the presence of riding mentor N Harris was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

GLORIFIED (V Colgan) - Shifted inwards near the 250 metres when not fully clear of OFFENDED placing that runner in restricted room. V Colgan was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.
