Race 5 - DUNEDIN CITY MOTORS 65 1400M

JUST MAYBE (T Comignaghi) – Trainer Ms K Williams advised Stewards that JUST MAYBE had bloods taken on Wednesday 1 December which did not reveal any abnormality, with K Williams further advising it is her intention to continue with the mare's current preparation.

Race 6 - GRAND CASINO OPEN 1400M

NEON MOON (T Comignaghi) – Co-trainer Mr J Parsons advised Stewards that NEON MOON underwent a veterinary examination on Monday 28 November which included an endoscopic examination, with results showing mucus in the windpipe. J Parsons further advised that the mare has been placed on antibiotics and will undergo another endoscopic examination next week.

Race 8 - POSITIVE SIGNS AND PRINT CROMWELL CUP OPEN 2030M

ROBINA JOY (K Williams) – Trainer Ms J Jones reported to Stewards that although satisfied with the post-race condition of ROBINA JOY, the mare will undergo a veterinary examination next week which will include blood tests and an endoscopic examination. Stewards will follow up with J Jones once the results are available.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 **RICCARTON PARK FUNCTION CENTRE (2100m)**

KUDOS DE SOTHYS (G Saejorhor) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after banging its head in the float enroute to the races and was cleared to race. Steadied to avoid heels racing into the first bend when ITS SO EASY was taken inwards by LIGHT UP. Shifted in under pressure passing the 200 metres inconveniencing RED RUFUS before being corrected by its rider.

ITS SO EASY (K Williams) - Held up rounding the final bend and was unable to obtain clear running until 250 metres.

RED RUFUS (S Wynne) - Briefly steadied when KUDOS DE SOTHYS (G Saejorhor) lay inwards under pressure near the 175 metres. G Saejorhor was advised that he must exercise greater care and straighten his mount sooner than he did on this occasion.

C Johnson (LIGHT UP) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount LIGHT UP to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of ITS SO EASY which was inconvenienced entering the first bend.

Race 2 **RANGIORA NEW WORLD MAIDEN (1600m)**

THE ARCTIC BLAST (J Laking) - Reared at the start losing ground. Briefly held up passing the 200 metres having to be steadied and shifted outwards across heels to obtain clear running.

THEUNNAMEDFEELING (C Johnson) - Slow to begin.

WHILE YOU'RE THERE (K Chowdhoo) - Taken back from a wide draw shortly after the start to obtain cover.

Race 3 **NEOVIA – ADVISORS & ACCOUNTANTS (1600m)**

JIMINY CRICKET (M Taylor) - Slow to begin.

MR GIBSON (K Chowdhoo) - Slow to begin and was then taken forward to sit outside the leader.

ARABIA (K Williams) - Raced keenly in the early stages and when being steadied passing the 1200 metres began to race fiercely placing the rider in some difficulty shifting out and making contact with LOVINGYOURWORK on a number of occasions before improving forward to sit outside the leader. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

LOVINGYOURWORK (T Moseley) - Contacted on a number of occasions throughout the back straight. Raced wide without cover from the 1150 metres. Placed in restricted room when runners to either side shifted ground and was then accidentally struck on the nose by the whip of IDEAL WARRIOR's rider near the 275 metres

ALTA BELLA (S Wynne) - Shifted ground inwards under pressure over the concluding stages and in the shadows of the winning post made contact with BLUEY'S CHANCE.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (A Balloo) - Contacted over the concluding stages.

S Wynne (ALTA BELLA) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount ALTA BELLA to shift inwards over the concluding stages making contact with BLUEY'S CHANCE in the shadows of the post.

