RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 RETURN 2 EARTH MAIDEN 1600m

VIVA LE VADA (M McNab) - Dislodged its rider during the preliminary and escaped riderless but was quickly recaptured and underwent a veterinary examination before being cleared to race. Rider M McNab was uninjured in this incident. Commenced to give ground early in the final straight. M McNab was questioned regarding the disappointing run after the gelding was not persevered with over the final stages and could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have a minor respiratory complaint.

The start of Race 1 was delayed due to the Clerk of the Course becoming dislodged from his horse and requiring medical treatment from St John personnel prior to being transferred to hospital. As a result the start of Race 1 was officially put back to the start time of Race 2 at 1.00pm, with all subsequent races put back a race and Race 8 rescheduled at 5.07pm.

TAVI ANN (J Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and was then hampered losing ground.

DEFENDER (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced greenly throughout. Commenced to give ground quickly passing the 600 metres and was not persevered with in the final straight. The connections were advised that a warning would be placed regarding the gelding's competitiveness.

BIGGIE (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin drifting out making contact with TRIGGER HAPPY.

TRIGGER HAPPY (L Allpress) - Slow to begin and was then contacted shortly after the start.

LOVE NESST (M Singh) - Slow to begin.

LOOSESPENDER (K Asano) - Raced ungenerously through the early stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 2 MONSTAVISION MAIDEN 3YO 1600m

MARK TWAIN (K Asano) - Slow to begin.

DUPUG (L Sutherland) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

REGGIE RULER (J Kamaruddin) - Raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1400 metres. Held up having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 175 metres.

DEAR JOHN LINCOLN (W Pinn) - Had to be briefly steadied off the heels of REGGIE RULER (J Kamaruddin) which shifted out when not fully clear. J Kamaruddin was advised to exercise greater care.

KAHMA SUITSYA (J Fawcett) - Hung outwards throughout the final straight.

Race 3 STELLA ARTOIS 1600m

PINSK (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

AIR WAVES (K Hercock) - Raced three wide without cover.

ARJAYBEE (J Kamaruddin) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

LIPPY (W Pinn) - Raced in restricted room for the majority of the home straight.

SHA CARRI (K Hannan) - Lay out under pressure throughout the final straight. Rider reported that the mare may be better suited to a longer distance.

KENKI (L Hemi) - Had to be angled out wide to improve near the 150 metres.

The track was upgraded to Good 4 retrospective to Race 3.

Race 4 NZB INSURANCE PEARL SERIES RACE MAIDEN 1400m

MADAM SASS (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

DONTTELLTIMMY (M McNab) - Buffeted at the start losing ground. Lay out throughout the home straight making brief contact with EXPLOSIVE LASS near the 150 metres.

RUSHANN (C Barnes) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

THE WITCH (C Butler) - Raced ungenerously getting its head up on a number of occasions through the early and middle stages.

EXPLOSIVE LASS (L Douglas) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Contacted near the 150 metres.

Race 5 JOHN TODD MEMORIAL 1400m

TOP NOTE (W Pinn) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination at the barriers and was cleared fit to race. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BRUNO MAGILE (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly shifting out making contact with TENZING.

TENZING (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin and was then contacted shortly after the start losing ground. Held up rounding the final bend shifting out making brief contact with ALWAYS MORE. Lay in under pressure throughout the final straight.

LINDA LOLA (K Asano) - Slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout.

ALWAYS MORE (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Briefly contacted final bend.

CATSACHARMER (M Singh) - Over raced through the early and middle stages.

ALWAYS MORE (L Allpress) - Contacted final bend.

MARGHERITA VELOCE (C Grylls) - Held up entering the final straight having to shift outwards to obtain clear running passing the 50 metres.

LOIS LANE (J Mudhoo) - Was not persevered with from near the 200 metres, with the rider advising that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

Race 6 COMCAT MAIDEN 1400m

BURLACE (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

TESTIFY ME (L Douglas) - Slow to begin. Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages getting its head up on a number of occasions. Was inclined to lay in under pressure in the home straight under hard riding.

ROEDERER (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Raced in restricted room rounding the turn.

TOP OF THE LINE (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly making contact with OUTER FOCUS and as a result lost ground. Spoken to regarding her whip use in the home straight.

LEGALLY BLONDE (S O'Malley) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

OUTER FOCUS (K Asano) - Contacted at the start.

TEXTBOOK (L Hemi) - Restrained behind runners from its wide barrier to obtain cover shortly after the start.

SIT DOWN DEAR (C Grylls) - Over raced through the early and middle stages. Became awkwardly placed on heels having to be briefly steadied when DUBLIN CASTLE (J Kamaruddin) shifted out passing the 200 metres. J Kamaruddin was advised he must straighten his mount sooner than he had on this occasion.

RUSTY LANE (K Hannan) - Lay out under pressure throughout the final straight.

DUBLIN CASTLE (J Kamaruddin) - Lay out under pressure from near the 150 metres.

Race 7 \$5,500 PUNTERS COMP FEB 4TH MAIDEN 1100m

FOXRAMBLA (L Douglas) - Declared a late scratching at 4.20pm after refusing to parade. Connections were advised that the mare will now be required to trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

TU TANGATA (L Hemi) - Reared over backwards behind the barriers dislodging its rider. Underwent a veterinary examination and was cleared to race. L Hemi was attended to by St John personnel and cleared to ride. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed on TU TANGATA's barrier manners.

KEANTOKISS (F Lazet) - Began awkwardly. Hung outwards and raced greenly throughout and could not be ridden out fully due to the saddle slipping rounding the final bend.

THE UGLY SISTER (L Allpress) - Slow to begin.

RETURNTOSENDA (J Fawcett) - Restrained behind runners from its wide barrier to obtain cover shortly after the start.

ANDIT HURTS (J Mudhoo) - Held up approaching the 400 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until early in the final straight.

CHOPPER REED (K Hannan) - Not persevered with in the home straight. Rider reported that the gelding had hung inwards rounding the final bend and was making abnormal breathing noises. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Stewards will follow up in coming days.

LOUISIANA MAN (M McNab) - Lost the near front plate during the running.

Race 8 LANDMARK HOMES CITY OF NEW PLYMOUH CUP 2000m

NOD (K Hannan) - Nose band broke prior to the start and could not be replaced. Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

RAZORS EDGE (C Butler) - Slow to begin then blundered losing ground.

ROSCHANA (C Barnes) - Slow to begin and was then taken back behind runners to obtain cover.

WAISAKE (L Douglas) - Slow to begin and was then taken back behind runners to obtain cover.

WANNABE 'N' VEGAS (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

SPORTING CHANCE (W Pinn) - Raced greenly and was inclined to shift ground under pressure throughout the home straight.

REGAL ROCK (J Fawcett) - Held up early in the final straight.

CHAMPERS (S O'Malley) – Lost the near hind plate during the running.

L Douglas (WAISAKE) - Issued with a warning after using his whip on WAISAKE when the horse was out of contention.
