Race 1	WEST END BOWLING CLUB MAIDEN 1800
<p>TRIGGER HAPPY (A Mudhoo) - Slow away. Lay inwards near the 200 metres having to be straightened.</p> <p>SMUG (K Asano) - Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>TIME AND AGAIN (J Kamaruddin) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Performed below market expectations. Rider advised the mare had not been suited to today's track conditions.</p> <p>THELASTINVINCIBLE (M Cropp) - Raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>RED QUEST (L Allpress) - Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages having to be straightened.</p> <p>ALL IN ALL (M Sanson) - Held up for the majority of the home straight before gaining clear running near the 100 metres to the inside of MAOLLA MISS (C Grylls) which rolled out under pressure. A short distance further MAOLLA MISS shifted in under hard riding hampering ALL IN ALL for some distance. C Grylls was shown footage of his ride and advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.</p>	
Race 2	NULOOK ALUMINIUM MAIDEN 3YO 1100
<p>CRAFTY COLIN (M Hudson) - Late scratching at 2.12pm after rearing behind the barriers dislodging rider M Hudson who was attended to by St John paramedics and transferred to hospital for observation. M Hudson was stood down from her remaining ride.</p> <p>MORE TO BE WRITTEN (C Butler) - Began awkwardly hampering OUTER FOCUS, which lost ground. Raced greenly through the early stages.</p> <p>OUTER FOCUS (K Asano) - Hampered, losing ground shortly after the start.</p> <p>READY TO REIGN (B Rogerson) - Raced greenly over the concluding stages.</p>	
Race 3	STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN 1200
<p>IZZIE'S BEAU - M Cropp replaced M Hudson. Hampered at the start losing ground. Raced greenly passing the 800 metres. Made the final bend awkwardly.</p> <p>The start of this race was delayed approximately 6 minutes until the arrival of a replacement ambulance.</p> <p>BROTHER RUN (B Rogerson) - Began awkwardly hampering IZZIE'S BEAU and MOMOSA. Lost contact with the body of the field near the 650 metres, finishing a distant last. Connections were advised a warning will be placed on the gelding's racing manners.</p> <p>MOMOSA (M Samson) - Hampered at the start losing ground. Over-raced in the early stages. Lay inwards under pressure in the home straight.</p> <p>OUR MATE REG (L Douglas) - Raced greenly near the 800 metres, having to be steadied. OUR MATE REG was not persevered with in the home straight. When questioned rider was of the opinion the gelding had a breathing issue and had recommended to connections that a tongue tie be added. A post-race veterinary examination confirmed a respiratory issue. Trainer C Bothwell undertook to monitor the gelding over coming days, report any anomaly and the result of an endoscopic examination.</p>	
Race 4	REVITAL FERTILISERS 1400

THE HOTTIE (J Kamaruddin) - Slow away.	
IDEAL (S O'Malley) - Slow away.	
CHAJABA (C Butler) - Over-raced, having to be steadied, passing the 700 metres. Rider advised the gelding had become momentarily unbalanced near the finish.	
STAR OF AUSTRALIS (L Allpress) - Commenced to weaken from the 450 metres finishing a distant last. A post-race veterinary examination confirmed STAR OF AUSTRALIS to have bled. STAR OF AUSTRALIS shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any Race of Trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian with a veterinary clearance provided.	
Race 5	TELFER YOUNG 1400
ROSCHANA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow away.	
HAYATE (H Kamaruddin) - Over-raced in the early stages.	
H Kamaruddin (HAYATE) - Issued with a warning after he struck his mount 6 times prior to the 100 metre mark.	
Race 6	NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1400
DUBLIN CASTLE (J Kamaruddin) - Slow away (5L).	
SENSE OF STYLE (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly.	
RETURNTOSENDA (F Lazet) - Over-raced having to be steadied passing the 1100 metres.	
H Kamaruddin (DUBLIN CASTLE) - Spoken to advisedly, in the presence of senior rider C Grylls, with regard to the use of his whip above shoulder height.	
Race 7	CARTERS YOUR BUILDING PARTNER 1800
SWING LOW (J Kamaruddin) - Slow away.	
SOUTHROAD (S O'Malley) – Checked near 300 metres.	
E Bragg (LUCKY PARK) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted LUCKY PARK to shift outwards near the 300 metres when not sufficiently clear of SOUTHROAD, which was checked. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of her licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 3 December, until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday, 14 December, 4 national riding days.
