RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 MEENAN & OTAGO TYRES, MAINFEEDS MAIDEN (1200m)

BENJI'S BOY (L Callaway) - Slow to begin.

MOROCCO MISS (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin. Contacted in the shadows of the post.

AYLA (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly making contact with CHISSIE.

PRESS CHARGES (K Hannan) - Shifted out shortly after the start contacting CHISSIE.

CHISSIE (K Kalychurun) - Contacted then crowded shortly after the start losing ground when runners either side shifted ground.

BORNHOLM (T Moseley) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. T Moseley was spoken to advisedly regarding his whip action over the concluding stages.

BASE UNIT (K Kwo) - Over-raced through the early stages. Lay out in the shadows of the post contacting MOROCCO MISS.

CHIPPEWA (R Beeharry) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 2CATALYST PERFORMANCE AGRONOMY (1200m)MISS BRITTANY (K Williams) - Cast a plate on jumping away.

CHARBANO (L Callaway) - Slow to begin. Improved onto the heels of HAGGLE having to be firmly restrained near the 800 metres.

THE PIRANHA (K Mudhoo) - Hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

HAGGLE (C Barnes) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Held up rounding the final bend having to shift ground outwards across heels to find clear racing room.

GUITAR MAN (K Hannan) - Raced wide without cover throughout. When asked to comment on the performance rider advised she had been trapped wide throughout which had taken its toll on the gelding.

MAXIMUS AUGUSTUS (C Campbell) - Placed in restricted room passing the 350 metres when GENERATION JOY (R Mudhoo) shifted out to find clear racing room. R Mudhoo was advised to exercise care.

TURF WAR (T Moseley) - Briefly hampered passing the 175 metres when CHARBANO lay inwards.

NINETEENSIXTYTWO (A Lawson-Carroll) - Steadied passing the 150 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of GUITAR MAN (K Hannan) which shifted in under pressure. K Hannan was advised to exercise care.

Race 3 PROPERTY BROKERS (1200m)

KEEN TO RUN (C Barnes) - Slow to begin.

SO NATURAL (Y Atchamah) - Slow to begin. Held up entering the final straight having to shift outwards across heels to obtain clear running approaching the 300 metres. Rider dropped his whip near the 50 metres.

MINT JULEP (A Lawson-Carroll) - Slow to begin. Became awkwardly placed on the heels of FIREGLOW which lay in briefly before being straightened by its rider near the 250 metres.

WILD ROVER (J Laking) - From a wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

LASER'S FURY (S Muniandy) - From a wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

LEROY (T Moseley) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover throughout.

PAPAGENA (S Toolooa) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

RETURN WITH HONOUR (C Campbell) - Held up approaching the 400 metres and was unable to obtain clear running until early in the final straight.

DIVOVSKI (K Mudhoo) - Held up approaching the 100 metres and was unable to obtain clear running with the gelding going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

GLADROY (K Williams) - When asked to comment on the performance rider advised she had been challenged in the lead through the early and middle stages and when placed under pressure the gelding had failed to respond. Miss Williams added that in her opinion the horse was looking for tracks with more moisture.

Race 4 BRENT LUCAS BUILDERS MAIDEN (1400m)

MUMBO JUMBO (R Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly.

STOLEN DECREE (L Callaway) - Began awkwardly making contact with SACHIN. Raced keenly through the early and middle stages.

COMPLIMENT (K Williams) - Slow to begin and was then hampered shortly after the start losing ground.

UNUSUAL AFFAIR (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Held up early in the final straight having to shift ground inwards to obtain clear running near the 200 metres.

TELLME YOU LOVEME (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin. Held up for the majority of the run home going to the line untested by its rider.

SACHIN (K Hannan) - Contacted then crowded shortly after the start losing ground when runners either side shifted ground. Trainer J Burns advised that on return to the home stable the gelding had been found to be suffering from a stone bruise.

CLAUDIUS MAXIMUSS (K Kalychurun) - Raced keenly through the early and middle stages. Cast the near hind plate during the running.

RHYOLITE (C Campbell) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

TOUGH TIME (A Lawson-Carroll) - Lay out rounding the final bend then continued to lay out under pressure throughout the final straight.

