SUPPLEMENTARY

Ashburton Racing Club - Thursday 19 January 2023

Race 1 - ASHBURTON U-HIRE MAIDEN 1600m

SAVUSAVU PRINCESS (S Toolooa) – Trainer Mr A Carston advised Stewards that SAVUSAVU PRINCESS would now be retired from his stable as a racing proposition.

Race 4 HYGAIN MAIDEN STAYERS 2200m

ESME (L Alpress) – Stable representative Mr A Carston reported to Stewards that the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of the mare however has now been sent for a spell.

Race 7 - GO RACING BUYING AT KARAKA 2023 1600m

EL TIRADOR (J Laking) – Co-trainer Mrs K Parson advised Stewards that the stable was satisfied with the post-race condition of EL TIRADOR and it is their intention to continue on with the gelding's current preparation.

Race 8 - IDEAL RACING / MY BOY GEORGE MISSING J R 1400m

SOOO DUSTY (K Williams) – Trainer Mr A Carston reported to Stewards that upon return to the stable the mare underwent a veterinary examination which included blood tests, with results showing no abnormalities. A Carston further advised that SOO DUSTY has been nominated for the Canterbury Jockey Club meeting on Saturday 28 January.

RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 FORD CONTRACTING MAIDEN 1400m

SISTER SARAH (G Saejorhor) - Knuckled shortly after the start. Raced ungenerously passing the 1000 metres before improving onto heels having to be heavily restrained. Continued to race ungenerously for a distance.

BALTIMORE (J Laking) - Began awkwardly losing ground.

SUNSET EXPRESS (R Mudhoo) - Jumped away awkwardly making contact with SASSMAN shortly after the start losing ground.

HEAVENLY BOUQUET (J Mudhoo) - Raced in restricted racing room shortly after the start before being restrained.

STOLEN DECREE (J Fawcett) - Steadied to avoid heels passing the 1200 metres. Lay in through the middle stages of the run home briefly hampering ZARAVELA passing the 200 metres.

SASSMAN (K Kwo) - Raced ungenerously in the early stages of the race.

ZARAVELA (C Barnes) - Raced wide without cover throughout. Briefly hampered passing the 200 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination at the request of the trainer after returning to the birdcage with lacerations to the back legs consistent with striking itself during the running.

AREYOUOKAY (B May) - Held up rounding the final bend and early in the run home.

BELLA ROSE (K Chowdhoory) - When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised that the filly had not been suited by the mixed tempo of today's race.

SEVEN ELEVEN (K Williams) - When asked to comment on the performance, rider advised that the filly had not been suited by the mixed tempo of today's race. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.

J Lowry (ATLANTIC CITY) - Issued with a warning after permitting his mount ATLANTIC CITY to shift in passing the 1200 metres when not fully clear of STOLEN DECREE which had to be steadied.

Race 2	VICTORIA TEMPLE-SMITH MAIDEN 1400m

Trainer **A Carston** - Issued with a warning after presenting NIGHT MIST without notified gear (side winkers).

LITIGATOR (J Laking) - Crowded at the start shifting in and contacting LUCKY SIMON with both runners losing ground.

LUCKY SIMON (T Moseley) - Crowded at the start losing ground and was forced inwards onto SWAY UP which was contacted and unbalanced shortly after the start. Contacted near the 700 metres.

SWAY UP (R Beeharry) - Contacted and unbalanced at the start losing ground.

SIT DOWN DEAR (J Fawcett) - Shifted in abruptly at the start crowding inside runners.

VICKEZZROSE (K Chowdhoo) - Jumped outwards shortly after the start before being restrained to the back of the field. Obligated to shift outwards to avoid heels passing the 700 metres making contact with LUCKY SIMON.

TOUGH TIME (B May) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

NORTOLOSE (G Jogoo) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

IT'S THE VIBE (J Lowry) - Made the bend near the 700 metres awkwardly shifting out, with the trailing VICKEZZROSE having to shift outwards to avoid heels and in doing so made contact with LUCKY SIMON.

FAYE'S WARRIOR (B Murray) - Lay in rounding the final bend and for the majority of the run home.

SCARY MARY (T Jonker) - Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed a slow recovery rate.

