##### Race 3 RYDGES HOTEL ROTORUA MAIDEN 3YO 1230

**CALL ME BILLIE** (K Asano) – Trainer B Pomare advised Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the filly, however, has now been sent for a brief freshen up.

##### Race 9 CAMPBELL INFRASTRUCTURE MAIDEN 1230

**MARUSYA** (J Fawcett) – Trainer J Collett reported to Steward, MARUSYA underwent a veterinary examination which included an endoscopic examination with results showing mucus in the lungs with the mare now being put on a course of antibiotics. J Collett further advised he may look to nominate MARUSYA for a race meeting at the end of this month.

##### Race 3 ELLERSLIE EVENT CENTRE MAIDEN 1400

**SHOOTIN TO SAKS** (L Satherley) – Trainer D Sweeney advised Stewards on return to the stable SHOOTIN TO SAKS underwent a veterinary examination which revealed a puncture wound to the right front sole. D Sweeney further advised the gelding has now been sent for a freshen up.

##### Race 6 EAGLE CHARTERS 1200

**BABYLON BERLIN** (K Hannan) – Trainer B Foote reported to Stewards he was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare, and it is his intention to continue on with BABYLON BERLIN'S current preparation.

##### Race 8 NZB INSURANCE 1200

**BEA A ROCA** (W Pinn) – Co-trainer D Weatherley advised Stewards the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of BEA A ROCA and it is their intention to continue on with the mare's current preparation.

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>ULTIMATE MAZDA 1400</b>
<p><b>TIA D'OR</b> (C Lammas) - Slow to begin. Finished a distant last. When questioned rider reported that the mare never travelled comfortably and failed to handle the soft track conditions.</p> <p><b>MANRICO</b> (A Lawson-Carroll) – Jumped in shortly after the start. When questioned regarding the improved performance trainer reported that the gelding appreciated being able to lead and dictate the tempo.</p> <p><b>YARI</b> (B Rogerson) - Jumped inwards at the start contacting another runner. Eased down passing the 200 metres. Rider reported that the gelding failed to handle the soft track conditions.</p> <p><b>SELVA VERDE</b> (T Newman) - Jumped outwards at the start contacting another runner.</p> <p><b>ALI ARC</b> (M Kareem) – Contacted leaving the barriers. Over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>HASSTOBEYOU</b> (N Parmar) – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>KEATS</b> (J Doyle) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SIDE BY SIDE</b> (W Pinn) – Held up for clear running entering the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the mare failed to handle the soft track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>HAPPY HIRE MAIDEN 1600</b>
<p><b>OCEAN CRUIZER</b> (M Cropp) - Slow to begin.</p> <p><b>THEODEN</b> (H Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>DEAR JOHN LINCOLN</b> (W Pinn) – Jumped awkwardly contacting another runner shortly after the start. When questioned regarding performance rider reported that the gelding failed to handle the heavy track conditions.</p> <p><b>BIEDERMEIER</b> (L Satherley) – Contacted by another runner shortly after the start.</p> <p><b>BELLA VOLAIRE</b> (T Newman) – Jumped awkwardly contacting another runner shortly after the start. Had to be steadied off heels leaving the 900 metres when EL PASO shifted in to obtain cover.</p> <p><b>JACK HAMMER</b> (Y Coonee) - Saddle shifted shortly after the start placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race. Ran off passing the 800 metres and as a result became tailed off.</p> <p><b>OCEAN GAIL</b> (A Lawson-Carroll) – Raced ungenerously in the early stages.</p> <p><b>EL PASO</b> (N Parmar) - Raced three wide without cover until passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p><b>N Parmar</b> (EL PASO) - Issued with a warning after allowing his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of BELLA VOLAIRE which had to be steadied losing ground near the 900 metres.</p> <p>Following this race, the track was downgraded to Heavy 9.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>GEAR WELDING SERVICES MAIDEN 1600</b>
<p><b>VERISMO</b> (J Doyle) – Began awkwardly losing ground.</p>	

**GREY POLY** (A Goindasamy) – Began awkwardly. Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages. Raced greenly in the final straight.

**UNTETHERED** (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly contacting TOMSK. Over-raced in the early stages.

