D Danis advised Stewards on race morning that he was injured and would not be attending today's meeting. D Danis is to provide Stewards with a medical clearance prior to riding next.

Race 1 went back 2 minutes at the request of the TAB.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 NZB READY TO RUN SALE 16 & 17 NOV MAIDEN 1100

JEKSO ABSOLUT (J Fawcett) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier. Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages shifting wider on the track.

NASHOBA (C Zackey) - Crowded leaving the barriers.

BOURBON ROAD (W Kennedy) – Contacted leaving the barriers, losing ground. Had to be firmly restrained off heels passing the 900 metres.

INCA BELLE (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

LONG GAME (S Fisher) – Began awkwardly. Raced four wide without cover throughout.

FELICITY THEN (C Lammas) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from an outside barrier.

THIS LITTLE LIGHT (T Abel) – Raced wide without cover throughout. Lay out rounding the final bend then commenced to shift outwards from near the 550 metres running wider on the track. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on the mare's racing manners.

RYDER (K Asano) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres to the outside of BOURBON ROAD (W Kennedy) which shifted out when not fully clear. W Kennedy was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

C Zackey (NASHOBA) - Issued with a warning after he struck his mount six times prior to the 100 metre mark.

Race 2 ELLERSLIE EVENT CENTRE MAIDEN 1300

THEE AULD MINX (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

DEAR JOHN LINCOLN (S Spratt) – Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 1200 metres.

ASGARD (C Zackey) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

BOURBON CHIQUE (C Grylls) - Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 850 metres.

INTREPID GIRL (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly when being restrained approaching the 800 metres. Had to be steadied passing the 400 metres after attempting a marginal run to the inside of BOURBON CHIQUE which shifted inwards.

TARTED UP (K Asano) - Had to be restrained off heels passing the 800 metres.

Race 3 HAWAIIAN AIRLINES 1600

SAMINA BIBI (J Kamaruddin) - Contacted leaving the barriers losing ground.

DOUBLE O' SEVEN (M McNab) – Began awkwardly.

CHILLAX (M Hashizume) - Raced keenly through the middle stages.

GOLDMAN (K Asano) - Held up for clear running until approaching the 100 metres.

LADY KOVAL (S Spratt) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in her opinion the mare would be better suited by some easing in the ground.

J Kamaruddin (SAMINA BIBI) - Issued with a warning after he struck his mount six times prior to the 100 metre mark with Stewards taking into account his clear recent record with regard to any breach of this whip rule.

Race 4 DOUBLETREE BY HILTON KARAKA 1600

SUPER SIX (M Hashizume) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had never travelled comfortably throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

HOARD THE BOURBON (M McNab) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that he was disappointed in the gelding's performance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

Race 5 DUNSTAN HORSE FEEDS MAIDEN 1200

LITTLE MISS WONDER (T Abel) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier. Raced greenly rounding the final bend. Improved onto heels passing the 50 metres having to be steadied by its rider.

VOLARE (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages.

VADAMAN (A Lawson-Carroll) - Lay out losing ground approaching the 600 metres.

COSMETIC VIRTUE (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MARCH OF STEEL (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had raced greenly throughout and failed to respond once placed under pressure.

J Fawcett (CANDYCANE) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of VOLARE which had to be steadied near the 50 metres.

Race 6 HAUNUI FARM MAIDEN 1400

OUR BIG BOY (A Goindasamy) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious in the barriers and was late scratched at 3.59 pm. As a result, this race ran 4 minutes late. Connections were advised that the gelding would be required to barrier trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

OCEAN GAIL (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly.

HOPE IS ETERNAL (E Bragg) - Placed in restricted racing room shortly after the start.

SHEZ CLASS (K Asano) - Raced wide in the early stages.

BRONTES GOLD (S Spratt) - Raced three wide without cover in the middle stages before taking cover approaching the 800 metres. Inconvenienced passing the 250 metres.

SAYAN (W Kennedy) - Lay in passing the 250 metres simultaneously as DEEP PURPLE shifted outwards resulting in SAYAN having to be steadied and shift outwards inconveniencing BRONTES GOLD. Contributing to this incident was inward movement from KIWI'S CRUISIN.

THEODEN (J Kamaruddin) - Made firm contact with the running rail unbalancing its rider just prior to the winning post.

Race 7 STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN 1400

PRIZE PRINCE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin.

OVER THE MOON (E Bragg) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MARK TWAIN (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

GHAZZAH (C Lammas) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

CAPEL PRINCE (W Kennedy) - Raced three wide without cover.

SHOOTIN TO SAKS (L Satherley) – Raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to stride forward to race outside the leader passing the 1000 metres.

REELROSE (J Kamaruddin) - Made the bend near the 900 metres awkwardly, shifting ground.

Race 8 NZB AIRFREIGHT 1300

MARCELLA (R Beemud) - Slow to begin (3L). Raced wide without cover throughout.

SKEW WIFF (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

CLASSIC BEETHOVEN (C Lammas) – Steadied off heels passing the 800 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that gelding had raced greenly when in the open.

SPLASH OF RED (A Lawson-Carroll) - Held up for clear running until near the 400 metres.