Race 3	KARAKA 2023 STARTS TOMORROW 1200m

FISCAL FUN (C Barnes) - Began awkwardly. Raced wide without cover through the early stages.

OVER TO YOU (K Williams) - Knuckled leaving the barriers shifting out making contact with KAPALKA. Raced three wide without cover throughout. Rider advised Stewards that OVER TO YOU had been unable to obtain the lead which in her opinion had been detrimental to the mare's performance today. A post-race veterinary examination revealed that OVER TO YOU had bled. OVER TO YOU shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

KAPALKA (G Jogoo) - Contacted at the start losing ground as a result.

SENTIENT (R Beeharry) - Slow into stride.

DIVINE DIVE (G Saejorhor) - Over raced in the early stages.

EPTIMUM (J Fawcett) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

AVITUS (T Moseley) - Raced four wide without cover throughout.

O'JESSICA (R Mudhoo) - Returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. Following a veterinary examination O'JESSICA was confirmed to have bled. O'JESSICA shall not be ridden in exercise for a period of two months or start in any race or trial for a period of three months, and then only after a satisfactory gallop of at least 1000 metres in the presence of a Veterinarian.

B May (RADIANT ROSIE) - Admitted a charge in that he struck his mount RADIANT ROSIE nine times prior to the 100 metre mark. After considering submissions the Adjudicative Committee imposed a suspension of B May's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 4 February until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 15 February, 7 national riding days.

Race 4	FAREWELL UNCLE SCOTTY 1100m

BRITISH ROYALTY (C Barnes) - Slow to begin. Rider advised Stewards she had a nice run throughout and had followed the winner early in the straight but when placed under pressure had failed to let down and been disappointing.

BEAU STITCH (B Murray) - Jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages. Lay in near the 350 metres having to be straightened by its rider.

VINO BELLA (T Moseley) - Restrained shortly after the start to a rearward position. Was inclined to shift in when placed under pressure over the concluding stages.

THIRD DECREE (K Williams) - Raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

A BOX OF TRICKS (G Saejorhor) - Raced in restricted room coming onto the course proper when TWIN SHOT over raced and lay in. Briefly steadied near the 300 metres when held up for clear running.

TWIN SHOT (K Chowdhoory) - Over raced and lay in when coming onto the course proper.

SECOND THOUGHT (K Chowdhoory) - Jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

TAKE THE DEEL (G Jogoo) - Slow to begin.

AQUATTACK (J Fawcett) - Slow to begin.

THE GROWLER (T Moseley) - Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained to take a position.

BLUEY'S CHANCE (T Jonker) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

KING OF THE DANCE (R Beeharry) - Raced three wide throughout and was inclined to shift out rounding the home turn when tiring.

LETSBRINGITON (K Williams) – Lay in throughout the run home when placed under pressure.

B May (WANNABE 'N' PARIS) - Rider spoken to advisedly regarding his celebratory gesture just prior to the winning post.

Race 6	ODT SOUTHERN MILE QUALIFIER 1600m

LARPOWER (C Barnes) - Slow to begin. Raced wide from the 700 metres. When questioned regarding performance rider advised that the gelding had been slow to begin getting back further than intended and was not suited by the muddling tempo of today's race.

DA VINCI GIRL (T Jonker) - Bounded at the start and was then restrained from a wide barrier draw to take a position.

NAMIBIA MISS (K Williams) - Shifted outwards shortly after the start placing MATSCOT in restricted room for a few strides.

MATSCOT (K Mudhoo) - Raced in restricted room shortly after the start. Over raced in restricted room for a distance near the 1000 metres and got its head up when being steadied to avoid heels.

FIREGLOW (G Jogoo) - Raced three wide without cover in the early stages until near the 1200 metres. Contacted and briefly steadied passing the 175 metres when EARS BACK lay inwards under pressure.

EARS BACK (J Fawcett) - Shifted inwards when placed under pressure throughout the run home having to be continually straightened.

SEVEN TWENTY (J Lowry) - Held up over the concluding stages. When asked to comment on performance, rider advised that the mare had been obliged to get back in the field but had battled fairly over the concluding stages and was held up later in the race. J Lowry added that the extra weight carried in today's race may not have helped.

J Fawcett (EARS BACK) - Issued with a warning after permitting her mount EARS BACK to shift inwards under pressure when not sufficiently clear of FIREGLOW which was crowded and had to briefly steady passing the 175 metres. In assessing this matter Stewards took into account the racing manners of EARS BACK.