**TOMSK** (M Hashizume) - Contacted by another runner shortly after the start losing ground.

**KINDRA GIRL** (M Cropp) – Began awkwardly. Had to be steadied off heels approaching the 150 metres when GREY POLY shifted out under pressure.

**Race 4** | **STEWART BROWNE MEMORIAL MAIDEN 1600**

**YOU KNOW** (K Asano) - Required farrier attention prior to entering the birdcage. Raced in restricted room shortly after the start losing ground.

**ZAKAYA** (H Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages.

**MY EXPLOSIVE** (B Rogerson) – Jumped away awkwardly shortly after the start. Over-raced in the early stages when leading.

**PRINCESS JASMINE** (N Parmar) – Jumped away awkwardly contacting the barrier. Over-raced in the middle stages.

**WOLF MOON** (J Riddell) – Jumped inwards contacting another runner shortly after the start. Raced in restricted room leaving the 1000 metres.

**TIZ LOUIE** (W Kennedy) – Jumped outwards contacting another runner shortly after the start losing ground.

**ALL SHOOK UP** (J Doyle) – Jumped in shortly after the start.

**SASSYNESS** (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

**KAHMA SUITSYA** (M Cropp) - Raced wide without cover.

**CRUZ MISSILE** (W Pinn) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Eased down passing the 300 metres when out of contention. Performed below market expectations. When questioned, rider reported that the gelding failed to handle the heavy track conditions.

**Race 5** | **ROB PINNY REALTYCOM MAIDEN 1400**

**TAVITA MISS** (K Asano) - Began awkwardly contacting the barrier losing ground.

**JUST A KARIN** (T Thornton) – Jumped away awkwardly contacting another runner shortly after the start. Contacted near the 400 metres when DAME COUNTY shifted outwards forcing JUST A KARIN into the running line of BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE which had to be steadied off heels. When assessing this incident Stewards took into account that NEIGH KID contributed with its slight outward movement. Rider S Weatherley was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

**KING MANDALO** (H Kamaruddin) - Raced in restricted room shortly after the start.

**BLEAKHOUSE BURTIE** (J Riddell) – Raced in restricted room shortly after the start, then checked losing ground. Steadied off the heels of JUST A KARIN near the 400 metres when DAME COUNTY shifted outwards.

**NEIGH KID** (A Lawson-Carroll) – Jumped inwards abruptly shortly after the start contacting numerous runners.

**DAME COUNTY** (S Weatherley) - Shifted outwards near the 400 metres when NEIGH KID's shifted outwards slightly. Rider S Weatherley reported that the mare reacted poorly with the addition of blinkers.

**Race 6** | **DOMINATOR GARAGE DOORS MAIDEN 1400**

**KRIMINAL** (W Kennedy) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding failed to handle the heavy track conditions.

**PATRIARCA** (H Kamaruddin) – Jumped outwards contacting another runner shortly after the start. Lay outwards in the final straight when placed under pressure.

**THATSAWRAP** (B Rogerson) - Jumped awkwardly then contacted by numerous runners at the start.

**SPACE LAB** (L Satherley) - Jumped inwards contacting another runner at the start.

**TARTED UP** (K Asano) - Jumped out contacting another runner at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout.

**HEY GIRLFRIEND** (J Doyle) – Jumped inwards contacting another runner at the start. Over-raced in the early stages.

**MARIA** (T Thornton) - Over-raced in the early stages.

**SPECIAL SWEY** (S Weatherley) - Hung outwards passing the 600 metres and continued to do so for a distance.

**IT'S BUSINESS TIME** (C Grylls) – Lost the off-front plate during the running.

**H Kamaruddin** (PATRIARCA) - Admitted a charge in that he used his whip on PATRIARCA when the horse was out of contention with the Adjudicator imposing a fine of \$350.

**Race 7** | **FERTCO MAIDEN 1200**

**KITH 'N' KIN** (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly then steadied leaving the barriers.

**ANGEL WINGS** (S Weatherley) – Jumped awkwardly contacting another runner shortly after the start. Briefly came together with ABLE WHITE over the concluding stages.

**SHIVOO** (M McNab) - Contacted leaving the barriers with the rider becoming unbalanced. Lay out under pressure over the concluding stages.

