RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 SVS STARTING GATES 2YO (1000 metres)

VIVA VIENNA (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly.

MY LIPS ARE SEALED (C Zackey) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

FULL TILT (K Hannan) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of VIVA VIENNA which shifted in slightly near the 900 metres then made the bend awkwardly when laying out, losing ground. W Kennedy was advised to exercise care. Raced three wide without cover for a majority of the race.

NEVER FORGOTTEN (S Spratt) - Made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly had raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight.

EL AMOR (C Barnes) – Lay out rounding the final bend.

<p>HERE'S JOHNNY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin then hampered shortly after.</p> <p>EVE'S SONG (T Mitchell) – Raced three wide without cover through the middle stages.</p> <p>ROCKET WON'T GO (K Hercock) - Steadied to avoid the heels of MS ROSE which shifted inwards approaching the 1400 metres. A Goindasamy was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.</p> <p>CANHEROC (M Sanson) – Held up rounding the final bend.</p> <p>I'M ALICE (T Thornton) - Raced in restricted room for a short distance passing the 50 metres when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>PEERLESS WARRIOR (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse.</p>	
Race 3	DUNSTAN HORSEFEEDS STAYERS (2200 metres)
<p>OSAKA (M Hashizume) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced near the 1700 metres.</p> <p>ATA RANGI (C Zackey) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Had to be steadied off heels approaching the 1600 metres.</p> <p>ENRIGHT (T Thornton) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>C Zackey (ATA RANGI) - Admitted a charge in that he changed his boots after weighing out and was fined the sum of \$100 under the minor infringement schedule.</p>	
Race 4	FOSTER MAINTAIN MAIDEN 3YO MILE (1600 metres)
<p>SAVOIR FAIRE (C Zackey) - Slow to begin. Held up until near the 350 metres.</p> <p>THE INSTIGATOR (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had been unsuited by the tempo of today's race and in his opinion would now benefit from a step up in distance.</p> <p>IN THE LOOP (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early to middle stages. Made the bend near the 850 metres awkwardly, shifting outwards having to be steadied off heels. Held up over the concluding stages.</p> <p>HUTSON (B Rogerson) - Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>THE ONLY ONE (J Riddell) - Over-raced in the early stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse.</p>	
Race 5	WAIKATO STUD WINNERS CIRCLE MILE (1600 metres)
<p>SOPHIA'S MAGIC (T Mitchell) - Began awkwardly. Improved onto heels near the 100 metres then was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race. When questioned regarding her riding tactics apprentice T Mitchell in the presence of riding mentor N Harris, advised that she had been instructed to ride her mount quietly in the early stages as the mare had previously tended to over-race during the middle stages after being asked to improve in the early stages. After settling towards the rear of the field she had elected to ease her mount as she had initially been caught three wide. Further advising that rounding the final bend she had been reluctant to improve into a run inside of HOT PINX as that runner appeared to be checking off heels and shifting inwards near the 450 metres.</p>	

Upon viewing films T Mitchell conceded that in hindsight she may have erred in her judgement. Stewards advised T Mitchell that she would be expected to ride in a manner that does not leave herself open to query in the future.

AQUILA STAR (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly.

ENCIERRO (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after losing ground.

HOT PINX (C Barnes) - Raced keenly in the middle stages. Improved onto heels near the 450 metres having to be steadied by its rider. Raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

MONZA (K Hannan) - Lay in passing the 175 metres making contact with the running rail and becoming unbalanced. Raced in restricted room just prior to the winning post.

Connections of the third placed MONZA viewed Stewards footage following the race before electing not to proceed with a protest.

Race 6	LEGACY LODGE SPRINT (1200 metres) (Listed Race)

OSELETA (T Newman) - Began awkwardly. Held up until near the 300 metres.

SIDE BY SIDE (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin then hampered shortly after.

GOSPODIN (J Riddell) - Knuckled jumping away.

TEVERE (N Parmar) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Contacted passing the 300 metres.

ONE MORE TIME (K Hannan) - Contacted shortly after the start with the rider losing the use of her left stirrup iron. K Hannan was unable to regain the left iron with the saddle shifting passing the 500 metres resulting in her losing the use of both stirrup irons for the remainder of the race being unable to be fully ridden out over the concluding stages. Shifted outwards passing the 200 metres despite the efforts of its rider crowding PACKING ROCKSTAR which was forced outwards contacting FAITHFUL FEAT which became unbalanced.

MALT TIME (M Hashizume) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the straight before shifting outwards passing the 300 metres making contact with TEVERE. M Hashizume was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

FAITHFUL FEAT (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. Contacted and unbalanced passing the 200 metres.

PACKING ROCKSTAR (C Zackey) - Crowded passing the 200 metres.

MR UNIVERSE (T Thornton) - Steadied when placed in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

BELDARRA (W Kennedy) – Inconvenienced passing the 100 metres.

SAINT ALICE (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly.

LINGJUN HERO (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages.

GEE CEE (J Riddell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after racing wide throughout the gelding had failed to finish the race off.

CLEVER RUDS (B Rogerson) – Contacted the running rail near the 900 metres.

DUNEAGLE (A Goindasamy) – Held up rounding the bend.

MILLEFIORI (N Parmar) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in his opinion the mare would be better suited ridden further back than on this occasion. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

GARNET (S Fisher) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THINK TWICE (C Barnes) - Raced greenly passing the 300 metres when shifting inwards abruptly.
