RACE COMMENTS

Race 1 LASER ELECTRICAL MOUNT MAUNGANUI MAIDEN 1600

PERSUADER (C Zackey) - Jumped in at the start making contact with FOOTLOOSE. Over-raced through the early and middle stages. Raced three wide without cover from near the 800 metres. Lay in throughout the final straight.

FOOTLOOSE (B Rogerson) - Contacted at the start then shifted out hampering PERSUADER which was forced out into the running of JAMACIA FAREWELL which had to be steadied. Came together with PERSUADER approaching the 300 metres. Shifted outwards when placed under pressure over the final 100 metres making brief contact with PERSUADER over the concluding stages.

JAMAICA FAREWELL (T Newman) – Had to be steadied when PERSUADER was forced out when FOOTLOOSE shifted ground shortly after the start.

MOONIGHT SHADOW (K Hannan) – Raced three wide without cover until near the 800 metres.

MOOLOOLABA (C Grylls) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that he was disappointed with the gelding's effort and could offer no explanation.

TE ATATU MEMPHIS (N Parmar) - Rider dropped his whip near the 150 metres. Lay in when placed under pressure over the final 100 metres.

Race 2 KIWI TRUCK TYRES MAIDEN 3YO 1400

The start of this race was delayed by 2 minutes due to MR MONDELLO undergoing a veterinary examination at the barrier.

MR MONDELLO (C Zackey) - Underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier and was late scratched at 2.02 pm. Trainer J Mahoney was advised that the gelding will require a veterinary clearance prior to trialling or racing next.

TOBLERONE (C Grylls) – Began awkwardly.

HUMBOLDT (K Hannan) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages.

ACCURACY (M McNab) - Lay out rounding the final bend despite the efforts of its rider. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that he was disappointed with the gelding's effort and could offer no explanation. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

Race 3 EMAC ELECTRICAL 1200

BRANDO (N Parmar) – Began awkwardly making contact with the barrier, losing ground. Lay in over the concluding stages having to be corrected by its rider. Briefly came together and brushed with AMUSEZ MOI just short of the finish line.

MEGA BOURBON (C Barnes) - Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages when inclined to lay outwards.

NO LOITERING (K Asano) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

MARKUS AURELIUS (O Bosson) – Held up rounding the final bend.

AMUSEZ MOI (K Hannan) - Briefly came together and brushed with BRANDO just short of the finish line.

Race 4 ENERGY SERVICES 1200

THIS LITTLE LIGHT (T Abel) - Slow to begin.

QUARTZ QUEEN (L Satherley) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. Held up near the 400 metres. Lay inwards when placed under pressure approaching the 300 metres.

DON'T LOOK ETHEL (C Barnes) – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

DIAMOND PEGASUS (S Spratt) – When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding had hung outwards during the running and failed to respond when placed under pressure.

EL NYMPH – N Parmar replaced K Hannan as she was unable to make the contracted weight due to travel commitments and dehydration from riding at Wingatui yesterday. Stewards notified NZTR to amend K Hannan's declared riding weight to 52 kgs.

LINCOLN KING (M Alam) – Began awkwardly making contact with AQUACADE, losing ground. Went off stride rounding the final bend. Rider dropped his whip near the 350 metres.

AQUACADE (W Kennedy) – Contacted at the start. Raced wide in the early stages before being restrained to obtain cover near the 1400 metres.

DAWN JESSIE (B Rogerson) – Began awkwardly. Lost the off-hind plate shortly after the start. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the mare lay outwards during the running and failed to handle the heavy track conditions. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind. Trainer P Lock was advised that the mare will require a veterinary clearance prior to trialling or racing next.

SELVA VERDE (T Newman) – Raced keenly in the early stages when being restrained.

Race 6 CABLERITE ELECTRICAL 2100

CALL ME FLINT (M Hashizume) – Became fractious in the barriers as the start was initiated and began awkwardly, losing ground. Over-raced through the early and middle stages due to the slow tempo. When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure in the final straight.

GO BUTCH (S Spratt) – Over-raced through the early and middle stages due to the slow tempo.

HAPPY REMARK (L Satherley) - Shifted outwards abruptly near the 300 metres having to be corrected by its rider hampering CANADIAN GIRL. Rider L Satherley was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

CANADIAN GIRL (J Kamaruddin) - Hampered near the 300 metres.

Race 7 STE ELECTRICAL 1600

OUR TRISTABELLE (W Kennedy) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover.

BARI (T Mitchell) - Raced three wide without cover throughout.

LIGHTNING FIELD (H Kamaruddin) – Dipped near the 250 metres. Lay inwards over the concluding stages when placed under pressure. Came together and brushed with TRIGON LAD just short of the finish line. H Kamaruddin was advised to exercise greater care in similar circumstances.

TRIGON LAD (T Abel) - Came together and brushed with LIGHTNING FIELD just short of the finish line.

Race 8 LASER ELECTRICAL TAURANGA 1600

JUST A TIPPLE (L Satherley) - Stood flat footed as the start was initiated losing ground.

STAR OF WONDER (S Spratt) – Began awkwardly contacting ROCABURY at the start. Lay out when placed under pressure rounding the final bend.

ROCABURY (R Elliot) – Began awkwardly contacting STAR OF WONDER at the start. Shifted outwards when placed under pressure near the 200 metres and continued to do so for some distance despite the efforts of its rider.

BAHIA EMERALD (W Kennedy) – Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from an outside barrier. Shifted outwards to obtain clear running passing the 350 metres.

THATSALLSHEWROTE (J Bayliss) - Restrained in the early stages to obtain cover after jumping from an outside barrier. Lay outwards approaching the 100 metres having to be corrected by its rider.

OZARK (C Zackey) - When questioned regarding the performance rider reported that he was disappointed with the gelding's effort and could offer no explanation.

CON ARTIST (T Abel) – Raced three wide without cover throughout.

BRIAN LAMONT (T Mitchell) - Over-raced having to be steadied off heels near the 1200 metres.