Race 7	KEVIN & PAM HUGHES 1400m

BLUE SOLITAIRE (G Saejorhor) - Slow to begin then restrained to take a position at the back of the field. Had some trouble finding clear racing room through the middle stages of the run home.

SHOW BAZZ (J Lowry) - Bounded at the start. Briefly steadied near the 200 metres when CEDDY SMITH lay in briefly before being steadied by its rider.

SHANGHAI EXPRESS (G Jogoo) - Crowded shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground and raced keenly in the early stages. Shied and shifted out abruptly passing the 1100 metres contacting and unbalancing FAME SHINES.

FAME SHINES (B May) - Contacted and unbalanced passing the 1100 metres.

SELFIE (K Williams) - Raced three wide without cover for the majority of the race.

LIPA MALA (R Mudhoo) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

CHEEKINI (J Fawcett) - Held up for clear running in the home straight until near the 200 metres.

CEDDY SMITH (J Laking) - When asked to comment on the performance of this favoured runner, rider advised he had been obliged to get back in the field and when placed under pressure the gelding had only battled on fairly.

Race 8	SPEIGHT'S TIMARU STAKES OPEN HANDICAP 1400m

RAPOSA RAPIDA (R Mudhoo) - Bounded at the start losing ground.

OKAY PAL (G Jogoo) - Stood flat footed as the start was effected losing ground. Raced keenly between the 1000 and 800 metres and lay out on the turn leaving the 800 metres.

AVAQUINELLA (K Chowdhoo) - Slow to begin. Shifted out passing the 225 metres to find clear racing room.

ROCK SENSATION (K Mudhoo) - Began awkwardly then restrained to a rear position.

KHIMAR WAR (K Kwo) - Raced keenly in the early stages.

LIVE DRAMA (K Williams) - Raced three wide without cover until near the 1000 metres.

JEWEL OF PATCH (C Barnes) - Raced three wide without cover from near the 1000 metres.

TIMES TICKING (T Moseley) - Held up from the 600 metres until passing the 400 metres.

PERFECT SCENARIO (J Laking) - Was inclined to lay in behind LIVE DRAMA over the concluding stages.

PHELAN THE POWER (J Fawcett) - Lost the off front plate during the running.

Following this race, rider **B May** reported to Stewards he was suffering cramping in his arms and as a result underwent an examination by St John Paramedics and was stood down from his remaining ride.

Race 9	RACECOURSE HOTEL & MOTOR LODGE 1800m

POWERFUL MOSS – Declared a late scratching at 5.05pm due to the unavailability of a suitable rider.

MADISON ROSE (T Moseley) - Trainer P Harris advised that the mare would be racing in season. Slow to begin.

TAVI WITH ME (G Saejorhor) - Slow to begin. Held up for a short distance passing the 300 metres and was obliged to shift out to find clear racing room and when doing so became awkwardly placed on the heels of ZADANE having to be briefly steadied and shift ground inwards.

ALLASERA (J Laking) - Restrained from a wide barrier draw to take a rear position shortly after the start.

HEY MICKEY (R Beeharry) - Over raced in the early stages when being restrained.

COLOSSAL (G Jogoo) - Over raced in the early stages when being restrained.

VALYRIAN (C Barnes) - Raced keenly in the early stages and shifted out near the 1600 metres to avoid heels and was then obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.

KRISTOFFERSON (R Mudhoo) - Lay in and over raced passing the 1100 metres when the tempo eased.

LADY TELENA (T Jonker) - When over racing had to be restrained passing the 1100 metres to avoid the heels of KRISTOFFERSON then shifted out passing the 1000 metres forcing MADISON ROSE wider on the track at that point.

RED SUNDAY (J Fawcett) - Held up rounding the final bend and when shifting out to find clear racing room passing the 400 metres briefly inconvenienced ZADANE which was dictated wider on the track. When asked to comment on the apparent improved performance, trainer P Harris advised that the gelding had been racing well but was totally unsuited to the inconsistent nature of the track at Kumara.

ZADANE (J Mudhoo) - Inconvenienced 400 metres.

VISTOCK (K Kwo) - Lost a racing plate during the running.
