RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | WAITOMO FUELS MAIDEN 2200

SACRED BOURBON (J Riddell) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from an outside barrier.

MOKELE MBEMBE (M Sanson) – Began awkwardly losing ground. Weakened from the 600 metres and finished a distant last.

PARADING (T Newman) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

THE FINNSTER (L Allpress) - Over-raced in the early stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Eased down in the final straight when well beaten. Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

Race 2	LASER ELECTRICAL ROTORUA MAIDEN 3YO 1400
<p>GOOD SPOT (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin. Hampered and forced wider passing the 1250 metres. Apprentice rider J Kamaruddin was shown the video footage with riding mentor N Harris when he clipped a heel near the 1100 metres and reported that the filly raced greenly.</p> <p>BELAFONTE (A Goindasamy) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from an outside barrier.</p> <p>ESTELLA KHAN (T Newman) - Made the bend near the 1250 metres awkwardly shifting out hampering GOOD SPOT and MEGA MOGUL which were forced wider with ESTELLA KHAN continuing to lay out placing GOOD SPOT in restricted room resulting in that runner clipping a heel and blundering unbalancing its rider approaching the 1100 metres. Lay out and raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>MEGA MOGUL (J Riddell) - Hampered and forced wider passing the 1250 metres.</p> <p>GHAZZAH (C Lammas) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Lay out near the 700 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage.</p> <p>MAGICAL ROAD (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
Race 3	ARAWA PARK HOTEL MAIDEN 1230
<p>RED KNIGHT (E Bragg) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after, losing ground.</p> <p>MISS FIREHAWK (J Kamaruddin) – Restrained in the early stages from its wide barrier to obtain cover.</p> <p>MISTER ROSHAN (L Allpress) - Crowded shortly after the start having to be steadied.</p> <p>KINDRA GIRL (V Colgan) - Steadied off heels passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>MARUSYA (T Thornton) – Held up for clear running rounding the final bend.</p> <p>LOOSE CHOICE (T Newman) – Steadied near the 200 metres when LORD JIMMY shifted ground inwards.</p> <p>LORD JIMMY (M Cropp) - Lay in when placed under pressure over the final 200 metres which resulted in LOOSE CHOICE having to be steadied. M Cropp was advised to exercise greater care when his mounts are shifting ground.</p> <p>CHOPPER REED (J Riddell) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider reported that he had to do too much work in the early stages and the gelding would be better suited taking cover in future.</p> <p>NINETEENSIXTYTWO (K Hannan) – Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider reported that the filly did not appreciate the soft track conditions.</p>	
Race 4	CAMPBELL INFRASTRUCTURE 1560
<p>ABOVE THE CLOUDS (T Newman) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages. Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider could offer no explanation.</p> <p>MAHOMES (K Asano) - Raced wide in the early stages.</p> <p>MUSE (L Allpress) - Raced keenly through the middle stages. Held up until near the 150 metres.</p>	

Race 5	HOUSE OF ELLIOTT 1400
<p>LAKEMAN (A Goindasamy) - Began awkwardly. Steadied near the 100 metres when placed in restricted room.</p> <p>STELLA ECLIPSE (C Lammas) – Over-raced in the early stages having to be steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>BOOMER (J Kamaruddin) - Over-raced in the early stages having to be steadied off heels near the 800 metres.</p> <p>VADAMOS STAR (J Fawcett) – Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LUXEMBOURG (N Parmar) - Had difficulty obtaining clear running for the majority of the final straight before improving into restricted room approaching the 100 metres having to be steadied.</p> <p>LA DOLCE VITA (B Rogerson) - Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 6	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1400
<p>KAAPTIVATING (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Held up for clear running rounding the final bend. Improved into a marginal run near the 300 metres making contact with FRISKY WHISKY which was crowded and checked. Contributing was outward movement from SISTER CHRIS. Video footage of this incident proved inconclusive with riders J Fawcett and M Hashizume advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>BELLADONNA (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>BIT NOSY (N Parmar) - Saddle slipped forward passing the 1000 metres placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>SISTER CHRIS (M Hashizume) - Shifted out and away from DONTTELLTIMMY near the 300 metres which resulted in FRISKY WHISKY being crowded and checked, losing ground.</p> <p>FRISKY WHISKY (K Asano) - Crowded and checked near the 300 metres when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>HOLY ORANGE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Over-raced through the middle stages. Steadied off heels near the 800 metres. Clipped a heel and blundered just prior to the winning post dislodging its rider shortly after crossing the finishing line. A Lawson-Carroll was attended to by St John ambulance personnel and cleared to fulfil his remaining rides.</p> <p>KIND WISH (J Kamaruddin) – Contacted 300 metres.</p> <p>A Lawson-Carroll (HOLY ORANGE) - Issued with a warning for allowing his mount to shift outwards near the 300 metres making contact with KIND WISH.</p> <p>K Hannan (IMPREVU) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she allowed her mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of HOLY ORANGE which clipped a heel and blundered dislodging its rider near the winning post. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of K Hannan’s licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Sunday 6 November up to and including racing on Sunday 27 November, 3 weeks.</p>	
Race 7	MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS 1230
<p>LOVE LETTER (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Finished last. Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider reported that she was disappointed with the mare’s effort and could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.</p> <p>WEOWNA TIGER (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p>	

LUXURIANT (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly then crowded shortly after having to be steadied. Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

MR RAINBOW (A Mudhoo) – Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead passing the 800 metres.

MATTER OF HONOUR (V Colgan) – Steadied off the heels of MR RAINBOW passing the 800 metres.

HENRY HUDSON (C Lammas) - Held up for clear running rounding the final bend until the early stages of the final straight.

CONFIDENTIAL (S Fisher) - Slow to begin.

INCUBO (R Elliot) - Began awkwardly.

BIEDERMEIER (M Alam) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

FRACTURED (C Lammas) – Raced four wide without cover throughout.

HIBERRY (K Hannan) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ELUSIVE CAPITAL (A Mudhoo) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

FUNZONE (L Satherley) - Over-raced through the middle stages.
