RACE COMMENTS						
Race 1	WANGANUI RACEHORSE OWNERS ASSOCIATION MAIDEN 2200m					
CELTIC JAZZ (K Hercock) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages placing its rider at a disadvantage. Continued to over-race passing the winning post on the first occasion having to steady off heels inconveniencing MYSALLY and CANBITEABIT which were racing to its outside. Taken forward to lead near the 1600 metres and continued to over-race. Commenced to give ground from the 800 metres.						

MYSALLY (A Mudhoo) – Inconvenienced passing the winning post on the first occasion.

CANBITEABIT (D Turner) – Inconvenienced passing the winning post on the first occasion.

OPAL SPIRIT (J Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced when being restrained to take cover near the 1500 metres. Held up by the tiring CELTIC JAZZ near the 600 metres.

NO TEARS (J Parkes) – Slow away.

MYSALLY (A Mudhoo) – Inconvenienced passing the winning post on the first occasion

SCELTA DI ELENA (A Mudhoo) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages and raced greenly throughout. When questioned into the performance rider confirmed the gelding had raced greenly throughout and had failed to handle the track conditions.

POPSAGOOSEY (M McNab) – Raced greenly in the early stages. When questioned into the performance rider advised the gelding had not handled today's track conditions.

IMARICHGIRL (L Allpress) – Lay in over the concluding stages.

Race 3 SUMMIT HAULAGE MAIDEN 1400m

TOTAL SHOCK (C Dell) – Slow away.

SOVIET WONDER (D Danis) – Hampered and held up rounding the final bend becoming unbalanced.

LADY POSH (L Allpress) – hampered rounding the final bend.

ARCADIAN IYNX (M McNab) – Made the final bend awkwardly laying in hampering LADY POSH and SOVIET WONDER.

DIAL A PRINCE (M Hudson) - Lay in over the concluding stages.

BOW STREET (M Singh) – Lay out over the concluding stages. Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider could offer no tangible excuse and that he was disappointed with the run.

SWINGIT OUR WAY (K Hannan) - Held up over the concluding stages.

ANOTHER BELLA (C Grylls)- Held up entering the home straight, gaining clear racing room near the 200 metres.

RIDE THE TIDE (D Turner) - Lay in during the home straight having to be straightened on several occasions.

Race 4 KIWI MEMORIAL STATUE 1400m

PRECIOUS NIAMH (C Dell) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after rearing and falling in the parade ring and was cleared to start. Over-raced in the early stages.

SHOWBOURNE (C Butler) – Shifted inwards shortly after the start hampering ALBUFEIRA. Rider C Butler was shown footage in the presence of the riding mentor and advised to exercise more care.

ALBUFEIRA (F Lazet) – Hampered shortly after the start.

BLUE VEIN (H Schofer)- Over-raced in the early stages.

GOBUYIT (D Danis) - Over-raced in the early stages when being restrained to take cover.

RIP WHEELER (K Hercock) – Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider advised the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions

Race 5 WENHAM SEED AND GRAIN MAIDEN 1200m

JHADIRA (A Mudoo) - Was declared a late scratching at 2.20pm after dislodging Rider A Mudhoo on the track prior to the start. Connections were advised that the mare would be required to trial prior to racing again. Trainer D Parry reported that consideration would be given to spelling the mare.

RIKKI RICARDO (D Danis) – Began awkwardly settling at the rear.

TENNESSEE ROSE (B Rogerson) – Slow away.

MERMAID (M Hudson) – Began awkwardly. Hung outwards throughout, racing very wide throughout and proving a difficult ride. A warning was placed on the filly's racing manners.

RETURNTOSENDA (K Hannan) – Made the final turn awkwardly and lay out throughout the home straight.

OUR GYPSY KING (E Nicholas) - Performed below market expectations. When questioned the rider advised the gelding was making a respiratory noise. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

Race 6 MERCURY WIND FARM MAIDEN 1200m

BELLE'S ECHO (M Hudson) - Dislodged its rider and cantered a short distance before being recaptured. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start. Rider M Hudson was uninjured.

PASHAMALA (B Rogerson) – Slow away.

SHE'S PATSY (D Turner) – Slow away.

ZEBADAYA (K Hannan) - Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider advised the gelding did not handle today's track conditions.

Race 7 ROSS FRANCIS PANEL AND PAINT 1200m

VISHAKHA (A Mudhoo) – Slow away.

RINGTHEBELLEDARCI (J Parkes) – Performed below market expectations. Rider advised that the gelding had not handled the track conditions which were holding later in the day.

HAKA BOOGIE (C Grylls) – Performed below market expectations. Rider advised that the gelding had not handled the track conditions which were holding later in the day.

CHIKIRA LASS (K Hannan) – Over-raced briefly passing the 1000 metres having to be steadied.

CONOR O'CEIRIN (C Butler) - Over-raced briefly passing the 1000 metres having to be steadied.

Race 8 PEKO CONTRACTING 1650m

WINNIE ROSE (C Grylls) - Slow away.

SIR BEETS (M McNab) - Slow away.

MANOLO (T Taiaroa) - Slow away.

BATTLE SECRET (M Hudson) – Began awkwardly. Lay out passing the 200 metres bumping DUBAI'S MOKO.

DUBAI'S MOKO (C Dell) – Bumped near the 200 metres.

SEMPER MAGICO (H Schofer) – Eased to obtain cover going into the back straight.