B May (IDEAL WARRIOR) - Stewards enquired into the manner in which rider B May used his whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had contravened the rules.	
Race 4	JON SNOW & ECHOES OF HEAVEN @ CLEARVIEW PARK (1200m)
<p>VINO BELLA (G Saejorhor) - Slow to begin.</p> <p>TIFFEN (K Chowdhoory) - Crowded shortly after the start when AUNT CINDY shifted in abruptly.</p> <p>AUNT CINDY (M Taylor) - Began awkwardly shifting in abruptly crowding inside runners.</p> <p>GELATO (S Wynne) - Crowded at the start losing some ground. Hung out throughout the running.</p>	
Race 5	BOOK A RACEDAY SUITE IN 2023 MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>FUN FUN FUN (K Kwo) - The connections were advised a barrier manners warning would be placed against the mare's record after proving difficult to loan. Began awkwardly making contact with NORTIBUTNICE.</p> <p>NORTIBUTNICE (K Williams) - Knuckled leaving the barriers being slow to begin and further hampered when SHOW US PLENTY shifted out at the start.</p> <p>SHOW US PLENTY (S Wynne) - Shifted out at the start crowding outside runner.</p> <p>TRUMBY (J Laking) - Raced greenly through the early stages and lost contact with the body of the field despite the efforts of the rider.</p> <p>LOVE FIFTEEN (A Balloo) - Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages. Lay in rounding the bend near the 900 metres.</p> <p>RED ORCHID (G Jogoo) - Crowded and had to steady passing the 1000 metres when CLARK KENT shifted in when being steadied to avoid the heels of COCKAHOOP.</p> <p>IRISH MOSS (K Chowdhoory) - Raced three wide without cover from the 850 metres.</p> <p>L Callaway (COCKAHOOP) - Issued with a warning after permitting COCKAHOOP to shift inwards when not fully clear of CLARK KENT which when being steadied to avoid heels shifted in briefly crowding RED ORCHID which had to be restrained passing the 1000 metres. When assessing this incident Stewards took into account the racing manners of CLARK KENT and RED ORCHID.</p>	
Race 6	WORLD TRAVELLERS ROLLESTON & BLENHEIM MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>LITIGATOR (BB Hong) – Began awkwardly losing considerable ground.</p> <p>NIGHT RAIDER (K Chowdhoory) - Began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>COSSETTE (L Allpress) - Lay inwards across heels shortly after the start having to be steadied losing ground as a result. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Commenced to give ground and was not persevered with approaching the 150 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised the filly had felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>CRUSHING (K Williams) - Lay outwards from the 800 metres and raced greenly for the majority of the race.</p>	

O'DUA (T Comignaghi) - Shifted away from MISS BRITTANY (M Taylor) which shifted outwards under pressure contacting THE NUMBER ONE SON which then made contact with IN AWE which made contact with NIGHT RAIDER, with all three runners becoming briefly unbalanced passing the 300 metres. M Taylor was advised to exercise greater care and straighten her mount earlier than she had on this occasion.

THE NUMBER ONE SON (R Mudhoo) - Contacted and buffeted 300 metres.

IN AWE (L Callaway) - Contacted and buffeted 300 metres.

NIGHT RAIDER (K Chowdhoo) – Contacted 300 metres.

MISS BRITTANY (M Taylor) - Placed in restricted room having to be briefly steadied when CAPITAL EXPENSE (T Moseley) shifted in under pressure near the 150 metres. T Moseley was advised to exercise greater care and straighten his mount earlier than he had on this occasion.

MATSCOT (T Moseley) - Slow to begin.

VAGUE (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

JUST TICKETY BOO (D-R Tait) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

AERIAL BLUE (T Comignaghi) - Briefly held up entering the final straight.

NAMIBIA MISS (R Mudhoo) - Inclined to lay inwards in the run home.

SOOO DUSTY (S Wynne) - Reared at the start losing ground.

VARDON ROAD (M Taylor) - Slow to begin.

SWEET LILLY (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.

POWER 'N' PASSION (K Chowdhoo) - Slow into stride and as a result lost ground. Held up rounding the final bend having to shift inwards to obtain clear running passing the 400 metres.

HOLY LOCH (L Callaway) - Placed in restricted room having to be steadied passing the 1200 metres when RUBY SUNRISE (K Williams) and POWER 'N' PASSION (K Chowdhoo) shifted ground simultaneously. K Williams and K Chowdhoo were advised to exercise greater care. Made the final bend awkwardly.

COME BACK TIGER (G Saejorhor) - Lay outwards making the bend near the 600 metres having to be steadied away from heels.
