RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1400

JAMAICAN EXPRESS (C Dell) - Lost its footing at the start, losing ground.

POMALO (K Hercock) - Knuckled shortly after the start making contact with SAVAGE LOVE and as a result lost ground. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed mild lameness. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance will be required prior to POMALO racing next.

SAVAGE LOVE (T Newman) - Contacted then hampered, losing ground, shortly after the start. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

TAVI ANN (K Bohorun) - Slow to begin.

Track downgraded to Heavy 9 following Race 1.

Race 2 STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN 1400

PERSIAN IDOL (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

JAMAICA FAREWELL (T Newman) - Slow to begin.

TAKES TIME (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Improved on to heels passing the 800 metres, having to be steadied and again near the 550 metres, having to be firmly restrained.

KAHLUA (M Hudson) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

NEIGHOMI CAMPBELL (M Singh) - Raced keenly when being restrained passing the 1300 metres. Improved on to heels passing the 1000 metres, having to shift outwards, then raced three wide without cover for the remainder of the race.

HOT SHIZZLE (C Butler) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the filly to be suffering from a stone bruise in the left fore hoof.

SIT DOWN DEAR (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

Track further downgraded to Heavy 10 following Race 2.

Race 3 ENERGY CITY FORD 1400

ONE BOLD CAT (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

MAZZINI (S O'Malley) - Began awkwardly, losing ground.

MY ZOI (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin, then hampered, losing ground.

HOLYELL (D Turner) - Eased down by its rider over the final 100 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have suffered a suspected broken femur and was humanely euthanised.

Race 4 WHITAKER CIVIL CONSTRUCTION 1400

The start of Race 4 was delayed approximately 8 minutes.

DREAM MACHINE (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly shifting out, making contact with BENDERMERRY. Lay outwards rounding the final bend and in the straight.

BENDERMERRY (K Hercock) - Contacted then crowded, losing ground.

HACKSAW RIDGE (A Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

Race 5 PRIMO MAIDEN 1200

ASMARDE (L Satherley) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Race 6 SINCLAIR ELECTRICAL REFRIGERATION OPUNAKE CUP JULY 23 MAIDEN 1200

MOMOSA (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

THE WITCH (K Hercock) - Slow to begin.

TANZANITE ROSE (C Butler) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

K Hercock (THE WITCH) - Admitted a charge in that she struck her mount THE WITCH 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 26 November until the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 3 December, 5 national riding days.

Race 7 LA NUOVA APPARELMASTER 2000

SWING LOW (A Goindasamy) - Slow to begin.

WAISAKE (L Douglas) - Slow to begin. Improved on to heels, having to be steadied near the 1400 metres.

THOMAS AQUINAS (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

RUA ROCKS (K Hercock) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

Race 8 REVITAL FERTILISER 1800

BERRY THE CASH (C Dell) - Began awkwardly making contact with THE UNDERBELLY.

ROAD DIVA (A Mudhoo) - Crowded at the start losing ground.

ANOTHER BELLA (C Grylls) - Contacted at the start then hampered, losing ground. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions.

RONIN POROTENE (C Butler) - Blundered shortly after the start.

GOBUYIT (M Singh) - Raced keenly for a distance when being restrained passing the 1400 metres.

THE UNDERBELLY (L Allpress) - Contacted at the start. Raced keenly for a distance approaching the 1200 metres.

HARDTIMES (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly making contact with ANOTHER BELLA and as a result lost ground. Rider dropped her whip near the 200 metres.

Race 9 RACING AGAIN 1ST, 24TH AND 27TH DECEMBER MAIDEN 1600

ZIVJELI (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

TRIGGER HAPPY (K Hercock) - Slow to begin. Shifted inwards contacting BLUE RATA QUEEN, becoming unbalanced entering the final straight.

FREE AT LAST (C Grylls) - Slow to begin. Commenced to over-race through the early stages making the bend near the 1200 metres awkwardly.

REBELWOOD (L Satherley) - Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room entering the final straight when BLUE RATA QUEEN was forced inwards by TRIGGER HAPPY, which shifted in and away from WHAT A CHARMER, which shifted in.

MINNIE MOUSE (A Goindasamy) - Had some difficult obtaining clear running until near the 200 metres.

WINKLE BAY (L Allpress) - When questioned regarding performance the rider could offer no excuse.

BLUE RATA QUEEN (M Singh) - Improved into a marginal run entering the final straight then contacted, becoming unbalanced.

T Newman (WHAT A CHARMER) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of TRIGGER HAPPY, which shifted in and away, crowding BLUE RATA QUEEN onto REBELWOOD, which had to be steadied when placed in restricted room entering the final straight.
