**CHOPPER REED (K Hannan)** – Stable Foreman Mr. R Mildon advised Stewards, the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of CHOPPER REED, however, has now been retired from racing.

**SHE'S PATSY (L Allpress)** – Trainer Mr. M Dixon reported to Stewards, SHE'S PATSY underwent a Veterinary Examination on Wednesday 28 December, which included blood tests, with results showing the mare to be suffering from slight dehydration, and a virus which has now been treated for with a course of antibiotics. M Dixon further advised SHE'S PASTY has now been sent for a freshen up.

**Race 2 JCE CONSTRUCT 3YO MAIDEN 1200**

**CROSSFIRE (F Lazet)** – Racing Manager of the Into Win Syndicates Ms. T Balcombe advised Stewards, on return to the stable CROSSFIRE underwent an Endoscopic Examination which revealed the filly to have a wind issue. T Balcombe further advised they will now look to race CROSSFIRE more relaxed and have also applied a tongue tie to the filly's gear.

**Race 7 DANNEVIRKE MEAT COMPANY 1400**

**SUNLIT LANE (K Hannan)** – Mr. S Brown reported to Stewards, he was satisfied with the post-race condition of SUNLIT LANE, however, has now been sent for a freshen up.

**RACE COMMENTS**

**Race 1 JACKSON STREET BAR MAIDEN 1000**

**MISS LILLY** (C Butler) - Slow away.

**RAURIMU** (F Lazet) - Tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground. Checked 400 metres.

**ZAH HONEY** (S O'Malley) - Made the bend near the 400 metres awkwardly and shifted out directing SPEAKEASY into the line of RAURIMU, which was checked.

**ASAHI** (L Sutherland) - Checked near the 300 metres when SAINT OLIVER was angled outwards when not clear. Directed outwards near the finish when SAINT OLIVER shifted out.

**SAINT OLIVER** (K Hercock) - Raced greenly throughout.

**SPEAKEASY** (W Pinn) - lost the left hind plate during the running.

**K Hercock** (SAINT OLIVER) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted SAINT OLIVER to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of ASAHI which was checked near the 300 metres. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of her from the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 7 January up to and including race on Friday, 13 January, 4 national riding days.

**R Bergerson** (ASAHI) - Issued with a warning under Rule 616(2) for presenting his runner with unnotified gear (pre-race ear covers).

**Race 2 VALLEY PLUMBING 1000**

**ZAMBEZI KHAN** (K Hercock) - Had to steady off heels near the 500 metres. Held up early in the home straight having to angle across heels to gain clear running.

**LANGMORE** (L Allpress) - Changed legs and shied at the winning post. Lost the near fore plate during the running.

**Race 3 COTTER & STEVENS 1000**

**MOCHATINI** (W Pinn) - Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination behind the barriers and was cleared to start. Over-raced through the early stages.

**SCOTCH** (S O'Malley) - Slow away. Over-raced through the early stages.

**RAFFLE** (M McNab) - Held up in the early stages of the home straight.

**Race 4 PUKEMANU TAVERN MAIDEN 1600**

**THE FAT LADY SINGS** (L Sutherland) - Slow away.

**ROADSTER** (J Riddell) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

**FLICK THE SWITCH** (K Hercock) - Raced wide throughout.

**RIGHT NOW** (M Singh) - Over-raced having to be steadied for a distance from the 800 metres. Held up in the early stages of the home straight.

**M Singh** (RIGHT NOW) - Spoken to regarding his whip action in the home straight.

**Race 5** | **SARGENTS MOTORCYCLES 1400**

**MISS SAILOR** (S O'Malley) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Lay in under pressure over the concluding stages.

**ACTING UP** (K Hercock) - Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

**BEAN A PLEASURE** (L Allpress) - Made the final bend awkwardly.

**PLATINUM ASSAULT** (J Riddell) - Performed below market expectations. Rider reported the gelding had lugged out throughout and when placed under pressure failed to respond and he considered something may be amiss. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**GLIDE QUEEN** (F Lazet) - Performed below market expectations. Rider advised the mare had never travelled well throughout and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality. Trainer advised Stewards the mare would be spelled.

**Race 6** | **POWER RELATED SERVICES 2050**

**TAUPARAE** (K Hercock) - Began awkwardly and slow away as a result. Performed below market expectations. Rider was disappointed with the mare's effort and could offer no excuse. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**SWING LOW** (T Taiaroa) - Began awkwardly and slow away as a result. Improved on to heels over the concluding stages having to be steadied.

**BEADMAN** (L Douglas) - Over-raced in the early stages. Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

**SCUTAR** (F Lazet) - Over-raced when leading through the early stages.

**SUBTLE TEASE** (M Singh) - Finished last. When questioned into performance rider advised the mare never travelled well throughout. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

**Race 7** | **KURIPUNI TAVERN MAIDEN 2050**

**ZACKERY** (M Singh) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

**YUNGBLUD** (F Lazet) - Raced wide through the early and middle stages.

**BEAUTIFUL NOISE** (L Sutherland) - Made the first bend awkwardly bumping SOUL OF FIRE.

**SOUL OF FIRE** (M McNab) - Bumped approaching the 1600 metres. Shifted inwards abruptly passing the 300 metres but was immediately straightened by its rider. This resulted in YUNGBLUD having to change ground and shift to the outside.

**DANGER MOUSE** (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly. Finished towards the rear. Trainer advised Stewards the mare's racing future would be reconsidered.

**LUVANUVA** (T Taiaroa) - Finished towards the rear. Trainer advised Stewards the filly's racing future would be reconsidered.

**Race 8**

**ROSIE'S FURNITURE REMOVALS MAIDEN 1400**

**HYDRO CHARM** (T Taiaroa) - Raced without a tongue tie. Held up rounding the turn when the pace ahead eased and was unable to improve its position until well into the home straight.

**STAND ALONE** (L Douglas) - Reared as the start was made, losing considerable ground.

**PERFECT POSY** (K Hercock) - Over-raced in the middle stages. Steadied 800 metres.

**MAGIC BORDEAUX** (L Hemi) - Raced wide throughout.

**LA CAPITA** (M Singh) - Over-raced throughout. Steadied for some distance passing the 600 metres when in restricted room and had to be steadied when the pace ahead eased.

**SOUND TRACK** (F Lazet) - Steadied 800 metres when pace ahead eased.

**S O'Malley** (VICTORTHEINFLECTOR) - Issued with a warning after slowing the pace near the 800 metres, which resulted in the following runners having to be steadied: SOUND TRACK (F Lazet), HYDRO CHARM (T Taiaroa), and PERFECT POSY (K Hercock) Stewards took into account the evidence of F Lazet who confirmed her mount was racing keenly when assessing the degree of interference.