THE BLAZING ONE (J Lowry) - On return to scale rider reported the gelding was making abnormal breathing noises during the running. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed gelding to have no obvious abnormality other than some minor abrasions to a hind leg consistent with striking itself during the running.

Race 5 CARGILL CONTRACTING MAIDEN (1600m)

PLEASURENPAIN (K Kwo) - Slow to begin. Briefly held up early in the run home.

MRS LAWRENCE (C Campbell) - Contacted then hampered at the start losing ground.

PETAL (K Williams) - Shifted out abruptly at the start making contact with THE TUI TOILER which was forced outwards onto MOOLOOLABA which was contacted and buffeted.

THE TUI TOILER (G Jogoo) - Contacted at the start. Raced wide without cover throughout.

SHE'S A CON (K Mudhoo) - Contacted then crowded at the start losing ground when THEGREATHASS shifted in.

MOOLOOLABA (A Lawson-Carroll) - Contacted and buffeted then crowded at the start with the rider becoming unbalanced, losing considerable ground. Over-raced for a distance passing the 1000 metres. Improved wide from the 800 metres and lay outwards rounding the final bend.

THEGREATHASS (L Callaway) - Shifted in at the start contacting SHE'S A CON. Raced wide without cover throughout. Rider reported the gelding had lay in throughout the running.

Race 6 ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER (1600m)

The start of this race was delayed 4 minutes 18 seconds due to ANJAMEME undergoing a Veterinary examination.

ANJAMEME (K Hannan) - Underwent a pre-race Veterinary examination after making firm contact with the birdcage gate and was cleared to start. Slow to begin. Commenced to race ungenerously in the run down the back straight, striding forward to lead when over-racing, then hung outwards rounding the final bend shifting wider on the track and was not persevered with over the concluding stages. A post-race Veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormality. Connections were advised the mare would be required to trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing next. Trainer T Kennedy advised the Stewards he would be reassessing the racing future of the horse.

REDFORD (J Laking) - From a wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

IN VEGAS (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start. Obliged to attempt to improve wide from the 700 metres.

FATHER LENIHAN (K Kalychurun) - Raced wide without cover for the majority of the event. Held up for a short distance through the middle stages of the run home.

ZADANE (G Jogoo) - Lay in early in the run home having to be straightened by its rider.

HENRY HUBBER (C Campbell) - Crowded and had to steady when tiring near the 250 metres.

S Muniandy (FETTERCAIRN) - Issued with a warning when allowing his mount FETTERCAIRN to shift outwards near the 250 metres crowding HENRY HUBBER which had to be steadied. When assessing this penalty Stewards took into account some contributing movement from ZADANE.

Race 7 HOPE & SONS HANDICAP (1400m)

OUR ECHO (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

SENTIENT (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin.

OKAY PAL (L Callaway) - Slow to begin. Commenced to over-race getting its head up for a distance passing the 1200 metres. Steadied over the concluding stages when ROCK SENSATION (K Mudhoo) shifted inwards under pressure. K Mudhoo was advised to exercise care.

ROCK SENSATION (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly and was then hampered shortly after the start losing ground. Commenced to race ungenerously getting its head up on a number of occasions through the early and middle stages. Shifted ground inwards over the concluding stages when under pressure.

ROBINA JOY (K Kwo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

Race 8 COOKE HOWLISON HYUNDAI (1400m)

PRINCE ALBY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SHANGHAI EXPRESS (A Balloo) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SHOW BAZZ (S Toolooa) - Began awkwardly and was then restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

VALYRIAN (R Beeharry) - Slow to begin.

SCARLETT'S PROMISE (T Moseley) - From a wide barrier was restrained behind runners to obtain cover shortly after the start.

WILLIS (G Jogoo) - Commenced to race fiercely passing the 1200 metres and shifted out hampering CHEYENNE DREAMS and JUST MAYBE with both these runners being forced wider on the track. Then allowed to stride forward to the lead passing the 900 metres.

JUST MAYBE (K Williams) - Hampered near the 1200 metres and shifted wider on the track and was then obliged to race wide for the remainder of the event.

CHEYENNE DREAMS (R Mudhoo) - Hampered near the 1200 metres and shifted wider on the track. Steadied off heels passing the 800 metres when racing keenly and again passing the 600 metres.

