SOPHISTICARDO (J Kamaruddin) – Te Akau Racing Manager Mr. R Trumper advised Stewards the gelding underwent a veterinary examination on Monday 21 November, which revealed no abnormalities. R Trumper further advised SOPHISTICARDO will be exercising on the water walker for the remainder of this week and the stable will look to nominate the gelding for a race meeting within the next four weeks.

Race 1 WESTBROOK WINES 2100

TE POROPITI (B Rogerson) – Raced wide without cover until near the 1000 metres.

FLIGHT PLAN (N Parmar) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Came together with SIDE HUSTLE approaching the 300 metres.

YES WE KHAN (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced keenly through the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding got its tongue over the bit which proved detrimental to its chances.

QUEEN SARABI (K Asano) - Lay in when placed under pressure passing the 400 metres.

N Parmar (FLIGHT PLAN) - Issued with a warning after using his whip on FLIGHT PLAN when the gelding was out of contention.

Race 2 CELLAR DOOR WAIMAUKU MAIDEN 2100

KID WARRIOR (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.

NINE REALMS (R Beemud) – Jumped outwards shortly after the start contacting BENEFICENT. Rider dropped his whip near the 150 metres. Improved wide from the 800 metres.

KIWI MAN (M Hashizume) – Jumped awkwardly making contact with BRICKIE'S MOJO. Over-raced in the early stages then continued to race wide and hung out entering the back straight.

SHADEZ (C Grylls) – Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from an outside barrier.

BRICKIE'S MOJO (N Parmar) – Contacted and unbalanced shortly after the start.

KINLOCH (W Kennedy) – Contacted and unbalanced shortly after the start. Raced wide in the early stages before improving forward to lead approaching the 1300 metres. Finished a distant last. When questioned, rider reported that the gelding raced greenly throughout and would benefit from the race day experience.

MIA ROSSI (A Lawson-Carroll) - Contacted and unbalanced shortly after the start.

TURNAROUND (C Dell) - Raced wide and hung throughout. Connections were advised a warning would be placed against the gelding's racing manners.

BENEFICENT (V Colgan) – Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider reported that he was disappointed with the mare's effort and could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

Race 3 MARSHALL STAND FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN 1200

AMBERARNA (L Satherley) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages when leading.

SILK 'N' DALE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground. Held up for clear running until passing the 300 metres.

LITTLE MISS WONDER (T Abel) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

DESTINYS DELIGHT (V Colgan) – Had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

BELLA TIVACI (N Parmar) – Inclined to shift out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

MAGIC ACE (J Doyle) - Performed below market expectations. When questioned, the rider could offer no explanation.

Race 4 AVONDALE TOWN CENTRE MAIDEN 1200

CASCATELLA (T Abel) - Slow to begin. Hampered rounding the final bend being forced wider on the track.

THIS LITTLE LIGHT (S Spratt) - Jumped awkwardly making contact with LADY GREY. Raced greenly then shifted outwards leaving the 1000 metres. Lay out passing the 500 metres racing wide rounding the final bend hampering CASCATELLA forcing it wider on the track.

LADY GREY (B Rogerson) - Contacted shortly after the start.

ENJOYABLE (A Goindasamy) - Restrained to obtain cover in the early stages after jumping from the outside barrier. Finished a distant last. When questioned, rider reported that the filly felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

REGAL WARRIOR (J Doyle) – Raced greenly for a short distance passing the 900 metres.

Following this race, the track was upgraded to Heavy 9.

Race 5 TULLOCH CAFE MAIDEN 1600

SPEEDRUN (C Zackey) – Over-raced in the early stages. Finished a distant last. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed blood in its mouth consistent with having knocked its head in the barriers prior to the start.

IN THE LOOP (N Parmar) – Began awkwardly losing ground shortly after the start. Shifted in sharply over the concluding stages when placed under pressure.

WILLIAM (J Doyle) – Over-raced in the early stages. Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider reported that when placed under pressure the gelding failed to respond and, in his opinion would be better suited stepping back in distance.

THE SPRINKLER (V Colgan) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.

HOPE IS ETERNAL (E Bragg) – Raced three wide without cover from near the 1000 metres.

Race 6 UNLOCK AVONDALE DEVELOPMENT MAIDEN 1600

JUST A TIPPLE (M Hashizume) - Slow to begin (3L).

KANDANOS (W Kennedy) – Began awkwardly.

MY EXPLOSIVE (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced leaving the 1200 metres. Finished a distant last. When questioned, rider reported that the filly made abnormal breathing noises. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the filly to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer S Ralph was advised the filly will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a veterinary certificate declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres.

MCENROE (E Bragg) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

THE GAMBLERS HAND (C Grylls) - Over-raced in the early stages.

Following this race, A Goindasamy was stood down from his remaining ride due to dehydration.

Race 7 AVONDALE RACECOURSE FOR FILMSHOOTS MAIDEN 1400

CADA CAMINO (B Rogerson) - Jumped out shortly after the start making contact with DRUIDOR.

DRUIDOR (E Bragg) – Made contact with CADA CAMINO shortly after the start.

LA DULCIN'EE (M McNab) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

SWEYSON (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced three wide without cover until near the 900 metres.

WOLF MOON (V Colgan) - Lay out passing the 800 metres and continued to do so for a distance placing its rider at a disadvantage. Crowded having to be steadied losing ground passing the 600 metres when his mount lay out across the heels of FOREVER YOUNG. Rider reported that the gelding raced greenly on debut throughout.

Race 8 NIGHTMARE ON ELM STREET MAIDEN 1400

HEY GIRLFRIEND (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages. Held up for clear running until near the 350 metres. Lay in when placed under pressure near the 100 metres. Apprentice rider N Parmar was shown video footage of the final straight in the presence of the riding mentor N Harris and he was advised that he must stop riding and make a greater effort to straighten his mounts when they commence to shift ground.

IMARICHGIRL (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

VOLARE (W Kennedy) – Jumped awkwardly making contact with VERISMO.

VERISMO (J Doyle) - Contacted shortly after the start losing ground. Held up for clear running until near the 300 metres.

TAVITA MISS (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover until approaching the 900 metres.

Race 9 AJC MEMBERS MAIDEN 1400

NANA'S WISH (W Kennedy) – Began awkwardly making contact with MI DUBAI shortly after the start.

MI DUBAI (T Thornton) - Contacted shortly after the start.

SPACE LAB (L Satherley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 10 OFF THE RAILS LUNCHBAR RAILSIDE AVE 1300

SPICEY LAD (T Abel) – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to take its place in the race. Inconvenienced when weakening passing the 400 metres.

CALL ME FLINT (W Kennedy) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

CHASE 'N' GOLD (N Parmar) – Began awkwardly losing ground.

WHOSHE'S GIRL (L Satherley) - Over-raced in the early stages. Raced wide without cover through the middle stages.

VADAMOS STAR (J Fawcett) - Held up for clear running until near the 200 metres.
