Race 2 - DAVE GRANT & NEIL KINGSTON 3YO MAIDEN (1200m)

LADY INCANTO (S Wynne) – Co-trainer Mr M Pitman advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the filly, and it is their intention to continue with LADY INCANTO'S current preparation.

Race 9 - EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES STAYERS (2200m)

VERMONT (C Campbell) – Co-trainer S Smith subsequently reported that the mare was found to be suffering from a viral complaint and is receiving the appropriate treatment.

Race 1 CLEM & RUSSELL BRAND MEMORIAL MAIDEN (1600m)

HEADS UP (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

THE ARCTIC BLAST (J Laking) - Slow to begin. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

POWERLITE (D Montes de Oca) - Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

COVARCHI (G Jogoo) - Forced wider rounding the final bend.

PERIA'S LEGACY (S Muniandy) - Forced wider rounding the final bend.

LOMBARDI (L Callaway) - Hampered entering the final straight when improving onto the heels of IT'S THE VIBE which was laying out.

IT'S THE VIBE (K Hannan) - Hung outwards from near the 600 metres forcing COVARCHI and PERIA'S LEGACY wider. Also hampered as a result was LOMBARDI entering the final straight. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the gelding's racing manners.

Race 2 HINDS RIDGE FARMING (1400m)

TAIMATE DIVA (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly.

TRUSTWORTHY (B May) - Slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

CASTLE ON THE HILL (T Moseley) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Contacted and forced wider entering the final straight.

TAVILIGHT (J Chung) - Held up entering the final straight.

AERIAL BLUE (T Comignaghi) - Shifted out entering the final straight making contact with CASTLE ON THE HILL.

PAHI LASS (S Wynne) - When questioned regarding performance, rider advised in her opinion the mare would benefit from a step up in distance.

Race 3 COCHRANES OF CANTERBURY MAIDEN (1200m)

LEAR JET (B Murray) - Escaped riderless during the preliminary, galloping for a distance prior to being recaptured. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to race. As a result, the start was delayed approximately two minutes. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed on LEAR JET's pre-race manners. Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after.

TAVANASIA (J Chung) - Began awkwardly.

NIPPY THE HIPPY (L Callaway) - Slow to begin.

MERITORIOUS (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

RUBY SUNRISE (K Asano) - Began awkwardly.

BOLSHOI STAR (S Wynne) - Lay out rounding the final bend.

Race 4 RD PETROLEUM (2200m)

SPINDLESHANKS (M Taylor) - Fractious in the barriers prior to the start, rearing on a number of occasions.

KENKI (B May) - Slow to begin.

TELLING TALES (R Mudhoo) - Restrained after jumping to take cover from a wide draw.

RED SUNDAY (A Goindasamy) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 1500 metres.

ITS SO EASY (L Callaway) - Raced three wide without cover through the middle stages.

BACK HUT (S Muniandy) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

DIAMOND RIVIERE (T Comignaghi) - Held up throughout the final straight.

Race 5 RAINERS IRRIGATION FERTIGATION INVITATIONAL (2200m)

JILDI JILDI (A Balloo) - Slow to begin. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed on heels passing the 50 metres.

FIVE PRINCES (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

ARABIA (S Wynne) - Jumped the crossing near the 1700 metres. When questioned regarding performance, rider could offer no excuse.

SAVVY MAN (T Comignaghi) - Lay in behind heels passing the 250 metres having to be corrected by its rider. Forced outwards over the concluding stages by VICENZA which shifted out slightly when placed under pressure.

VICENZA (K Asano) - Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

EKSTREMEMISS (G Jogoo) - Had to shift outwards to obtain clear running passing the 250 metres.

S Wynne (ARABIA) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount ARABIA 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$500.

Race 6 BARNESWOOD FARM STAKES (G3) (1400m)

ONE KISS (K Asano) - Knuckled at the start.

PERFECTLY SUITED (S Wynne) - Slow to begin. Rider advised that the filly had felt indifferent in its action over the concluding stages. Stewards will follow up in coming days.

CORRECTION (J Laking) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SEVEN ELEVEN (A Goindasamy) - Raced wide in the early stages. Held up in the middle and concluding stages of the final straight.

Race 7 AGRAFORUM GROWING INNOVATION STEWARDS HANDICAP (1200m)

RADIANT ROSIE (B May) - Slow to begin.

