Race 3 - KINGS SHOE STORE & "GO RACING" 1200

Trainer P Harris advised Stewards that **RADIANT ROSIE** post-race has been found to be suffering a respiratory virus and has been treated accordingly. He further advised the mare would not take her place at Greymouth on Tuesday but hoped to have her ready for Kumara on the 7th of January.

Race 1 MENNIES MINI DIG / HALDER HEDGE CUTTING MAIDEN (1400m)

SPIN A CHAMPION (S Khetoo) - Fractious in the barriers. Reared and began awkwardly, losing ground. Connections were advised the gelding was on a barrier manners warning. Co-trainer K Tyler advised the Stewards he would be reassessing the racing future of the gelding.

PINX (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

SHE'S A CON (K Mudhoo) - Slow to begin.

THE BLAZING ONE (J Lowry) - Contacted and briefly unbalanced passing the 1000 metres. Contacted again passing the 200 metres.

STILL GOT HOME (K Kwo) - Raced wide for the majority of the event. Lay outwards rounding the bend and proved difficult to steer, losing contact with the field and not being persevered with from the 500 metres. Rider reported the gelding had raced greenly throughout and had been field shy when around other horses. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality. Connections were advised that the gelding was on a racing manners warning.

PURE ZAMBEZI (K Williams) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running in the run home, only gaining clear racing room inside the final 250 metres.

THE GREY GOOSE (T Moseley) - Raced greenly throughout the run home and shifted ground outwards near the 200 metres making contact with THE BLAZING ONE before being straightened by its rider.

PETAL (C Campbell) - Rider advised the filly had been disappointing and he could offer no tangible explanation.

Race 2 DAVE HEGARTY & ROSS MALCOLM @ HARCOURTS / TRENZ HOMES (1400m)

RUBY ROYALE (C Campell) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start after hitting its head at the plate inspection and receiving a slight laceration to the nose.

OUR BOY RITCHIE (S Khetoo) - Restrained to obtain cover after jumping from a wide draw.

IMBLAZE (K Kalychurun) - Lay inwards throughout the run home, having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

K Mudhoo (ZAC BLACK) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which K Mudhoo used his whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had breached the rules.

Race 3 DONALD WHITE HEDGE CUTTING MAIDEN (1200m)

IMAGERY (K Kalychurun) - Over-raced through the middle stages and got its head up on a number of occasions, having to be steadied off heels passing the 800 metres.

DAVID MOSS (K Mudhoo) - Raced greenly when making the bend near the 375 metres, shifting wider on the track.

MABEL (C Campbell) - When questioned regarding the performance of favoured runner rider was of the opinion that the filly needs more ground.

THE SAPPHIRE (K Williams) - Rider advised that the filly would take natural benefit from today's first up run.

Race 4 RIVERTON SUPERVALUE / FIRST NATIONAL REAL ESTATE RIVERTON MAIDEN (1200m)

AUSPICIOUSOCCASION (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin, then lost contact with the field in the early stages despite the efforts of the rider.

THE KINGS GIRL (L Callaway) - Briefly had to be steadied off heels passing the 1000 metres when SANDY COOL shifted inwards after that runner had become awkwardly placed inside the heels of WELLAINTSHE.

THE ADVISOR (K Williams) - Held up for clear racing room through the middle stages of the run home. Lay out abruptly passing the 100 metres having to be straightened.

WELLAINTSHE (C Campbell) - Had to be steadied racing into the first bend and when doing so, got its head up and made the bend awkwardly, shifting wider on the track near the 800 metres and then continued to race ungenerously for a short distance before obtaining cover near the 700 metres.

JIBBITY (K Kalychurun) - When asked to comment on the performance the rider could offer no tangible excuse, advising the filly had been disappointing.

Race 5 MACAULAY MOTORS / FLIPPIN FRESH FISH (1220m)

PROBELLA (T Moseley) - Crowded shortly after the start and was then taken back to obtain cover. Rider advised that after getting back in the field he had found it difficult to make ground over the concluding stages on a good tempo.

ELUSIVE TEN (K Williams) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages, getting its head up on a number of occasions.

EARL OF ORKNEY (K Kwo) - Briefly held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

GO LOTTE (S Khetoo) - Had to shift ground outwards passing the 100 metres to find clear racing room.

IRON MIKE (J Laking) - Rider advised he had been disappointed with the effort and believed the gelding may be looking for tracks with more moisture content.

MI CAROL (Y Atchamah) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that after getting further back than he had wanted the mare had failed to respond when placed under pressure and had been disappointing.

Race 6 UNCLE BUCKS SECOND HAND SHOP / DEMPSTER PAINTING & DECORATING (2147m)

PLATINUM ROAD (K Kalychurun) - Over-raced in the early stages and made the bend near the 1600 metres awkwardly, then raced three wide for a distance before obtaining cover near the 1300 metres.

DR VELOCIOUS (J Lowry) - Improved wide from the 1200 metres to sit outside the leader from the 800 metres.

SUTHERLAND (G Jogoo) - Commenced to give ground from the 1000 metres finishing in a distant last placing. Rider expressed disappointment with the performance advising that the gelding had been under pressure a long way from home. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have suffered cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer J Gordon was advised that SUTHERLAND will not be permitted to start in any race or trial until a veterinary certificate is supplied declaring the horse free of any cardiac arrhythmia following a gallop of at least 1000 metres.

ZAMBEZI ZIPPER (S Khetoo) - Steadied near the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.

COSY NOOK (K Mudhoo) - Lay inwards passing the 225 metres and had to be straightened.

Race 7 BLAIR RACZ FENCING / OTAUTAU FARMLANDS MAIDEN (1600m)

MRS LAWRENCE (C Campbell) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Blundered passing the 500 metres.

THE TUI TOILER (K Kalychurun) - Began very awkwardly losing considerable ground. Raced greenly through the early stages then locked on one rein racing into the back straight and was not persevered with thereafter. Connections were advised the gelding was stood down to trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next.

REINEDELARIVIERE (S Khetoo) - Slow to begin. Raced three wide without cover through the early and middle stages.

LEVON (T Moseley) - Taken back from a wide draw to obtain cover shortly after the start.

BETH DUTTON (S Toolooa) - Held up near the 250 metres and had to shift ground inwards passing the 150 metres to find clear racing room.

Race 8 ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER (1600m)

CANDIDATE (J Laking) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

RITA HAYWORTH (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly losing ground, before improving wide around the field to lead passing the 1000 metres.

THE CLUSTER (J Lowry) - Began awkwardly. Held up early in the run home and when obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres, lay inwards having to be corrected by its rider.

GERRY JOYCE (K Kalychurun) - Blundered leaving the barriers.

GINTYS GIRL (L Callaway) - Got its head up when being steadied racing into the bend by the 900 metres.

DORIS DAY (K Mudhoo) - Held up early in the run home and had to be steadied passing the 200 metres when THE CLUSTER, which was laying in, shifted in before being straightened.

ADIKTIV PASSION (T Moseley) - When asked to comment on the performance rider expressed disappointment and could offer no tangible excuse.
