IFFIDAPUNT (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly.	
REBELWOOD (J Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.	
FLERTA (C Grylls) - Briefly held up entering the home straight.	
Race 2	TE AKAU RACING 3YO 1200
SCELTA DI ELENA (M Hudson) - Began awkwardly.	
DIAMOND THIEF (M McNab) - Slow away.	
JOLI SOLEIL (J Bayliss) - Over-raced in the early stages.	

ROCABABY (L Allpress) - Lay inwards having to be straightened on several occasions in the home straight.

BEST SELLER (S Spratt) - Lay inwards under pressure over the concluding stages. Rider reported that although BEST SELLER has wet track form the filly was not entirely comfortable in the conditions and would derive benefit from today's race.

Race 3	THE PAVEMASTERS 1100

ON THE BUBBLES (J Riddell) - Began awkwardly, bumping ROCKET SCIENCE. Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider advised his intention was to ride the gelding forward but after being awkwardly away, was unable to do so and failed to finish the race off as expected. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

ROCKET SCIENCE (J Doyle) - Bumped at start.

SHAMUS (C Grylls) - Briefly held up entering the home straight. Lay outwards over the concluding stages.

DEERFIELD (J Bayliss) - Rider advised his saddle had slipped placing him at a disadvantage and could not ride the gelding out fully over the concluding stages.

JUSTASKPERCY (A Goindasamy) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

FIVE FORTUNE (L Douglas) - Began awkwardly, bumping MY FATHER'S GUN.

MY FATHER'S GUN (J Riddell) - Bumped at the start.

LIFFEY (S O'Malley) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw.

BOLD IRIS (M McNab) - Held up early in the home straight, gaining clear racing room passing the 300 metres.

MCKHAN (K Hercock) - Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

SPIRIT OF BEXLEY (S Spratt) - When questioned into performance, Trainer C Osman advised the mare had not been comfortable in today's track conditions.

PERFECTSISTER (C Grylls) - Performed below market expectations. When questioned rider advised the mare had not been comfortable in today's track conditions.

Race 5	RICHARD SIMPSON CONTRACTING 1600

BELARDO BOY (J Doyle) - Slow away. Lost the near fore plate during the running.

RUBY ROCKS (W Pinn) - Bumped passing the 400 metres with the rider becoming unbalanced when KELLY COE (L Allpress) improved into a marginal gap which narrowed when CONOR O'CEIRIN made the bend awkwardly and shifted out. L Allpress was advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

COLORADO STAR (M McNab) - Held up until passing the 350 metres.

SERGIO (J Bayliss) - Hung outwards under pressure over the concluding stages and could not be fully ridden out. When questioned rider confirmed that the gelding had hung outwards shortly after entering the home straight.

HE'S A DOOZY (K Asano) - Performed below market expectations. Rider advised the gelding had not been comfortable in today's track conditions under the 62kg top weight.

ALL IN BLACKBERRY (M Hudson) - Slow to begin.

HESACITIBOY (S Spratt) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw. Improved on to heels having to be steadied near the 400 metres.

MASSO (A Goindasamy) - Restrained to the rear from its wide draw. Angled wide in the home straight to gain clear racing room.

DIVINE SPIRIT (K Asano) - Improved on to heels entering the first bend having to be steadied.

HE NO OPILIO (F Lazet) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Lay outwards under pressure over the concluding stages.

TORQUE TIME (S O'Malley) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

HEY HEY HEY (K Hercock) - Lay inwards and had to be straightened near the 400 metres.

BEAR GRYLS (T Taiaroa) - Bumped near the 350 metres when weakening when WENEEDASHOCK (J Doyle) improved to its outside. J Doyle was shown footage and advised to exercise greater care when in similar circumstances.

DALMATIA (J Riddell) - When questioned into performance rider advised the gelding had not been suited to today's track conditions.

SOUTHROAD (J Bayliss) - When questioned Trainer A Sharrock advised Stewards that recent racing and the addition of blinkers had contributed to the gelding's improved performance.

J Bayliss (SOUTHROAD) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which J Bayliss used his whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that he had contravened the rules.

Race 7	JAPAC HOMES MARTON CUP 2200 (Listed Race)

LANGKAWI (J Bayliss) - Began awkwardly, losing ground. Over-raced and had to be steadied off heels passing the winning post on the first occasion.

WAISAKI (J Riddell) - Restrained to the rear from a wide draw.

SAVANAH BELLE (A Goindasamy) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MARIETTA LANE (W Pinn) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

PRINCE LEO (D Bradley) - Raced wide throughout.

K Hercock (SOLDIER BOY) - Stewards inquired into the manner in which K Hercock used her whip in the home straight and could not be conclusively satisfied that she had contravened the rules.

<p>SACRED PEARL (S Spratt) - Began awkwardly, hampering SHEZZACATCH. Awkwardly placed on heels having to be steadied passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>SHEZZACATCH (K Hercock) - Hampered start. Over-raced when wide.</p> <p>ABSOLUTELY MAYBE (S O'Malley) - Slow away. Raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages placing the rider at a disadvantage. Continued to over-race for a distance passing the 900 metres and had little left at the finish.</p> <p>NOM DE PLUME (C Grylls) - Held up in the home straight having to angle inwards near the 200 metres to gain clear racing room.</p>