MY WORLD (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin. Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

BUOYANT (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

EPTIMUM (D Montes de Oca) - Over raced in the early and middle stages when racing three wide without cover.

SWISSWATCH (A Goindasamy) - Held up rounding the final bend and in the early stages of the final straight.

FIRST ROCK (T Moseley) - Held up in the early stages of the final straight.

AMBERECHO (K Williams) - Raced in restricted room for a distance passing the 650 metres. Rider advised in her opinion the mare would derive benefit from the run today after being fresh up since May.

CHOKITO (S Wynne) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised in her opinion the mare would derive benefit from the run today after being fresh up since July.

Following this race, the track was upgraded to Good 3.

Race 8 MCCREA PAINTERS & DECORATORS ASHBURTON CUP (1600m)

SACRED GIANT (A Goindasamy) - Knuckled over at the start. Lost the left front plate during the running. Improved onto heels passing the 1100 metres having to be firmly restrained.

LOUIE LOUIE (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance, rider advised that the gelding was unsuited by today's track conditions.

FRANKIE THE FOX (S Muniandy) - Slow to begin.

LETSBRINGITON (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover until passing the 800 metres.

ZOULUMINOUS (K Asano) - Raced three wide without cover from near the 800 metres. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

FETTERCAIRN (S Wynne) - Improved onto heels passing the 1100 metres having to be firmly restrained dropping back onto FIRODEN which was hampered as a result.

FIRODEN (C Campbell) – Hampered passing the 1100 metres.

Race 9 STEWART FAMILY CUP WEEK IS COMING (1400m)

THE BOLD LOOK (K Kwo) - Late scratched at 4.36pm by order of Stewards after rearing over backwards in the birdcage dislodging the rider. K Kwo was attended to by St John Paramedics, being transferred to hospital for further treatment. K Kwo was advised he must produce a medical clearance prior to riding next.

BAUBLE (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly in the early stages.

GOODANYA (K Chowdhoory) - Slow to begin. Held up until near the 200 metres.

DUSHKU (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

ITS ALL OVER ROVER (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Lay in when placed under pressure over the concluding stages having to be straightened by its rider.

IFFRAAJABLE (K Asano) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout. Crowded approaching the 200 metres having to be steadied by its rider.

ASTRAKHAN (L Callaway) - Had to be firmly restrained approaching the 600 metres after improving onto heels. Hindquarters contacted approaching the 200 metres having to be straightened by its rider. Came together with THE MOTIVATOR passing the 100 metres when both runners shifted ground.

AMAZON GODDESS (A Balloo) - Shifted outwards into a marginal run approaching the 200 metres making contact with IFFRAAJABLE which shifted out slightly making contact with the hindquarters of ASTRAKHAN which had simultaneously shifted inwards slightly with ASTRAKHAN having to be straightened by its rider contributing with slight outward movement from THE MOTIVATOR.

DECISIVE (G Jogoo) - Improved into a marginal run approaching the 200 metres making contact with THE MOTIVATOR which was forced outwards slightly. Contributing was slight outward movement by ROYCE ROCA.

THE MOTIVATOR (J Laking) - Came together with ASTRAKHAN passing the 100 metres when both runners shifted ground.

SHOW BAZZ (K Williams) - When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

SURCHARGE (A Goindasamy) - Received veterinary attention after suffering a medial heel bulb laceration post-race.

Race 10 SAVILE ROW & VESPA STANDING AT MAPPERLEY STUD (1400m)

EL TIRADOR (S Wynne) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary inspection behind the barriers being cleared to race.

JUST TICKETY BOO (D Tait) - Stewards granted permission for D Tait's riding weight to be altered to 55 kg due to miscommunication.

NAVALHA (J Laking) - Slow to begin.

ILLICIT MISS (K Hannan) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that after drawing wide, she had been instructed to take a position back in the field, however was of the opinion that this may not have suited the mare.

PETTY'S LEGACY (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

RUBY'S LAD (C Campbell) - Lay out rounding the final bend. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had commenced to lay out from near the 600 metres and had failed to run on. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormality.

SEIKRID (K Chowdhoory) - Shifted ground outwards throughout the run home.

VICTOR ROUGE (T Moseley) - Steadied passing the 50 metres when LARPOWER shifted inwards slightly and JEWEL OF PATCH (L Callaway) shifted outwards. L Callaway was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

STRIKE FORCE (K Asano) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
