RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 MARTY & DI CATERING MAIDEN 2100

BINIKA (V Jalalkuncha) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Rider dropped his whip approaching the 300 metres.

GALILEO INVADER (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced ungenerously getting its head up on a number of occasions through the early stages. Dictated outwards 600 metres.

JAMESON (S O'Malley) - Raced three wide without cover through the early stages before improving forward to lead near the 1100 metres.

C'MON EILEEN (C Barnes) - When being angled outwards near the 600 metres to obtain clear running, dictated GALILEO INVADER outwards, which in turn forced REBELWOOD over extra ground. C Barnes was shown footage of her ride and reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

REBELWOOD (J Mudhoo) - Forced over extra ground near the 600 metres. Made the final bend awkwardly.

Race 2 MERRYLEES HOTEL 2100

SWING LOW (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

UNUSUAL SAINT (S O'Malley) - Slow to begin.

HEY HEY HEY (C Grylls) - Slow to begin. When questioned rider advised that in his opinion the gelding is better suited to more rain affected going and may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

NUN SO BAD (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

HESACITIBOY (V Jalalkuncha) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

TRUSTWORTHY (L Hemi) - Crowded and checked 1800 metres.

GINGER SNAPZ (K Hercock) - Forced inwards 1800 metres.

HIKON (L Allpress) - Steadied off heels near the 1800 metres.

ALMERAKI (F Lazet) - Held up for the majority of the final straight having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running passing the 150 metres.

BEAR GRYLS (M Singh) - When questioned regarding the improved performance, connections advised the gelding had been better suited when leading on this occasion as opposed to its recent runs.

M Singh (BEAR GRYLS) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted BEAR GRYLS to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of GINGER SNAPZ, which was forced inwards on to TRUSTWORTHY, which was crowded and checked, with HIKON having to be steadied off heels near the 1800 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of his licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday, 4 January 2023 up to and including racing on Friday, 13 January 2023, 7 national riding days.

Race 3 WALK THE NEW HIGHWAY 22 JANUARY 1600

SAVANAH BELLE (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

HUNGRY (M McNab) - Slow to begin. Lost the left hind plate during the running. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities. Connections advised the gelding would now be sent for a spell.

ONE DREAM ONE SOUL (A Mudhoo) - Unable to take advantage of a narrow run which briefly presented near the 300 metres, so then had to shift ground outwards to improve after RUBY ROCKS shifted in when not fully clear. C Grylls was shown footage of his ride and advised to exercise greater care.

Following the race connections of the 2nd placed ONE DREAM ONE SOUL viewed footage of the home straight but elected not to proceed with an objection against the winner, RUBY ROCKS.

Race 4 DANNEVIRKE DAIRY SUPPLIES MAIDEN 1600

STORMCAST (L Allpress) - Slow to begin. Commenced to race ungenerously for a distance passing the 1200 metres.

TICKFORD (L Hemi) - From its wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

TAKING STOCK (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the event.

GIN TRAP (M Singh) - Improved on to heels having to be steadied approaching the 400 metres.

KANUKA (C Barnes) - Lost the near hind plate during the running.

CHECKPOINT CHARLIE (K Hercock) - When questioned regarding performance rider was of the opinion the gelding would benefit from any easing in track conditions.

Race 5 SHANE BROWN RACING MAIDEN 1200

BELLA DA PARTY (K Hercock) - Shifted out shortly after the start crowding GUM BASHER.

GUM BASHER (S O'Malley) Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

BELLUCCI (M McNab) - Crowded shortly after the start losing ground.

DETONATE (T Allan) - Shifted in shortly after the start crowding BELLUCCI.

GRAEME JOHN (L Hemi) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

COURVOISIER (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Finished some distance last. When questioned rider could offer no excuse. Connections advised the filly's racing future would be reassessed.

JE SWEY (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CACTUS ROSE (C Butler) - Raced greenly rounding the final bend.

RUSTY O'CEIRIN (C Grylls) - Had to shift ground inwards when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of CACTUS ROSE (C Butler), which lay out and away from BELLUCCI passing the 200 metres. C Butler was shown footage of her ride in the presence of the Apprentice Mentor and reminded that she must straighten her mount sooner than she had done on this occasion.

Race 6 EQUINE-N-MIND 1200

BRADMAN (M McNab) - Hung outwards rounding the final bend and throughout the home straight.

VISHAKHA (C Barnes) - Blundered at the start and was then crowded, losing ground.

LINCOLN RAIDER (C Grylls) - Slow to begin.

BLUE ON BLACK (A Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly losing ground. When questioned rider reported the gelding had hung outwards throughout the running proving a difficult ride. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

Race 7 DANNEVIRKE MEAT COMPANY 1400

PRECIOUS NIAMH (L Sutherland) - Slow to begin.

FIVE FORTUNE (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly making contact with SUNLIT LANE and as a result lost ground.

SUNLIT LANE (K Hannan) - Contacted at the start losing ground. Was not persevered with passing the 200 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider could offer no excuse. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be 1/5 lame in the off-front leg.

SHARE POWER (V Jalalkuncha) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

MANIFIQUE (M McNab) - Contacted then hampered losing ground at the start. Held up for the majority of the final straight and was unable to obtain clear racing room until near the 100 metres.

OUR JUMALA (L Allpress) - Began awkwardly making contact with MANIFIQUE.

MATINEE (K Hercock) – From its wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

SON OF THUNDER (F Lazet) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

IVY DAZZLER (A Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

SHOWBOURNE (C Grylls) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

V Jalalkuncha (SHARE POWER) - Spoken to regarding the use of his whip in the home straight.
