Race 5 WAIKATO STUD @ KARAKA 2023 MAIDEN 1000

BEVANDA (L Satherley) – Trainer Mrs. D Sweeney advised Stewards, upon return to the stable BEVANDA underwent a veterinary examination which showed no abnormalities. D Sweeney further advised the filly has now been sent for a spell.

Race 9 COASTWOOD HOMES LOCKWOOD THAMES CUP 1600

ALIGHIERI (V Colgan) – Mr. R Wellwood reported to Stewards, the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the gelding, and it is the stables intention to continue on with ALIGHIERI'S current preparation.

SAVOIR FAIRE (O Bosson) – Te Akau Racing Manager Mr. R Trumper advised Stewards, the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of SAVOIR FAIRE, and it is the stables intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 PROUDLY RAY WHITE MAIDEN 1400

REDSHEIS (M McNab) - Slow to begin. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the filly had failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

JUST A TIPPLE (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Raced wide in the early stages.

SILVERSTREAM (C Lammas) - Steadied off the heels of JUST A TIPPLE approaching the 900 metres. J Fawcett was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

PATRIARCA (O Bosson) - When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that the mare had failed to handle today's heavy track conditions.

Race 2 RAY WHITE MOUNT MAUNGANUI MAIDEN 1200

VALENTINE (O Bosson) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

STICKTO THE ORDERS (C Zackey) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

CARAJILLO (M McNab) – Held up rounding the final bend.

Race 3 RAY WHITE TAURANGA 1200

MONTANA MIST (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

ORANGE PEARL (M Hashizume) - Knuckled on jumping away then crowded shortly after, losing ground.

LOOKSEASY (S Spratt) - Shifted inward leaving the barriers, crowding ORANGE PEARL.

WAIRAU COVE (O Bosson) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Made the bend near the 1000 metres awkwardly when racing keenly.

MILLEFIORI (H Kamaruddin) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

WINDSPEED (W Pinn) – Held up rounding the final bend.

Following this race, the track was upgraded to Heavy 9.

Race 4 RAY WHITE GREERTON 1200

PURE IMAGINATION (C Zackey) - Slow to begin.

BOLD PERFORMER (W Pinn) - Raced three wide without cover throughout. Contacted rounding the final bend when TIME FLIES had improved to its inside. Rider O Bosson was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances. Steadied off heels passing the 300 metres when runners to its inside shifted ground. V Colgan was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

DIAMOND PEGASUS (V Colgan) - Lay out rounding the final bend and continued to do so for some distance, despite the efforts of its rider. Contacted and briefly unbalanced approaching the 100 metres.

BERBIZIER (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced keenly in the early stages. Shifted inwards approaching the 100 metres making contact with DIAMOND PEGASUS which was briefly unbalanced.

Following this race, the track was upgraded to Heavy 8.

Race 5 RAY WHITE WHAKATANE & OHOPE 1400

LANDRY (K Asano) - Slow to begin then crowded shortly after losing ground. Hampered near the 300 metres.

SO SURREAL (B Rogerson) - Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

ROYAL ROC (M McNab) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

MANRICO (K Hannan) - Forced wider passing the 300 metres.

B Rogerson (SO SURREAL) - Admitted a charge of careless riding in that she permitted her mount to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of LANDRY which was checked near the 300 metres. Also inconvenienced as a result was MANRICO. After considering submissions the Adjudicator imposed a suspension of B Rogerson's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 18 January up to and including racing on Saturday 28 January, 5 national riding days.

Race 6 RAY WHITE BAYFAIR & TE PUKE 1400

HASSTOBEFAST (W Pinn) - Began awkwardly losing ground. Over-raced and skied its head near the 900 metres having to be steadied.

SEEUINABIT (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

GIANT GEM (T Mitchell) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

GWEN'S DAUGHTER (A Goindasamy) – Lay out throughout the race and in particular over the final 100 metres.

Race 7 RAY WHITE PAPAMOA 2100

KASHOCK (W Kennedy) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from the outside barrier.

SELVA VERDE (T Newman) – Rider dropped her whip near the 350 metres.

YOULEDO (S Spratt) – Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

IFFIE SHOWS (M McNab) - Not persevered with in the final straight when out of contention When questioned regarding the performance rider could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

LEICALOT (W Pinn) - Not persevered with in the final straight when out of contention. When questioned regarding the performance rider advised that he felt something was amiss with the mare. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 8 GEOFF SMITH RAY WHITE GREERTON 1600

SOPRANO SUPREME (M McNab) - Slow to begin.

ILLICIT MISS (H Kamaruddin) - Slow to begin. Lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

ASTERIX (C Zackey) - Began awkwardly. Rider reported that the gelding felt indifferent in its action on returning to the birdcage. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

LINCOLN KING (T Mitchell) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

NEW YORK JAZZ (T Newman) – Raced keenly in the early stages.

Race 9 PROUDLY RAY WHITE 1600

ROCABURY (K Hannan) – Raced keenly for a distance when being restrained in the early stages. Inclined to lay out when placed under pressure in the final straight.

CON ARTIST (S Spratt) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

ROCKSPELL (C Zackey) - Held up entering the final straight.

CASTLE BAY (V Colgan) - Had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.