KERANY (K Hannan) - Over-raced through the middle stages due to the lack of tempo.

DECEPTIO VISUS (K Mudhoo) - Over-raced in the middle stages having to be steadied away from heels passing the 700 metres.

DARCI'S BELLE (C Barnes) - Over-raced through the middle stages due to the lack of tempo. When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner rider advised mare was unsuited to the mixed tempo of today's race.

TOMYTURBO (L Callaway) - Raced wide without cover throughout.

FAME SHINES (Y Atchamah) - Crowded and had to steady near the 225 metres and was again held up over the final 50 metres going to the line not fully tested by its rider.

J Laking (CEDDY SMITH) - Issued with a warning when allowing his mount CEDDY SMITH to shift out near the 225 metres placing FAME SHINES in restricted room.

J Laking (CEDDY SMITH) – Admitted a charge in that he used his whip with an action which raised the rider's arm above shoulder height. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a fine of \$250.

Race 9 WAE WAIKOUAITI CUP (2200m)

NESTA (K Kalychurun) - Bounded at the start, getting its head up and losing ground as a result.

AQUATTACK (A Balloo) - Slow to begin.

LETSBRINGITON (K Williams) - Over-raced through the middle stages. Lay in throughout the run home having to be straightened on a number of occasions.

DR VELOCIOUS (A Lawson-Carroll) - Attempted to improve wide from the 800 metres.

LEAVE IT TO ME (K Mudhoo) - Lay inwards in the run home having to be straightened near the 200 metres. Continued to lay inwards thereafter and near the 100 metres shifted in despite the efforts of its rider, crowding DUNHILL which had to be steadied. Then passing the 50 metres got its head up and over reacted when being restrained after laying inwards across the heels off SADLERS LASS (K Hannan) when it shifted away from LETSBRINGITON (K Williams) when both those runners shifted ground marginally. After viewing replays and questioning riders, Stewards could not be totally satisfied that any one rider was careless however riders K Williams and K Hannan were advised to exercise greater care and straighten their mounts sooner than they did on this occasion.

ASATHOUGHT (C Campbell) - Held up passing the 125 metres having to shift ground outwards near the 75 metres to find clear racing room.

DUNHILL (R Mudhoo) - Crowded and had to steady near the 100 metres.

Race 10 ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER (1600m)

J Lowry was unable to make the contracted weight for his ride on THE CLUSTER and was fined \$100 under the Minor Infringement Schedule. Mr Lowry was replaced by K Kwo.

SESTINA (K Mudhoo) - Late scratching on Veterinary advice at 2.12pm after being injured in the float on route to the races.

HUNTER VILLAIN (K Hannan) - Slow to begin.

CAITLYN JAY (T Moseley) - Slow to begin. Held up in the run home and went to the line untested by its rider.

RITA HAYWORTH (R Mudhoo) - Slow to begin. Crowded and had to steady near the 75 metres when racing between PHYLLITE (C Barnes) which when giving ground under pressure shifted out slightly and DEMAND RESPECT (J Laking) which lay inwards at this point. Both C Barnes and J Laking were advised to exercise greater care.

LINCOLN COUNTY (K Kalychurun) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

THE CLUSTER (K Kwo) - Began awkwardly and was then hampered shortly after the start, losing ground. Held up for several strides passing the 225 metres.

SYMPATHIQUE (G Jogoo) - Over-raced in the early stages and had to be steadied to avoid heels near the 1300 metres. Held up in the middle stages of the run home having to shift outwards across heels passing the 100 metres to find clear racing room.

POVERTY BAY (A Lawson-Carroll) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

POWERLITE (J Fawcett) - Lay inwards in the run home and near the 200 metres shifted in, briefly crowding PHYLLITE.

PHYLLITE (C Barnes) - Briefly crowded near the 200 metres and again near the 75 metres. When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner rider advised the mare had raced wide with cover and when presented for its run turning for home had failed to quicken and had been disappointing.

DEMAND RESPECT (J Laking) - Lay in throughout the run home and near the 75 metres shifted inwards briefly crowding PHYLLITE.

CLASSIC DIVA (K Williams) - When asked to comment on the performance of favoured runner rider advised that after being obliged to get back from a wide draw in her opinion the mare had finished the race off fairly.
