DAPPER (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly. Made the final bend awkwardly.

Race 3 AQUASHIELD ROOFING 3YO 1200

HOKKAIDO (M Hudson) - Slow away. Bumped passing the 100 metres. Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

MR TWINKLETOES (S O'Malley) - Restrained back at the start.

THE FAT LADY SINGS (K Hercock) - Lay inwards passing the 100 metres, bumping HOKKAIDO.

Race 4 RIVERSTONE CAFE MAIDEN 1200

MAROTIRI MARSTA (S O'Malley) - Slow away.

PACE ATTACK (T Taiaroa) - Slow away.

COLORADO SILVER (L Allpress) - Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider advised the filly was not comfortable in today's track conditions. Co-Trainer J Benner advised Stewards consideration would be given to spelling the filly.

V Jalakuncha (HYDRO CHARM) - Spoken to regarding the use of his whip on a runner out of contention.

Race 5 THE TELE OTAKI MAIDEN 1200

BEYOND VIOLET (C Grylls) - Slow away.

CALL ME LOLLY (C Dell) - Restrained to the rear from a wide draw.

HEMI RIDAPEST (J Riddell) - Over-raced through the early stages, having to be steadied.

STRIDES (L Allpress) - Put in a rough step and went off stride near the 250 metres.

BEERSHEBA (L Sutherland) - Finished last. When questioned, rider was of the opinion there may be something amiss with the mare. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 6 HARCOURTS OTAKI MAIDEN 1600

MADAM RAZIA (M Hudson) - Slow away (3L).

WENEEDASHOCK (K Hercock) - Slow away.

TWOOUTATHREE (J Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.

EXTRAORDINAIRE (S O'Malley) - Slow away. Came together and bumped with KALUANUI (L Sutherland) near the finish when both runners shifted ground.

KALUANUI (L Sutherland) - Bumped with EXTRAORDINAIRE near the finish.

EL ATTITUDE (D Bradley) - Began awkwardly, unbalancing the rider for a short distance.

HERE COMES TROUBLE (T Taiaroa) - Over-raced in the early stages having to be steadied.

PRINCESS BIDDY (L Allpress) - Lay out over the concluding stages.

PLATINUM LINING (J Riddell) - Finished last. When questioned rider could offer no excuse.

Race 7

CAVALLO FARM & CHRIS RUTTEN BLOODSTOCK HANDICAP 1400

DESTINY ONE (J Mudhoo) - Slow away.

TOWN BELT (F Lazet) - Over-raced having to be steadied near the 1000 metres.

O'SO DIVINE (D Turner) - Finished well back. When questioned the rider advised the mare may have held its breath.

LINCOLN LOVER (J Riddell) - Lay in, having to be straightened near the 250 metres.

Race 8 VETS ON RIVERBANK MAIDEN 1200

LA CAPITA (C Dell) - Began awkwardly unbalancing the rider after being fractious in the barriers. Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages.

MR MERLIN (A Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.

TRIGGER HAPPY (D Turner) - Slow away. Lay inwards over the concluding stages.

LADY TELENA (T Taiaroa) - Slow away.

CEE ARE EL (D Bradley) - Raced wide throughout. Bumped and unbalanced near the 1000 metres. Rider D Bradley advised the mare had little left after racing wide throughout.

REPLICA ROAD (L Sutherland) - Over-raced when in restricted room passing the 1000 metres, having to be steadied off heels near the 800 metres.

FLAMENCO (L Allpress) - Over-raced passing the 900 metres.

DUCKETT'S GROVE (F Lazet) - Steadied when in restricted room near the 600 metres.

LADY SUPERB (S O'Malley) - Awkwardly placed, having to be steadied when runners either side shifted ground passing the 600 metres. When questioned S O'Malley advised she was unable to avoid tiring runners and had to steady as a result.

Race 9 EL CHEAPO CARS HANDICAP 2200

MIZZENA (F Lazet) - Slow away. Held up entering the home straight, having to angle across heels to obtain clear racing room near the 250 metres.

SMART ATTIRE (L Allpress) - Slow away.

CARNABY (S O'Malley) - Over-raced briefly and had to be steadied near the 1000 metres.

KHAFEEF (J Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages then taken forward to race wide from the 1200 metres.

MASSO (A Mudhoo) - Held up until near the 250 metres.

FREE SPIRIT (K Hercock) - Unable to obtain clear racing room in the home straight and went to the line untested.