**MEDINA** (W Pinn) – Jumped inwards leaving the barriers crowding several runners.

**OHIWA SUNSET** (M Cropp) – Crowded leaving the barriers, losing ground. Held up for clear running rounding the final bend.

**ABLE WHITE** (W Kennedy) – Crowded leaving the barriers, losing ground. Briefly came together with ANGEL WINGS over the concluding stages.

**KARAPIRO** (C Lammas) – Became unbalanced shortly after the start when contacted by another runner which in turn made contact with SHIVOO. Steadied off the heels of MEDINA near the 900 metres.

**Race 8** | **REAL CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS MAIDEN 1200**

**TRU PLANET** (S Weatherley) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious in the gates and was cleared to start. Began awkwardly making contact with the barriers, losing ground. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the filly failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

**ALMINETTE** (H Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly contacting another runner.

**GO BUTCH** (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly contacting another runner.

**DIAMOND ALLEY** (T Mitchell) - Knuckled approaching the 900 metres.

**H Kamaruddin** (ALMINETTE) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which he used his whip in the final straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had breached the rules, with the sixth strike being very close to the 100 metres.

**Race 9** | **JACKSON REEVES LAWYERS MAIDEN 2100**

**KIWI MAN** (M Hashizume) – Dislodged its rider during the preliminary and was late scratched at 5.56 pm on veterinary advice. M Hashizume was uninjured.

**LIKE IT SWEET** (J Doyle) – Began awkwardly contacting another runner.

**GO FIONA** (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly contacting another runner.

**NINE REALMS** (C Lammas) – Began awkwardly crowding another runner.

**WHOSHE'S BOY** (A Goindasamy) - Knuckled shortly after the start.

**DRUIDOR** (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly contacting another runner.

**JUST A TIPPLE** (N Parmar) - Began awkwardly contacting another runner.

**FRACTURED** (M Cropp) - Inclined to over-race in the early stages when being restrained. Finished a distant last. When questioned, rider could offer no explanation.

**JACK IN THE BOX** (L Satherley) - Shied at the infield rounding the final bend having to be corrected by its rider.

**KASHOCK** (W Kennedy) - Lay out when placed under pressure near the 75 metres having to be corrected by its rider. Rider reported that the mare faltered near the 50 metres and felt indifferent in its action when pulling up. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormalities.

**SHADEZ** (M McNab) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the mare failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

**KING MONDO** (T Thornton) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to have a slow post-race recovery. Stewards will follow up with the stable in the coming days.

**Race 10** | **BOSSON DEVELOPMENTS 1300**

**SEEUINABIT** (S Spratt) – Slow to begin. Improved onto heels having to be steadied entering the final straight.

**SPLASH OF RED** (A Lawson-Carroll) – Began awkwardly. Inclined to over-race in the middle stages.

**KELLY KEEPER** (T Mitchell) - Began awkwardly.

**THATCHER** (J Doyle) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

**LORD VALENTINE** (H Kamaruddin) – Held up for clear running entering the final straight.

**HAYATE** (N Parmar) – Inclined to shift outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

**Race 11**

**YRW CHARTERED ACCOUNTANTS 1600**

**CHASE 'N' GOLD** (J Doyle) – Slow to begin.

**TEEN TITAN** (J Riddell) – Began awkwardly.

**HOT SALSA** (H Kamaruddin) – Began awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early stages.

**EL BANDOLERO** (T Thornton) – Began awkwardly contacting another runner.

**FIERCE FLIGHT** (N Parmar) – Contacted by another runner shortly after the start.

**LULO ROSE** (W Pinn) – Began awkwardly contacting another runner. Placed in restricted room having to be steadied near the 200 metres when runners either side shifted ground. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the mare failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

**DIOSA LUNA** (R Elliot) - Had to be steadied off heels approaching the 200 metres when HOT SALSA shifted ground outward

**H Kamaruddin** (HOT SALSA) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift outwards when insufficiently clear of DIOSA LUNA which had to be steadied off heels near the 200 metres. Apprentice rider H Kamaruddin assisted by riding mentor N Harris was shown a replay and advised that he must stop riding and make a greater effort to straighten his mounts when they commence to shift ground when not clear of other runners.
