BRANDO (M McNab) – Stable representative R Trumper advised that they were satisfied with the gelding's recovery and that it is their intention to continue with its current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS**Race 1 WAITOMO FUELS MAIDEN 1950**

ON ICE (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly then hampered shortly after the start.

BRIAR (J Kamaruddin) - Began awkwardly. Over-raced in the early stages having to ease off heels passing the winning post for the first time. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BELAFONTE (J Doyle) – Began awkwardly.

HIGHLY VINDICATED (K Asano) – Began awkwardly. Raced four wide without cover for the majority of the race.

RAAJOICES (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly contacting HIGHLY VINDICATED.

JAMESON (J Riddell) - Raced in restricted room leaving the straight for the first time.

CONFIDENTIAL (T Davies) - Raced wide without cover in the early stages. Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

NINE REALMS (B Rogerson) – Over-raced in the middle stages.

PRISMATIC (C Grylls) – Raced wide until near the 1400 metres.

DAYDREAM BELIEVER (M Hashizume) – Raced keenly having to be eased off heels approaching the 1200 metres.

BIGGIE (N Parmar) - Held up for clear running passing the 400 metres. Became unbalanced entering the home straight when CONFIDENTIAL laid in.

UNFASTEN (M McNab) – When questioned regarding the performance rider M McNab advised that the mare did not handle today's track conditions.

Race 2 MACMILLAN ACCOUNTANTS 1230

EDGE OF WONDER (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin. Raced wide for the majority of the race. Lost the nearside front plate leaving 1000 metres.

CARIGNAN (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly contacting another runner, losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages.

CIVIL UNREST (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly contacting another runner. When questioned regarding the performance rider S Spratt advised that the gelding did not handle today's track conditions.

SAGAN (W Kennedy) – Over-raced in the early stages.

DON'T TELL ETHEL (J Doyle) – Raced ungenerously in the middle stages. Inclined to lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

Race 3	RYDGES HOTEL ROTORUA MAIDEN 3YO 1230
<p>PAUL DAVID (W Kennedy) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the middle stages and refused to settle for the majority of the race.</p> <p>KINGFISHER (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground shortly after the start. Forced wider rounding the home turn.</p> <p>KHAFRE (J Fawcett) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>CALL ME BILLIE (K Asano) - When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the filly raced greenly and would derive benefit from today's race. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no significant findings.</p>	
Race 4	SWEENEY TOWNSEND INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN 3YO 1230
<p>THE WOMAN KING (T Newman) - Reared on jumping, losing ground. Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Trainer S Logan was advised that a warning would be placed against the filly's barrier manners.</p> <p>OUR MILLY BEE (J Kamaruddin) - Jumped inwards at the start hampering PURRFECT PUSS.</p> <p>PURRFECT PUSS (N Parmar) - Hampered at the start by OUR MILLY BEE. Hung out entering the home straight. Contacted and unbalanced passing the 350 metres when MARTELL shifted into a marginal run with DELPHINE then shifting out slightly.</p> <p>CLAIRIERE (J Doyle) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>INTREPID GIRL (M Hashizume) – Raced wide and over-raced in the back straight.</p> <p>DELPHINE (S Spratt) – Shifted out slightly entering the final straight.</p> <p>MARTELL (J Fawcett) – Improved into a marginal run contacting PURRFECT PUSS passing the 350 metres.</p> <p>J Fawcett (MARTELL) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to improve into a marginal run contacting PURRFECT PUSS passing the 350 metres. When assessing the incident Stewards took into account slight outward movement from DELPHINE.</p> <p>Following the running of this race connections of the 2nd placed horse PURRFECT PUSS lodged a protest alleging interference entering the final straight by the 1st placed horse MARTELL. After considering submissions the Adjudicator dismissed the protest with placings standing 1st MARTELL, 2nd PURRFECT PUSS, 3rd OUR MILLY BEE, 4th CLAIRIERE.</p> <p>Following this race, the track was downgraded to Heavy 9.</p>	
Race 5	T W MOORE 1560
<p>ABOVE THE CLOUDS (T Newman) - Slow to begin. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>FONTEYN (T Mitchell) - Held up for clear running approaching the 400 metres when improving onto heels. Lay in under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>LOWRY (C Grylls) – Raced four wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Following this race, the track was downgraded to Heavy 10.</p>	

Race 6	LANCE LAWSON MAIDEN 1560
<p>AULD JOCK (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced wide throughout.</p> <p>TIZ LOUIE (J Doyle) – Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>NOSNEVETS (T Newman) - Began awkwardly contacting another runner shortly after the start, losing ground.</p> <p>STRATTY’S WAY (C Barnes) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start, losing ground.</p> <p>KIWI’S CRUISIN (C Grylls) – Inclined to hang out leaving the 400 metres.</p> <p>MR FANTASTIC (T Mitchell) – Shifted ground over the concluding stages when placed under pressure.</p> <p>I’M ON FIRE (M Hashizume) - Shifted ground over the concluding stages when placed under pressure.</p>	
Race 7	ISCL MAIDEN 1560
<p>KIND WISH (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>GALILEO INVADER (J Riddell) - Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>SUPER GUNN (T Newman) – Knuckled shortly after the start.</p> <p>STYX (J Doyle) - Over-raced in the early stages. Momentarily held up for clear running turning into the home straight. When questioned regarding the performance rider J Doyle advised that the filly had failed to handle today’s track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no significant findings.</p> <p>UNTETHERED (T Thornton) – Over-raced for the majority of the race.</p> <p>DUPUG (M McNab) - Held up approaching the home turn.</p> <p>STRATHTAY (W Kennedy) – Over-raced in the middle stages. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding did not handle today’s track conditions.</p> <p>COM SI COM SA (K Hannan) – Stewards questioned trainer I Marks regarding today’s improved performance who advised that the horse had been working well and a forward showing was expected today on the heavier track. Stewards noted his explanation.</p>	
Race 8	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES MAIDEN RACE 1560
<p>SAFURA (J Kamaruddin) - Crowded at the start. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly had failed to let down in today’s heavy track conditions over the concluding stages.</p> <p>OVER THE MOON (E Bragg) - Jumped out at the start contacting the barrier.</p> <p>STERNLAND (H Kamaruddin) – Jumped awkwardly. Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages. Lost the nearside front during the running.</p> <p>LADY HIKA (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>GALLIVANTER (M McNab) - Lay out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.</p>	

SIOUXSIE SIOUX (C Barnes) - Connections advised that the mare would not be persevered with a racing proposition from their stable.	
Race 9	CAMPBELL INFRASTRUCTURE MAIDEN 1230
<p>MARUSYA (J Fawcett) - Began awkwardly contacting CORNWALLIS. Raced keenly in the early stages. When questioned regarding performance the rider advised that the mare had never felt comfortable in today's heavy track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no significant findings.</p> <p>CORNWALLIS (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly contacting MARUSYA, losing ground.</p>	
Race 10	HAVE YOUR FUNCTION AT "ARAWA PARK" 2200
<p>CANADIAN GIRL (J Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly unbalancing its rider for a few strides. Over-raced through the early and middle stages.</p> <p>RISING RANSOM (K Asano) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>POSER (T Newman) – Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>PEERLESS WARRIOR (T Mitchell) – Raced in restricted room in the back straight.</p>
