RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 SINCLAIR TRANSPORT & ADVANCE AGRICULTURE MAIDEN 1200m

DUCK DUCK GOOSE (B May) - Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after rearing over backwards in the parade ring and was cleared to start. Co-Trainer K Tyler advised the Stewards that he would be reassessing the racing future of the mare.

POPPIES BOY (L Callaway) - Crowded and checked passing the 900 metres.

REDDINGTON (C Johnson) - Raced wide throughout. Commenced to give ground from the 300 metres.

LOCKDOWN LEGACY (R Mudhoo) - Held up for clear racing room rounding the final bend.

MOROCCO MISS (D Montes de Oca) - Raced greenly in the run home.

CANDIDATE (C Campbell) - Lay in throughout the run home with the rider swapping the whip to his left hand.

C Johnson (REDDINGTON) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted REDDINGTON to shift inwards near the 900 metres dictating DUCK DUCK GOOSE inwards onto POPPIES BOY which was checked. After hearing penalty submissions, the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of Mr Johnson's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today until the conclusion of racing on Sunday 16 October 2022, 5 national riding days.

Race 2

AON INSURANCE, COUNTRY JEWEL, TRAVELLER REST TAVERN 1200m

JIMMY FIVE (S Wynne) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend until gaining clear racing room passing the 225 metres. Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages.

ZAC BLACK (S Khetoo) - Taken back to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from an outside barrier.

CHEERS (M Taylor) - Raced wide early. Rider reported the mare would be better suited to tracks with more moisture.

CROP (S Toolooa) - Raced three-wide throughout.

Race 3 AB LIME, WINTON HOTEL & HYDE LANDSCAPING MAIDEN 1600m

SAVEZ VOUS (S Wynne) - Slow to begin. Raced three-wide throughout. Gave ground from the 600 metres. Rider reported that after being obliged to race wide she had been under pressure from the 600 metres with the mare being very disappointing.

LAST TRY (T Moseley) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

TUMEKE (L Callaway) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages getting its head up on a number of occasions. Rider advised he was disappointed with the effort of the gelding after having a nice trip throughout.

GABBY DIAZ (K Mudhoo) - Held up near the 500 metres having to be restrained off heels and was then shifted wider on the track to find clear racing room passing the 350 metres.

Race 4 FARMERS DIPPING & FLASH AGRICULTURE & PALAMOUNTAINS 1600m

PETE THE DRIVER (S Khetoo) - Began awkwardly.

KITTY POWER (B May) – Crowded shortly after the start having to be briefly restrained.

SUTHERLAND (K Mudhoo) - Restrained to avoid the heels of TELEKINETIC which was improving forward shortly after the start. D Montes de Oca was advised to exercise greater care.

Race 5 RYAL BUSH TRANSPORT & NIGHTCAPS CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1400m

The start of this race was delayed approximately 8 minutes due to the St John Ambulance staff being required to attend to a member of the public on course.

LOVELOCK (K Williams) - Began awkwardly and shifted out buffeting NO PROBLEMO. Raced below market expectations with the rider advising the gelding would take natural benefit from its first up run in the South Island today and would also appreciate a step up in distance.

NO PROBLEMO (C Johnson) - Buffeted at the start losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages.

HALLOWING COMMANDS (S Toolooa) - Hampered at the start when inside runner shifted out and lost ground as a result. Gave ground from the 600 metres with the rider unable to offer any tangible excuse.

SCARLETT'S PROMISE (R Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the early stages and near the 1000 metres had to be shifted outwards to avoid heels and when doing so hampered PEARL OF DELGATIE.

PEARL OF DELGATIE (L Callaway) - Hampered near the 1000 metres and was then obliged to race wide for the remainder of the event.

Race 6

WASHRITE WINTON CUP 1400m

MIDNIGHT RUNNER (M Taylor) - Lay out from the 300 metres dictating KILOWATT over extra ground. Continued to lay out in the run home making brief contact with KILOWATT on two occasions passing the 100 metres. M Taylor was advised to exercise greater care and reminded of her obligations to straighten her mount sooner than she had on this occasion.

KILOWATT (T Moseley) - Dictated wider on the track rounding the final bend and was contacted briefly on two occasions passing the 100 metres.

EXCHANGE (C Campbell) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

Following the race T Moseley rider of the 3rd placed KILOWATT lodged a Protest against 2nd place being awarded to MIDNIGHT RUNNER alleging interference over the final 300 metres. After viewing replays and hearing evidence from the connections of both horses and the Stewards, the Adjudicative Committee dismissed the Protest.

Race 7 TRENZ HOME, O'MEARA CONTRACTING 1400m

THE BOOGEYMAN (S Wynne) - Slow to begin.

SWEET MOLLY MALONE (K Mudhoo) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover.

HENRY HUBBER (K Williams) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover. Rider reported that the gelding had been obliged to get back from a wide draw and had not been suited to the sit sprint nature of today's race.

LEROY (R Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the early stages.

LILY OF THE VALLEY (BB Hong) - Raced three-wide without cover throughout.

OUR TEDDY BOY (C Campbell) - Raced wide throughout. Rider reported that the gelding is better suited to tracks with more moisture content.

DARCI VINO (T Moseley) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend.

SLINKY LINKY (S Toolooa) - Under pressure rounding the final bend and gave ground finishing last with the rider reporting the mare is better suited to more rain affected tracks.

GO LOTTE (S Khetoo) - Shifted out across heels passing the 200 metres to find clear racing room.
