K Hannan (QUIZ KID) - Stewards concluded an inquiry into the riding tactics adopted in the early stages, taking into account her riding instructions issued and her relative inexperience, her explanation was noted, however K Hannan was advised that she would be expected to ride her mounts in a manner that is not left open to query in the future.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 | NZB READY TO RUN SALE TRAINERS SERIES 3YO 1200**

VAL DI ZOLDO (V Colgan) - Began awkwardly.

STONYBRECK (O Bosson) – Over-raced in the early to middle stages. Held up until near the 100 metres.

WESTWOOD (W Pinn) – Lost the left hind plate during the running.

Race 2 | WAIKATO DRAUGHT 1200

WITH YOU (J Fawcett) - Jumped inwards at the start hampering **CANADIAN GIRL**, **ACTING OUT** and **LA DOLCE VITA**. Over-raced through the middle stages.

CANADIAN GIRL (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin then hampered shortly after, losing ground.

ACTING OUT (L Allpress) - Crowded shortly after the start, losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after receiving interference leaving the barriers the mare had never fully recovered. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

LA DOLCE VITA (T Mitchell) - Hampered at the start.

THINK TWICE (R Elliot) – Raced wide through the early stages.

DON'T LOOK ETHEL (C Barnes) – Over-raced in the early stages.

Race 3 | SVS STARTING GATES 1200

ANGE DE REVE (R Elliot) - Slow to begin.

THE HOTTIE (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly.

CLASSIC BEETHOVEN (S Weatherley) – Began awkwardly.

EXTORTION (T Newman) – Raced wide in the early stages.

A LITTLE BITY BOSSY (O Bosson) - Made the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly, shifting outwards. Raced greenly when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 450 metres.

POLLY PLUM (N Parmar) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 850 metres. Held up rounding the final bend.

BILLY BUNTER (J Riddell) - Underwent an endoscopic examination after coughing post-race which found grass and dirt in the trachea as a result of the inhalation of a clod.

SHINING PEAK (M McNab) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had been unsuited to today's track conditions.

Race 4 | **W B MORELAND MEMORIAL 2100**

LEITRIM LAD (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly.

CLEESE (D Danis) - Hampered at the start. Hampered when crowded near the 1800 metres. Lay in approaching the 250 metres then continued to lay in for the remainder of the race.

BEAU ARCHERS ROSE (T Mitchell) – Raced wide in the middle stages.

PINION (N Parmar) - Over-raced in the early stages.

ENCHANTED ELLE (M McNab) - Crowded passing the 1800 metres.

SPIRIT OF BAZ (O Bosson) – Inconvenienced passing the 1800 metres. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had been unsuited by today's track conditions.

N Parmar (PINION) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount PINION to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear crowding ENCHANTED ELLE onto CLEESE near the 1800 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator suspended N Parmar's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 8 October up to and including racing on Wednesday 19 October, 7 national riding days. N Parmar is to continue to meet with the Rider Skills Review Panel.

Race 5 | **HAPPY 20TH BIRTHDAY SKYCITY HAMILTON MILE 1600**

AURORA DOLCE (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin.

ESS VEE ARE (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

MANDALO (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

FLY MY WEY (L Allpress) – Held up for a distance approaching the 400 metres.

CORUBA JAK (S Spratt) - Lay out when placed under pressure passing the 250 metres hampering TASCIONI with REGAZZO also being forced wider.

TASCIONI (M McNab) – Hampered passing the 250 metres.

REGAZZO (J Riddell) – Forced wider passing the 250 metres.

GINGERBREAD (N Parmar) – Underwent a post-race endoscopic examination after the rider reported an abnormal respiratory noise with no obvious abnormality detected.

MISS INTERPRET (T Newman) - Rider reported that the mare had felt indifferent in its action on pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

S Spratt (CORUBA JAK) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift outwards passing the 250 metres when not sufficiently clear of TASCIONI which was hampered, forced wider as a result was REGAZZO.

Race 6 | **SKYCITY HAMILTON WAIKATO CUP DAY 10 DECEMBER MILE 1600**

SHERWOOD FOREST (C Grylls) – Slow to begin.

MARKUS AURELIUS (O Bosson) - Slow to begin. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 600 metres to the outside of FIELD OF GOLD which shifted out slightly when making the bend awkwardly.

HE'S A DOOZY (W Pinn) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages.

PERFECT SCENARIO (J Kamaruddin) - Restrained in the early stages from a wide barrier.

BULLYBROOK (E Bragg) - Raced wide through the early and middle stages.

FIELD OF GOLD (S Spratt) – Had to be steadied off heels when over-racing near the 1100 metres. Held up rounding the final bend and early in the final straight having to shift ground outwards to improve.

ZEE FALLS (L Allpress) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

MARRONI (K Hannan) – Held up until near the 150 metres.

M Hashizume (LE SABLIER) - Issued with a warning after striking his mount with the whip when clearly winning over the concluding stages.

ACADEMY AWARD (M McNab) - When the barrier blindfold was removed the filly made contact with the front gate of its barrier stall. The starter was spoken to and advised that in similar circumstances the horse should be removed from the barriers to undergo a veterinary inspection.

METRICAL (M Hashizume) - Began awkwardly.

MAZZOLINO (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly.

SHANLORD (S Weatherley) - Raced wide in the early to middle stages. Hampered when contacted becoming unbalanced passing the 400 metres. Also inconvenienced as a result was AMBERITE.

AMBERITE (S Spratt) – Inconvenienced passing the 400 metres.

J Kamaruddin (JAFFIRA) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he directed his mount outwards where there was insufficient room to do so making contact with SHANLORD near the 400 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator suspended J Kamaruddin's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 8 October up to and including racing on Saturday 15 October, 5 national riding days.

NOD OF THE HEAD (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly unbalancing its rider.

DARCI LA BELLA (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

TAVI MAC (M Kareem) – Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

MR UNIVERSE (S Spratt) - Briefly steadied after becoming awkwardly placed on heels near the 400 metres.

GERMANICUS (A Lawson-Carroll) – Had to shift ground outwards to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.

RISING STORM (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

MONZA (D Prastiyou) – Steadied when awkwardly placed near heels going into the bend near the 800 metres.

MARCHAND (S Spratt) - Improved onto heels over the concluding stages having to be steadied.

MISTER ROQUETTE (D Danis) - Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the gelding's barrier manners after proving difficult to load.

SERESIN (J Riddell) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.
