RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 | **SENJO SECURITY MAIDEN 1800**

ANNETARZ (C Barnes) – Began awkwardly.

MEGA MOGUL (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly then raced in restricted room shortly after, losing ground. Made the crossing awkwardly near the 1500 metres.

THE JAKKAL (J Fawcett) – Began awkwardly.

SPACE LAB (L Satherley) – Inclined to lay out shortly after the start. Raced keenly leaving the home straight on the first occasion.

THATSAWRAP (B Rogerson) – Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

CON ARTIST (S Spratt) – Raced wide in the early and middle stages. Hampered and forced wider near the 1500 metres. Shifted in under pressure entering the home straight then was inclined to shift out over the concluding stages.

BERWYN (K Hannan) - Lay out making the crossing near the 1500 metres hampering CON ARTIST which was forced wider.

STRANGE LOVE (J Bayliss) – Improved onto heels passing the 800 metres having to be steadied. Lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

FUNZONE (J Doyle) – Steadied before having to shift out to avoid heels passing the 200 metres.

MEHZEBEEN (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly had not travelled comfortably throughout and in his opinion was unsuited by today's track conditions.

S Spratt (CON ARTIST) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount to shift in when not sufficiently clear of FUNZONE which had to be steadied to avoid heels passing the 200 metres.

VARUNI (J Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin.

DON PAULY (S McKay) - Slow to begin. Raced keenly for a distance when being restrained approaching the 1000 metres.

RICHARD STOMPER (S Weatherley) - Over-raced in the early stages.

MATAHIWI (K Hannan) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

BRANCIFORTI (S Spratt) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

IMPULSE CONTROL (W Pinn) - Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 175 metres.

J Doyle (LUCKY SIMON) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount to shift inwards when not sufficiently clear of IMPULSE CONTROL near the 175 metres. Contributing was outward movement from PATRIARCA.

O Bosson (PATRIARCA) - Issued with a warning for weighing in 0.6 kgs heavier than the weight at which he weighed out.

TOO CLASSY (J Bayliss) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

KING'S MOUNT (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin.

HOLA PAPI (C Barnes) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the filly had raced greenly throughout and failed to respond when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.

PRIMO VINO (R Elliot) – Over-raced in the early stages. Had to be steadied when placed in restricted room near the 800 metres to the outside of HOLA PAPI which shifted out abruptly despite the efforts of its rider. Improved onto heels having to be steadied just prior the winning post.

ASMARDE (L Satherley) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

J Bayliss (TOO CLASSY) - Issued with a warning after using the whip in two consecutive strides on TOO CLASSY passing the 50 metres with Stewards taking into account his clear recent record with regard to a breach of this whip rule.

Following this race, the track was upgraded to Firm 2.

Race 4 | **THE KINLOCH COUNTRY LODGE TROPHY 1300**

RUDYARD (S Weatherley) - Slow to begin. Improved onto heels just prior to the winning post.

TINA AGAIN (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide in the early stages.

CALVARIA (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

LAKEMAN (T Mitchell) - Slow to begin.

PENNY ROYAL (L Sutherland) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BARONET (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the gelding had failed to handle today's track conditions.

J Bayliss (FLORENCENIGHTNGALE) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in two consecutive strides on his mount FLORENCENIGHTNGALE near the 50 metres with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$150.

Race 5 | **COSANA NZ MAIDEN 1100**

RENEGADE RUPERT (J Fawcett) - Jumped in the air as the gates opened, losing ground.

SEAMSEW (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ELUSIVE NATION (J Doyle) – Knuckled on jumping away then hampered shortly after. Improved onto heels leaving the back straight having to check, losing ground.

DAPPER LAD (C Barnes) – Over-raced when being restrained in the early stages.

DESERT ISLAND (A Goindasamy) – Over-raced in the early stages.

PUZZLE SOLVED (C Grylls) – Returned to the enclosure having shifted its off-fore plate during the race.

Race 6 | **POVERTY BAY TURF CLUB 1200**

LIGHTNING FIELD (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly.

NORTH OF HAVANA (J Doyle) – Slow to begin.

HERO WORSHIP (S Weatherley) – Slow to begin.

ZEITAKU (J Kamaruddin) - Shifted in just prior to the winning post having to be steadied after improving onto the heels of MACTHIEF which shifted out. K Hannan was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

Race 7 | **J SWAP CONTRACTORS LTD MAIDEN 1100**

RADRADRA (J Bayliss) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Steadied when placed in restricted room near the 500 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that after being steadied near the 500 metres the gelding had failed to respond when placed under pressure in the straight.

SAN SIMEON (J Doyle) – Began awkwardly.

SWAZI (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly.

SIR STERLING (W Pinn) – Raced wide without cover throughout.

Race 8 | **HARCOURTS TAUPO CUP 2000**

LANGKAWI (J Bayliss) - Slow to begin. Held up until near the 150 metres.

HUNTA PENCE (L Sutherland) – Slow to begin. Raced three wide in the middle stages.

ROGER THAT (L Satherley) – Knuckled shortly after the start.

HINEPARA (A Goindasamy) – Slow to begin then restrained shortly after the start.

TUTUKAKA (M McNab) – Made the crossing awkwardly.

MASETTO (J Doyle) – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

PEP TORQUE (K Hercock) - Steadied when placed in restricted room approaching the 200 metres. When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that in her opinion the gelding had failed to back up from its run at Otaki on 26 December.

ENRIGHT (T Thornton) - Inconvenienced approaching the 200 metres by TUTUKAKA which shifted in when not fully clear. M McNab was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

CALPURNIA (B Rogerson) – Lost the left front plate during the running.

J Bayliss (LANGKAWI) - Admitted a charge of using the whip in two consecutive strides on two occasions on his mount LANGKAWI near the 50 metres with the Adjudicative Committee imposing a fine of \$500.

Race 9 | **WAIKATO EQUINE VETERINARY CENTRE 1800**

SHOCKALLIA (K Hannan) - Began awkwardly.

MIGHTY CONNOR (C Grylls) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

TE POROPITI (S Spratt) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the race.

FAST WILLIE (J Kamaruddin) - Steadied when placed in restricted room to the inside of GOLDEN KIWI near the 1600 metres then made the bend awkwardly when racing keenly. J Doyle was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances. Continued to race keenly through the middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend.

SET IN STONE (B Rogerson) - When questioned regarding the performance the rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any abnormality.
